CYPARISSIAS.



GENERIC CHARACTER.

Antennæ thickening towards the upper part
and generally terminating in a knob.

Wings (when sitting) erect, and meeting up-
wards. (Flight diurnal.)

SPECIFIC CHARACTER.

BUTTERFLY with entire, black wings, with
two white bands; those of the upper wings
oblique; of the lower spotted.

The Papilio Cyparissias is a native of South America, and is represented on the plate in its natural size.
