Wishing to borrow some few of Taylor's Hepaticæ (Gymnomeria reclusa and gate-nulata), and offering you the publications I have written since the death of our mutual friend Sullivan, I wrote to you a letter, but erroneously "Cambridge Maryland", not Massachusetts, by which mistake you may not received it.

For a monograph of Catia (= Gymnomitrium !) I want to see Taylor's specimens of (G.) phylocaulum, phygium and acinacifolium, please lend me some few items of them, also of all his specimens of G. concinnum, both European and Extra-European, especially from the Arctic Regions, and G. coralliorides ! But excuse if I must tell that I



want them as soon as possible. Can
