Dear Professor A. Gray,

I thank You sincerely for the kindly  
transmitted Supplement to your Synoptical  
Flora of N. America.

Of the *Ranunculus tuberosus* Hornem. bot.  
Hafn. I have found 2 specimens, the one labelled  
by Hornemann, the other by Schumacher; both  
are garden-specimens without root or bulb,  
and both undoubtedly *R. bulbosus* L., very  
different (not only by the want of bulb, as  
Hornem. observes) from *R. Philonotis*. The seeds  
are said by Hornemann (l. c.) to have been  
sent from North America, but I cannot  
make out, from what part of Your country  
or by whom they were sent to the garden of Cop.
