Dear Sir, -

We are in receipt of your favor of 20th inst and are glad to learn that the work on the new Manual is nearing an end.

With reference to the plates we are ready to accept your judgment as to the number needed. They should all be made by the same process and we should prefer that they be printed from relief plates if possible. We think we can reproduce in relief those we now have on stone. It will be well however to examine this question at once and we shall do so and report to you. We can certainly reproduce in relief from a clear copper plate print.

In any case you had better prepare the drawings so that they can be reproduced either way so far as you have to make new drawings.
