A new name for the genus *Cyrtolabus* van der Vecht (Hymenoptera, Eumenidae)

Some years ago I described a new genus for two Oriental species of small wasps which agree in several characters with the genus *Labus* de Saussure. Unfortunately it was overlooked that the name *Cyrtolabus*, proposed for this genus, had previously been applied by VOSS (1925 : 262) to a subgenus of *Attelabus* (Coleoptera).

It was my intention to correct this error in a future paper on Eumenidae. However, recently my colleague Dr. A. GIORDANI SOIKA (1968) placed the five Palaearctic species, hitherto included in *Labus*, together with some new species, in the genus *Cyrtolabus*, and the genus is thus likely to receive more general attention in the near future.

As further delay of the correction appears now undesirable, I propose to apply the new name *Cyrtolabulus* to the genus *Cyrtolabus* van der Vecht, 1963 (type species *Cyrtolabus suavis* van der Vecht).
