### Stenoma cymogramma, n. sp.

3. 18-19 mm. Head white, back of crown tinged grey. Palpi white, a dark grey streak on basal  $\frac{2}{3}$  of second joint, extreme base of terminal joint dark grey. Thorax light grey, shoulders narrowly whitish. Forewings slightly narrowed posteriorly, apex rounded, termen somewhat obliquely rounded; 2 from near angle, 3-5 approximated, 7 to costa; light brownish-grey, paler or whitishtinged towards costa anteriorly, costal edge white; three somewhat curved oblique dark fuscous lines, first two irregular, first from towards costa at  $\frac{1}{4}$  to dorsum beyond middle, thickened dorsally, second from middle of costa to dorsum at  $\frac{4}{5}$ , second discal stigma perceptible on this, third from costa at  $\frac{3}{4}$  rather abruptly curved on lower half to dorsum just before tornus; eight blackish marginal dots round posterior part of costa and termen: cilia whitish-grey, a grey subbasal shade. Hindwings 3 and 4 rather short-stalked; pale grey, whitish-tinged anteriorly; costa dilated on basal  $\frac{2}{3}$ , with fringe of white scales, a yellowish subcostal groove from base to middle; cilia whitish, a pale grey subbasal line. Forewings beneath with long ochreous-whitish expansible subdorsal hairpencil from base lying in subcostal groove of hindwings.

#### Stenoma neocrossa, n. sp.

J. 13 mm. Head ochreous-white. Palpi white, basal half and subapical ring of second joint, base and oblique supramedian ring of terminal joint dark fuscous. Thorax ochreous-white, suffused light grey posteriorly. Forewings suboblong, rounded, termen somewhat obliquely rounded; 2-5 closely approximated at base, 6 and 7 nearly approximated throughout, 7 indefinite; white, dorsal half tinged brownish; a fine dark fuscous median dash near base; stigmata moderate, dark fuscous, plical rather obliquely beyond first discal, a short oblique streak above and before first discal pointing to it; an undefined patch of fuscous suffusion extending along anterior half of dorsum and touching plical stigma; oblique transverse dark fuscous lines from costa at middle and \(\frac{3}{4}\), first straight, irregular, interrupted in disc, nearly preceding second discal stigma, second curved on lower half, dorsal half between these forming a fuscous blotch becoming dark fuscous anteriorly; three præmarginal black dots on apical part of costa, lowest largest, and two or three minute and undefined on termen: cilia white. Hindwings 3 and 4 moderately stalked; ochreouswhitish, suffused light grey posteriorly; a fringe of long raised ochreous-whitish hairs along lower margin of cell and basal half of vein 2; cilia whitish.

3 Q. 22-23 mm. Head white, crown pale grey except on sides. Palpi white, a streak on basal half of second joint, and base of terminal joint dark grey. Thorax grey, shoulders whitish. Fore-

wings oblong, apex rounded-obtuse, termen nearly vertical; 2-5 approximated at base, 7 to apex; white, in Q tinged ochreous except on costa; dorsal half ochreous-whitish, mainly occupied by three subquadrate dark grey blotches; in Q undefined longitudinal streaks of greyish suffusion anteriorly beneath costa and above middle; a better-marked longitudinal grey streak above anterior part of second dorsal blotch, shorter in d; a very oblique dark grey dash above end of cell, and a slight mark preceding it; a nearly straight dark grey line from beneath costa at  $\frac{3}{5}$  to posterior angle of third dorsal blotch; in d 3, in Q 6 dark grey præmarginal dots round apex and termen, largest about apex: cilia snow-white, basal third light grey on termen. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; light grey; cilia light grey, on costa white.

### Stenoma tetrapetra, n. sp.

Q. 25 mm. Head white. Palpi white, a grey streak on basal half of second joint. Thorax white, tinged grey posteriorly. Apex of abdomen yellowish. Forewings oblong, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rounded, little oblique; 2-5 approximated at base, 7 to apex; white; tour rather dark grey blotches occupying most of dorsum, not nearly reaching half across wing, first elongate, second and third subquadrate, fourth small, triangular, tornal; an indistinct greyish streak above middle from near base to  $\frac{1}{4}$ , and a stronger one in disc from  $\frac{1}{5}$  to  $\frac{2}{5}$ ; second discal stigma dark grey, three greyish longitudinal marks above cell forming a very oblique series pointing to this; a short fine grey dash beyond cell above middle; five minute dark grey dots on termen: cilia white. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; ochreous-whitish suffused pale grey on posterior half; cilia white.

