We send you herewith proofs from the relief plates of Nos I. III. VII. XIII. and XXII. With careful printing they ought to make very excellent plates for the book —

In considering the number of plates we have to take account of the conveniences in printing regular forms. If the plates go above 24 in number they may as well go to 32. If you could condense so as to make the number 24 it would be well, but if not you might add a few more. Could not the XXI and XXV be combined? We make this suggestion without any knowledge of the conditions in the case, and leave the matter to your judgment.
