found on the sandy shore of the
Platte River in Schuyler Colfax
County, Nebraska -

Erect, 2-3^o feet high, dichoto-
mously branched, leaves petioled,
linear-lanceolate; ^{repandly} stellate pubescent

Flower dioecious. - Staminate
flowers with 5 parted calyx, ^{no petals} stamens
11) eleven, base of calyx with 5 glands.
Pistillate calyx 5 parted, base with
a saucer-shaped gland, no petals,
ovary stellate-tomentose + dehiscent -
pod 3 lobed, separating into 3 carpels -
Seed sarcinate. - Stigmas dichotomously
