OTHER FAUNA

Snakes

Carpet Snake (Morelia variegata), one seen in the ruins of an abandoned timber mill at the head of the brook.

Gwardar (Demausia uuchalis), a speeimen about 70 em. long was

caught.

Lizards

Cryptoblepharus plagiocephalus several seen on tree trunks and on fallen limbs.

Menetia greyii (Ablepharus greyii) several in paddoeks.

Trachysaurus rugosus three speeimens seen erawling about.

Frogs

Three species of adult frogs were identified in Gingin Brook: Crinia insignifera, C. georgiana and Hyla adelaidensis.