## Stenoma cremastis, n. sp.

2. 24 mm. Head white, crown light grey except sides. Palpi white, a light greyish streak on basal half of second joint. Thorax grey, shoulders whitish. Forewings oblong, apex rounded, termen rounded, little oblique; 2-5 approximated at base, 7 to costa (indefinite); white, dorsal half mostly suffused pale ochreous-grey, somewhat darker towards dorsum anteriorly; three suffused dark grey dorsal blotches, not reaching half across wing, first subtriangular, before middle of wing, second subquadrate, about 3, third small, triangular, tornal; a small dark grey spot in disc at 1; second discal stigma dark fuscous, a short oblique fuscous mark above cell before this; a faint interrupted incurved fuscous line from costa at 4 to apex of third dorsal spot; 5 or 6 dark fuscous marginal dots round apex and termen: cilia white, on tornus tinged greyish. Hindwings 3 and 4 in Jurimaguas specimen coincident (probably an abnormality), in Manaos specimen shortstalked; pale grey, rather darker posteriorly; cilia whitish-grey, round apex white.

Peru, Jurimaguas, March (type); Brazil, Manaos, November (Parish); 2 ex. These agree so well, especially in the peculiar and very characteristic form of the posterior line of forewings, that I regard them as identical, notwithstanding the different neuration of hindwings.

### Stenoma subdulcis, n. sp.

3. 16 mm. Head white. Palpi white, a dark fuscous streak on basal half of second joint. Thorax very pale grey, shoulders white. Forewings oblong, costa nearly straight posteriorly, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen vertical, nearly straight; 2 from towards angle, 7 to termen; pale grey; a broad white costal band from base to near apex, posteriorly pointed, costal edge ochreous-tinged, below band a streak of whitish-ochreous suffusion to end of cell; an inwards-oblique irregular dark fuscous streak from dorsum beyond middle to fold, some slight suffusion about fold before and beyond this; a waved ochreous-whitish terminal line: cilia white. Hindwings 3 and 4 almost connate, 6 and 7 nearly approximated at base; light grey; cilia white.

### Stenoma chloromis, Meyr.

A fresher example from La Cambre, Honduras, is 29 mm., with head light violet-grey, thorax yellow-ochreous, forewings with grey area extended to costa on basal fourth, leaving a broad white costal band beyond this.

## Stenoma remorsa, n. sp.

Q. 30 mm. Head white. Palpi white, a streak on basal half of second joint, and base of terminal joint dark fuscous. Thorax whitish-ochreous, a quadrate blackish dorsal spot. Forewings oblong, slightly expanded posteriorly, costa almost straight, apex rectangular, termen almost straight, vertical; 2 from towards angle, 7 to termen; whitish-ochreous; an oval blackish blotch along anterior half of dorsum; a triangular blackish blotch extending in disc from \frac{1}{3} to \frac{2}{3}, separated from preceding by an oblique curved streak of groundcolour, and connected with dorsum by an oblique blackish streak beyond this; four blackish interneural streaks in costal area; on terminal area a band formed of confluent interneural streaks of grey suffusion, not reaching discal blotch or termen: cilia whitish-ochreous, basal half grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate, 6 and 7 nearly approximated towards base; light grey, rather darker towards apex; cilia whitish-ochreous, round apex suffused light grey.

Q. 25 mm. Head ochreous-white. Palpi white, second joint whitish-ochreous except tip. Thorax whitish-ochreous. Forewings somewhat dilated posteriorly, apex rounded, termen rounded, little

oblique; 2 from very near angle, 7 to apex (indefinite); white, costal edge whitish-ochreous; a dark fuscous patch extending along anterior half of dorsum but leaving dorsum slenderly ochreous-white, reaching nearly half across wing, at base touching costa, immediately beyond it a pale ochreous triangular dorsal blotch, followed by an inwards-oblique broad dark fuscous fasciate blotch from tornus reaching  $\frac{3}{4}$  across wing, suffused posteriorly and above: cilia white, towards tornus whitish-ochreous suffused grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate, 6 and 7 approximated towards base; yellow-whitish; cilia yellow-whitish, on costa about  $\frac{2}{3}$  a broad patch of long projecting grey scales.

