Updates to Western Australia's vascular plant census for 2013

The census database at the Western Australian Herbarium (PERTH), which provides the nomenclature for the website *FloraBase* (Western Australian Herbarium 1998–), lists current names and recent synonymy for Western Australia's native and naturalised vascular plants, as well as algae, bryophytes, lichens, slime moulds and some fungi. The names represented in the census are either sourced from published research or denote as yet unpublished names based on herbarium voucher specimens. We herein summarise the changes relating to vascular plants made to this database during 2013, the latest part of an annual series (Parker & Biggs 2012; Biggs & Parker 2013).

In 2013, 348 name changes were made to the census. One hundred and fifty three concerned taxa newly recorded for the state, of which 15 are naturalised and 38 have been added to the Department of Parks and Wildlife's (formerly Department of Environment and Conservation) *Threatened and Priority Flora list for Western Australia* (Smith 2013) (Table 1). Plant groups for which a number of name changes were made in 2013 include *Acacia* Mill. (Maslin 2013; Maslin *et al.* 2013), *Astartea* DC. (Rye 2013a) and *Euphorbia* L. (Halford & Harris 2012). Under the Council of Heads of Australasian Herbaria's (CHAH) guidelines for informal names (Barker 2005), manuscript names are being converted to phrase names unless publication is imminent. Thirty two manuscript names were updated to phrase names through this process, while one manuscript-named and 56 phrase-named taxa were formally published (Table 2). Table 2 also includes cases where there has been a change of taxonomic concept, misapplication, exclusion or rank change.
