*GENERIC CHARACTER.*

*Animal* resembling a *Limax*.

*Shell* univalve, involute, obtuse, ovate.

*Aperture* linear, longitudinal, toothed on both sides.

*SPECIFIC CHARACTER, &c.*

Cinereous turbinated Cypræa, with broad vio-laceo-fuscous bands.
