TRICOLOR CHÆTODON.



GENERIC CHARACTER.

Teeth setaceous. Body varied or banded.

SPECIFIC CHARACTER, &c.

Yellow CHÆTODON, with the hind part black;
the tail and fins bordered with red.

The TRICOLOR or triple-coloured CHÆTO-
DON.

This highly singular species, which grows to the length of a foot or more, is a native of the American seas, and seems to have been first described in the work of Dr. Bloch.
