GENERIC CHARACTER.

Animal allied to a Tethys.

Shell bivalve, strong.

Hinge with a gibbose callus obliquely inserted
into an oblique fossule.

SPECIFIC CHARACTER, &c.

CHAMA with smooth roundish shell, with re-
curved tips, and gaping orifice.

The Smooth OX-HEART CHAMA.

The present shell is a native of the European seas, and is sometimes found of a larger size than represented on the annexed plate.
