GENERIC CHARACTER.

Bill crooked, (not furnished with a cere.) Noftrils covered with recumbent briftly feathers. Head large: Ears and Eyes large. Tongue bifid.

Specific Character.

FERRUGINOUS - BROWN OWL, paler beneath, with the forehead white, and the remiges barred with black and white.

The very curious and diminutive fpecies of owl here reprefented in its natural fize, has perhaps never been either figured or deferibed. It is a native of North America, and particularly of Canada. The fuppofed female is defitute of the white forehead, which forms fo confpicuous a character in the male? It belongs to the division of fmooth or hornlefs owls.
