*Animal* allied to a *Slug*.

*Shell* univalve, spiral, gibbous.

*Aperture* ovate, ending in a channel pointing towards the right.

*Interior Lip* expanded.

*SPECIFIC CHARACTER, &c.*

Yellowish flesh-coloured *BUCCINUM*, with longitudinal undulated brown bands.