&. 26-28 mm. Head white, sides of forehead fuscous. Palpi white or whitish, second joint fuscous. Thorax white, shoulders dark fuscous. Forewings elongate, rather dilated, apex obtuse, termen slightly rounded, somewhat oblique; 2-5 approximated, 7 to termen; dark fuscous; a broad white costal streak from near base to beyond middle, ends pointed, costal edge pale ochreous; an irregular-edged rounded white apical blotch extending on costa to  $\frac{2}{3}$ ; a slender pale brownish-ochreous dorsal streak throughout, expanded into a triangular postmedian blotch tipped white, tornal extremity also white: cilia round tornus pale brownish-ochreous, round apical blotch white, between these grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate, 6 and 7 connate; whitish-ochreous suffused light grey, apex whitish; cilia concolorous, on costa at  $\frac{2}{3}$  a thickened patch of ochreous-grey scales.

## Stenoma leucosaris, n. sp.

J. 20 mm. Head whitish. Palpi white, second joint lilacbrown. Thorax light lilac-ochreous, shoulders whitish. Forewings suboblong, apex rounded, termen vertical; 2-5 approximated, 8 to apex (indefinite); light lilac-ochreous; costal edge very finely whitish-ochreous, towards base fuscous; markings rather dark purplish-fuscous; stigmata moderate, plical very obliquely beyond first discal; a small mark on costa at \frac{1}{3}; a dot towards costa before middle; flattened-triangular spots on costa about middle and  $\frac{3}{4}$ , from first an interrupted shade strongly curved round beyond second discal stigma, thence nearly straight to dorsum about \(\frac{2}{3}\) but nearly obsolete on lower portion, from second a transverse series of dots excurved in disc, rather indented above and sinuate below this, running to dorsum near tornus; a terminal series of cloudy dots obscurely coppery-tinged: cilia pale glossy violet-grey. Hindwings costa somewhat expanded, 3 and 4 connate; ochreous-whitish, an undefined terminal band of light grey suffusion; cilia whitish, round apex and upper half of termen a grey subbasal shade. Forewings beneath with long whitish fringe on 1 a from base reaching end of cell.

Peru, Papitinga, June (Parish); 1 ex. Extremely similar to siraphora, but apex of forewings more rounded, subdorsal fringe in siraphora yellowish and reaching to beyond end of cell, hindwings more suffused grey.

## Stenoma clysmographa, n. sp.

3. 30 mm. Head whitish-brown. Palpi whitish, second joint suffused light brownish. Thorax light brownish. Forewings rather dil ted, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen straight, vertical; from towards angle, 8 to termen; without subdorsal fringe beneath; brown; markings suffused, pale greyish, viz., an irregular blotch towards costa before middle, a roundish spot about fold beneath this, two small dots longitudinally placed in disc beyond middle, some slight irroration towards costa about  $\frac{2}{3}$ , a curved subterminal shade from above middle to dorsum, thickened in disc and with waved posterior edge, and a terminal streak becoming obsolete towards extremities; a terminal row of dark fuscous dots: cilia pale brownish-grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 very short-stalked; dark fuscous; cilia grey, suffused darker towards base.

## Stenoma phaeomystis, n. sp.

Palpi whitish, second joint externally and terminal joint anteriorly suffused brownish. Antennæ scaled dorsally towards middle, ciliations under 1. Thorax dark brown, patagia brown suffused brownish-ochreous anteriorly. Abdomen blackish. Forewings rather dilated posteriorly, apex obtuse, termen slightly sinuate, somewhat oblique; 2 from very near angle, 8 to apex; violet-fuscous, becoming ochreous-brown towards costa posteriorly, and dark purple-brown towards dorsum and termen, dorsal edge suffused blackish; cilia brownish, base pale ochreous-brown on upper part of termen. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate, 6 and 7 stalked; grey irrorated blackish hairscales; cilia light grey, a darker subbasal line.

