*GENERIC CHARACTER.*

*Legs* generally eight, (in some species six or ten,) besides two claspers or chelated arms.

*Feelers* six, unequal.

*Eyes* two, commonly distant; footstalked, movable.

*Tail* articulated, unarmed.

*SPECIFIC CHARACTER, &c.*

Long-bodied CANCER, with the thorax aculeated forwards, and prismatic arms with the angles spiny.
