was made in 1820 in favor of restricting slavery
in the State of Missouri as a condition of
her admission to the Union

In 1819 he commenced a correspondence
with De Baudelle who in 1824 dedicated a genus
to his name. In 1826 the catalogue of W.
Baxter plants, ^{commenced 13 years previous} was published under the title
of *Flora bostica*. The same year he founded
the Baxter Soc. Cabinet of N. Science of which
he became President & to which he has left
his valuable herbarium & botanical library

In 1835 he began to print the *Flora bostica*
in 1843 he published the correspondence of
Baldwin, & in 1847 the *Agricultural botany*
in 1849 the correspondence of John Bartram
& Humphrey Marshall was published & in
1853 an improved & enlarged edition of
Flora bostica.

During the latter years of his life he was engaged
in collecting material ^{for} sketches of some
of the old worthies of Baxter county & other an-
tiquarian researches in the history of the
county & its early settlement