## Stenoma capnocrossa, n. sp.

J. 25 mm. Head, thorax pale brownish-ochreous, face whitish-ochreous. Palpi ochreous-whitish, second joint pale ochreous infuscated externally except apex. Forewings moderate, somewhat dilated, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen straight, vertical; 2 from near angle, 8 to termen; light brownish-ochreous; plical and second discal stigmata very small, dark fuscous: cilia whitish-ochreous, on termen rather dark fuscous. Hindwings 3-5 nearly approximated at base; rather dark grey; cilia whitish-grey.

3 9. 21-22 mm. Head, thorax light greyish-ochreous, face ochreous-whitish. Palpi ochreous-grey-whitish, an obscure

purplish-grey streak on basal half of second joint. Forewings slightly dilated, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rounded, vertical; 2 from near angle, 8 to apex (very indefinite); greyish-ochreous; three obscure rather irregular grey transverse lines, first rather curved, rather oblique, lower half forming posterior limit of a triangular purple dorsal blotch, somewhat marbled with ground-colour, second and third obtusely angulated in middle, space between these forming a suffused purplish blotch on dorsal half; second discal stigma forming a dark grey transverse mark preceding second line; a fuscous terminal line: cilia pale grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; grey; cilia pale grey. Thorax 3 with a moderately long whitish hairpencil lying along side from beneath base of forewings.

& Q. 20-24 mm. Head, thorax ferruginous-ochreous, face whitish-ochreous. Palpi ochreous tinged ferruginous or fuscous. Forewings suboblong, apex rounded, termen rounded, vertical; 2-5 approximated, 8 to apex (indefinite); pale ochreous; markings formed of suffused brown or ferruginous-brown irroration, viz., a basal patch of which edge runs from  $\frac{1}{4}$  of costa to middle of dorsum, separated by a pale streak from a moderate parallel fascia, this nearly followed by an irregular parallel line traversing a linear transverse dark fuscous mark on end of cell, and a premarginal fascia covering more than  $\frac{1}{3}$  of costa and narrowed to tornus, its anterior edge curved; a terminal series of small black dots: cilia pale ochreous, a light brownish antemedian line. Hindwings 3 and 4 com ate; light ochreous-yellow, dorsal third more or less tinged grey; cilia pale yellow.

Q. 22 mm. Head ochreous-whitish, face whiter. Palpi white, second joint suffused light greyish-ochreous except apex. Thorax whitish-ochreous. Forewings apex rounded-obtuse, termen nearly straight, nearly vertical; 2–5 nearly approximated, 8 to just above apex; whitish-yellowish, beyond an irregular line from  $\frac{1}{4}$  of dorsum to costa near apex light grey, division suffused; plical and second discal stigmata minute, black; a semioval black spot on middle of costa; a very small black spot on costa at  $\frac{4}{5}$ , whence a slightly curved series of faint grey dots runs to tornus; a terminal series of small black dots: cilia ochreous-whitish. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; light grey; cilia ochreous-whitish.

### Stenoma ochrosaris, n. sp.

♂♀. 17 mm. Head white. Palpi white, second joint with grey lateral streak except towards apex. Thorax light greyishochreous, outer margin of patagia whitish. Ovipositor of 2 broadly flattened laterally. Forewings slightly dilated, costa somewhat sinuate, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen nearly straight, hardly oblique; 2 from near angle, 8 to termen; pale greyish-ochreous, costal edge whitish; three dark fuscous costal spots, first beyond  $\frac{1}{4}$ , very small, second postmedian, elongate, flattened-triangular, third at  $\frac{4}{5}$ , somewhat smaller, semioval; stigmata very small, dark fuscous, plical obliquely beyond first discal; an evenly curved series of small indistinct fuscous dots from third costal spot to tornus; an almost marginal series of small dark fuscous dots round apex and termen: cilia whitish-ochreous. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate or closely approximated; ♂ light grey, ♀ grey-whitish; in & a subdorsal groove containing a long expansible yellowochreous hairpencil from base; cilia whitish.

very similar tricharacta by ovipositor.

