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Rhagionidae (Diptera) from the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Five species of this family were collected by the writer and Robert R. Dreisbach in the Tennessee part of the park in 1946: Chrysopilus connexus Jns., Elkmont, June 15, 2 99; C. ornatus Say, Cherokee Orchard, June 14, 9; C. quadratus Say, Elkmont, June 15, 9; C. rotundipennis Lw., Cades Cove, June 13, 3; Rhagio vertebratus Lw., Cherokee Orchard, June 11, Chimneys Camp, June 11, Headquarters, June 15, 3 39. It is interesting to note that the only form found in Cades Cove (Chrysopilus rotundipennis) has a costal plains distribution. Chrysopilus connexus is apparently known only from the North Carolina mountains and Jacksonville, Florida. The others are more widespread.—George C. Steyskal, Grosse Ile, Michigan.
