

It is as regards form of organs are rather light.

S. reflexum is a form difficult to place, it is very close to *S. carolinianum* which immediately you have had very far from *reflexum*, quite close to *displanthum*. Such is a perfect Ammon type! I do not know *Stoloniferum*

S. macrocephalum are unfortunately unknown to me
S. plumosum I do not know what relation this may have with the two *carolinianum*, but it looks more as if it were placed among *Lupinaster* than among Ammons, being very near allied to *S. dasycyllum*. *S. altissimum* *abundans* is unknown to me

S. bicoloratum seems to be allied to *Lupinaster* but its habit as *S. longi* (very peculiar for the form of its corolla) is very different from the two types (each of them heterogeneous) *apinum* *macrocephalum*. I do not know *S. Bolanderi*

S. nanum a typical *Lupinaster*!
S. Grandis *umbrosum*.

S. gymnocarpus *serotinum* unknown, whatever its form and structure may be, it is nearer to Ammon than to *Lupinaster* and precisely close to our *S. montanum* so difficult to place. Its habit is very similar to many specimens of *S. serotinum*, as I had from your goodness.

S. macrac a very representative of our large section. *Sagittata*, *dichotomum* is scarcely a variety of *macrocar*.

Let us go down to *Evolutaria*, a most difficult group, as to *evolutaria* I have sent me under *S. involutum* three peculiar forms the same for *S. tridentatum* which contains just as many good species. From No 28 to No 32 not to say about to *S. monanthum* we have a most natural group. These characters allow us thoroughly to divide the group into 3 subgroups - some typical forms are *S. involutum* *varia*,
S. tridentatum *Lincol*
S. fraxiniflorum *chili*

S. S distinguished by calyx-teeth subulate from the base
S. S subulate from a very broad base
S. S stipules whose circumscissure is perfect
round, few acutely multi-lobed and acute reflexed. In this latter group the calyx is just like in *macrocarum*. Searching for basal forms like *capitata* *chrysantha* I have been looking for the names of Douglas *multilobum* Gray but except *S. grandis* *longi* *umbrosum*, the names very distinct species I have been unable to report to none of the species of which I am still looking for what is *colasiflorum*? *S. variegatum* *S. acicula* *perfoliatum* *melananthum* *heterodon*? I have just now handed to the forms belonging to the 3 groups one belonging to *macrocarum* group. I have named *S. altata* another belongs to *variegatum* *S. altatum* I have had the pleasure to honor with your name, another to *variegatum* *S. subgroup* which I had named *S. appendiculatum* owing to the *ultriforme* *acumen* of the ped. Probably you will laugh at me in reading these titles, but I must say that I am not decide upon the foundation of these new species till I may be in the case of securing a good lot of specimens of the *Evolutaria* section and the *Ammonia* section what *heterodon* *obtusiflorum* *melananthum* *delicatum* *polyphyllum* etc are by means of most authentic plants. Do I see you to be so kind as to give or lend me authentic bits of the *Ammonia* species unless I must decline my task and I will have spent 6 months of labor *most* without obtaining the proposed result. From my side I will be very anxious to give as soon as possible a small bit of the probable new species in order to have a good answer from you or that you may know when the *Ammonia* species proposed will do. I wish to wear my name *algeri*.

I have a peculiar variety of *macrocarum* which I have called *var. bulbosum*.