Forewings suboblong, hardly dilated, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen nearly straight, vertical; 2-5 approximated, 8 to termen; greyish-ochreous or light fuscous, sometimes tinged

purplish towards dorsum anteriorly, costal edge whitish-ochreous; three semioval or subtriangular dark fuscous costal spots, first at \(\frac{1}{4}\), small, others moderate, second median, third about \(\frac{4}{5}\); stigmata faintly darker or obsolete, very small; a rather sinuate series of small fuscous dots from third costal spot to tornus; a marginal series of small dark fuscous dots round apex and termen: cilia pale greyish-ochreous, on termen suffused fuscous, with darker median line. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; grey, in \(\tau\) darker; cilia whitish-grey, a darker subbasal shade.

Forewings somewhat dilated, apex obtuse, termen nearly straight, hardly oblique; 2–5 approximated, 8 to apex; light fuscous irrorated grey-whitish; extreme costal edge yellowish except towards base; some undefined fuscous suffusion on costa at  $\frac{1}{3}$ , and semioval dark fuscous spots beyond middle and at  $\frac{4}{3}$ ; a blotch of brownish suffusion on middle of dorsum; second discal stigma dark fuscous; several indistinct darker dots in a subterminal series on lower part of wing; a marginal series of black dots round apex and termen: cilia light yellow-brownish. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; pale ochreous-yellowish, posterior half suffused grey, terminal edge yellowish; cilia light yellowish, dorsum clothed with pale yellowish hairs.

Forewings rather dilated, apex obtuse-rectangular, termen faintly sinuate, hardly oblique; 2-5 approximated, 8 to termen; pale lilac-grey, costal edge ochreous-yellow; stigmata fuscous, plical obliquely beyond first discal; a spot of faint brownish suffusion on middle of dorsum; a small fuscous spot beneath costal edge in middle, whence a series of cloudy undefined fuscous dots rather strongly excurved in disc runs to dorsum about  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; a rather large triangular fuscous spot beneath costal edge towards apex, whence a curved series of small dark fuscous dots runs to tornus; a terminal series of small black dots: cilia grey-whitish, partially suffused lilac-fuscous on termen. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; pale ochreous-yellowish; cilia whitish-yellowish.

Forewings moderately broad, rather dilated, apex rounded-obtuse, termen straight, hardly oblique; 2 from near angle, 8 to termen; violet-fuscous; a transverse dark brown spot on end of cell, sometimes broken into two, upper part centred brownish-ochreous: cilia light violet-fuscous. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; dark grey; cilia grey.

### Stenoma camptospila, n. sp.

3. 21-22 mm. Head whitish. Palpi white, second joint light grey except apex. Thorax whitish-grey-ochreous. Forewings dilated, apex obtuse, termen nearly straight, hardly oblique; 2-5 closely approximated, 8 to termen; pale greyish-ochreous; about five small blackish dots in disc in two transverse series at about \frac{1}{3} and before middle; a transverse dark fuscous spot filled with ochreous in disc beyond middle, its lower end produced obliquely towards tornus as a dark fuscous lobe with apex expanded; an undefined cloud of light fuscous suffusion on costa towards apex, whence a hardly traceable faint pale fuscous rather curved shade runs to tornus; a terminal series of small dark fuscous dots: cilia whitish-ochreous, on termen partially suffused pale violet-fuscous. Hindwings 3 and 4 very short-stalked; whitish-yellowish, yellower towards apex; cilia whitish-yellowish.

Forewings somewhat dilated, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rounded, vertical; 2–5 approximated, 8 to termen (indefinite); ochreous-white; a small very oblique dark fuscous mark on costa at  $\frac{1}{4}$ , and a small blackish spot on dorsum at  $\frac{1}{4}$ , some brownish scales tending to indicate an irregular curved line between these; stigmata very small, indistinct, fuscous, plical obliquely beyond first discal, some faint irregular brownish suffusion towards median area of dorsum; a moderate blackish spot on middle of costa, whence a faint undefined irregular curved line of brownish irroration runs to dorsum at  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; a rather large semioval blackish spot on costa at  $\frac{4}{5}$ , whence a curved series of dark fuscous dots runs to tornus; a terminal series of dark fuscous sublinear dots: cilia whitish-ochreous. Forewings moderate, rather dilated, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rounded, little oblique; 2 from towards angle, 7 to termen; lilac-whitish, costal edge white; dorsal area beneath fold tinged lilac-brownish, with scattered dark fuscous scales, a few lilac-brown scales scattered in disc about stigmata; a fine line of dark fuscous scales along dorsal edge from about \(\frac{1}{4}\) to tornus; stigmata dark fuscous, plical very obliquely beyond first discal, second discal transverse-linear; cloudy grey subtriangular spots on costa about middle and  $\frac{4}{5}$ , from second a curved series of cloudy fuscous dots to tornus, between veins 3-9 a curved series of rather larger similar dots midway between this and end of cell; a marginal series of blackish dots round apex and termen: cilia whitish, base spotted light grey. Forewings oblong, apex rounded, termen rounded, nearly vertical; 2-5 approximated, 8 to apex (indefinite): light moss-green; markings deep moss-green; a rather oblique fasciate blotch from dorsum towards base reaching half across wing; a moderate spot on middle of costa; a linear transverse mark on end of cell; a straight transverse subterminal line: cilia whitish-green. Hindwings and cilia green-whitish; 3 and 4 connate.

Forewings slightly dilated, costa slightly sinuate in middle, apex obtuse-pointed, termen sinuate, little oblique; 2-5 approximated, 8 to termen; light ochreous-fuscous, becoming more ochreous-tinged posteriorly, a subcostal spot of ochreous suffusion at base; a triangular dark fuscous spot with rounded apex on middle of costa; second discal stigma forming a small transverse-linear fuscous mark; a slight dark brown mark from costa about \(\frac{2}{3}\), whence a rather strongly curved series of small indistinct dots runs to near dorsum at \(\frac{4}{5}\); dorsal edge tinged brown except towards extremities: cilia concolorous with wing. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; grey closely irrorated dark grey; cilia whitish-grey, a grey basal shade.

Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; ochreouswhitish; a narrow grey marginal streak round posterior 2/5 of costa and upper part of termen, narrowed and obsolescent downwards; cilia ochreous-grey-whitish, basal half grey round apex and upper part of termen.

Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; ochreous-whitish; a short dark grey almost marginal streak round apex; cilia whitish, round apex base dark grey.

Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; grey; a fringe of long pale ochreous-yellowish expansible hairs from near dorsal edge on basal half projecting directly inwards beneath abdomen; cilia whitish-grey.

Forewings suboblong, slightly dilated, costa on basal third with triangular raised or partially reflexed flap fringed with rough scales towards its apex, then straight, apex rectangular, termen faintly sinuate, vertical; 2 from near angle, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; iridescent-whitish-grey; costal edge ochreous-white from flap; stigmata grey, plical obliquely beyond first diseal; a strongly curved series of cloudy greyish dots from towards costa at \(\frac{3}{2}\) to near dorsum at \(\frac{3}{4}\), interrupted in middle by a round cloudy light grey-brownish spot; a strongly curved subterminal series of fuscous dots, sinuate inwards towards costa; a terminal series of blackish-grey dots: cilia whitish. Hindwings 3 and 4 very short-stalked; light grey, becoming light greyish-ochreous towards apex; cilia ochreous-whitish.

Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; ochreous-whitish, tinged greyish-ochreous towards apex; a fringe of long whitish-ochreous expansible hairs from near dorsum on upper half projecting inwards beneath abdomen; cilia ochreous-whitish, a faint greyish subbasal shade.

Hindwings 4 absent, 3 and 5 connate; grey; cilia whitish, a grey subbasal shade.

Forewings suboblong, slightly dilated, apex obtuse, termen vertical; 2 from near angle, 8 to termen; ochreous, somewhat lighter towards costa anteriorly; dorsal edge fuscous from near base to termen; plical and second discal stigmata small, dark fuscous, first discal indicated by faint fuscous suffusion; a faintly indicated streak of slight fuscous suffusion from middle of costa

to dorsum at  $\frac{2}{3}$ , angulated beyond second discal stigma; a gently curved line of fuscous scales from costa at  $\frac{3}{4}$  to dorsum towards tornus; some slight fuscous speckling towards termen: cilia light grey tinged ochreous, tips pale. Forewings somewhat dilated, apex rounded, termen vertical; 2 from near angle, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; pale grey; costal edge pale ochreous; markings light ferruginous-brownish, darker towards costa and partially on edges; a dot near base in middle; a triangular patch extending on dorsum from near base to middle, its apex confluent with a spot on costa at  $\frac{1}{3}$ , its posterior edge with a projection in disc; a transverse-oval spot representing second discal stigma; a triangular spot on middle of costa, whence a shade strongly excurved beyond second discal stigma runs to dorsum at 3/4, its extremity produced each way on dorsal edge; a larger triangular spot on costa at 3, whence a gently curved series of small cloudy spots runs to tornus; a marginal series of blackish dots round apex and termen: cilia pale brownish-ochreous becoming whitish towards tips. J. 17 mm. Head, thorax pale greyish-ochreous, face whitish, patagia dark brown. Palpi white, second joint dark grey except apex, terminal joint grey anteriorly towards apex, base dark grey. Forewings suboblong, costa hardly sinuate, apex rounded, termen nearly vertical; 2-5 approximated, 7 to apex; light greyish-violet; basal third of dorsum and projecting scales ferruginous-brown; a fine white longitudinal line from base just above this extending to middle; costal edge whitish; a slender blackish streak from costa at 1 to dorsum near tornus, expanded on costa, partially tinged brownish on its edges, margined with a whitish streak anteriorly to fold and posteriorly beyond fold, preceded on fold by a small greyish and ochreous tuft; space between this and next streak mixed or tinged whitish-ochreous; an oblique dark brown whitemargined fasciate streak from middle of costa reaching half across wing, then becoming black and continued by a blackish line to dorsum where it almost meets apex of preceding; apical fourth of wing forming a blotch with anterior edge slightly convex, its anterior half whitish, posterior pale ochreous; a marginal series of blackish dots round apex and termen: cilia pale ochreous, a faint brownish line. Forewings hardly dilated, apex rounded, termen vertical; 2-5 approximated, 7 to apex (indefinite); pale glossy greyish-ochreous; costa suffused grey on basal fourth; a dark grey dot near base in middle; stigmata small, dark grey, plical obliquely beyond first discal; an oblique grey mark on middle of costa; a rather strongly curved series of blackish dots from costa at \(\frac{3}{4}\) to tornus, slightly sinuate towards costa and below middle; a marginal series of blackish dots round apex and termen: cilia pale greyish-ochreous, a dark grey subbasal line. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; grey; cilia light grey.

Forewings rather elongate-oblong, apex rounded-obtuse, termen vertical; 2-5 approximated, 6 and 7 slightly approximated at tip, 7 to apex (indefinite); ochreous-grey-whitish; second discal stigma dark fuscous; sometimes some fuscous irroration towards base of costa and dorsum; an oblique blackish-grey mark on costa at  $\frac{1}{3}$ , whence a faint interrupted brownish shade runs to some suffusion on dorsum about middle; a triangular blackish-grey spot on middle of costa, whence a similar faint shade runs to some dorsal suffusion at \(\frac{3}{4}\); a larger triangular blackish-grey spot on costa about  $\frac{3}{4}$ , whence a curved brownish line runs to tornus; some black marginal dots round apex and termen, largest at and above apex, on termen connected by a fuscous line: cilia whitish or grey-whitish, a dark fuscous subbasal shade at and above apex. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; pale grey, rather darker towards apex; cilia grey-whitish.

Forewings somewhat dilated, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rounded, little oblique; 2-5 approximated, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; pale ochreous, veins posteriorly obscurely suffused fuscous, costal edge whitish, margined fuscous beneath; stigmata blackish, plical obliquely beyond first discal; an irregular strongly curved subterminal series of dark fuscous undefined dots, deeply indented towards costa; a marginal series of dark fuscous dots round apex and termen: cilia white, basal half whitish-ochreous. Hindwings 3-5 nearly approximated

#### Stenoma crocosticta, n. sp.

Head, thorax pale greyish-ochreous, face whitish. d. 23 mm. Palpi white, second joint with dark grey streak terminating in supramedian ring, terminal joint with base and tip blackish. Forewings hardly dilated, apex rounded, termen rounded, hardly oblique; 2-5 approximated, 7 to apex (indefinite); pale greyishochreous; a greyish-ferruginous dot on fold near base, and dark grey elongate dot obliquely beyond and above it; stigmata ferruginous, plical obliquely beyond first discal; a series of indistinct light ferruginous dots from beneath middle of costa very obliquely outwards to beyond second discal, then acutely angulated and continued faint and irregular to some suffusion above dorsum beyond middle; a series of cloudy subcrescentic ferruginous dots becoming dark grey towards costa, from beneath costa at  $\frac{3}{5}$  very obliquely outwards strongly curved near termen and continued slightly sinuate to near dorsum about  $\frac{4}{5}$ ; a marginal series of dark ferruginous-grev dots round posterior part of eosta and termen: cilia white. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; ochreous-whitish; cilia white, base ochreous-tinged.

Head, thorax pale greyish-ochreous, face ♂ ♀. 18-19 mm. whitish. Palpi white, second joint with dark grey streak to above middle, base and apex of terminal joint dark grey. Forewings somewhat dilated, apex obtuse, termen rounded, slightly oblique; 2 from near angle, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; light greyish-ochreous, veins suffused light fuscous; a slightly indicated fuscous dot at base of fold; stigmata blackish, plical obliquely beyond first discal; a blackish dot towards costa before middle, from beyond this a series connected by fuscous shading strongly curved round second discal stigma, indented on fold, to dorsum at  $\frac{2}{3}$ ; a curved series of cloudy blackish dots connected by slight fuscous suffusion from costa at 4 to dorsum before tornus, indented beneath costa, apical area beyond this suffused fuscous; a marginal series of black dots round apex and termen: cilia whitish-ochreous, tips whitish. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; rather dark grey; cilia whitish-grey, a grey subbasal shade.

3. 16 mm. Head, thorax whitish-ochreous, face whitish. Palpi whitish, basal  $\frac{2}{3}$  of second joint dark grey, base and tip of

terminal joint blackish. Forewings slightly dilated, apex roundedobtuse, termen vertical; 2 from near angle, 7 to termen, 8 to costa;
whitish-ochreous slightly and irregularly sprinkled light fuscous; a
small indistinct fuscous spot towards base above middle connected
with dorsum by a striga; stigmata blackish, plical obliquely beyond
first discal; an inwards-oblique suffused blackish spot from middle
of dorsum reaching to just before plical stigma; triangular blackish
spots on costa at middle and \(\frac{3}{4}\), from second a strongly curved waved
blackish line near termen to tornus; a marginal series of blackish
dots round apical part of costa and termen: cilia whitish-ochreous.

Forewings gradually dilated, apex obtuse, termen nearly straight, hardly oblique; 2 from near angle, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; pale violet-grey; costal edge whitish-ochreous; plical and second discal stigmata blackish-grey; an evenly curved grey line from a blackish-grey thickening on costa at  $\frac{4}{5}$  near termen to tornus; a marginal series of blackish dots round apical part of costa and termen: cilia whitish. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; rather dark grey; cilia light grey.

3. 13 mm. Head dark violet-grey, face whitish. Palpi whitish externally suffused grey. Thorax bronzy-greyish-ochreous anteriorly suffused dark grey. Forewings slightly dilated, apex rounded, termen rather obliquely rounded; 2-5 approximated, 7 to costa; light brownish-ochreous speckled grey; costal and apical edge suffused ferruginous, base of costa grey; second discal stigma small, dark grey; cilia light grey, towards tornus whitish, round apex a darker grey subbasal shade. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; grey; cilia whitish-grey, a grey subbasal shade.

Forewings posteriorly dilated, costa strongly arched posteriorly, apex rounded-obtuse, termen rather obliquely rounded; 2-5 approximated, 6 to apex; ochreous-brown, on posterior third thinly strewn elongate flat pale violet-grey scales tipped blackish, a few also about fold; costal edge ochreous-rosy throughout, edged beneath greyish-violet; plical and second discal stigmata blackish: cilia light brownish-

grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 short-stalked; ochreous-yellow; cilia light yellowish tinged rosy.

3. 31 mm. Head, thorax whitish-fuscous speckled fuscous, face suffused whitish. Palpi whitish, second joint suffused fuscous. Forewings widest beyond middle, costa moderately arched, apex obtuse, termen somewhat oblique; 2-5 approximated, 7 to apex; whitish-fuscous closely speckled fuscous, anterior half of costa rather suffused fuscous; three nearly parallel oblique transverse dark fuscous lines, first before middle, not reaching margins, second beyond middle, becoming more oblique dorsally and ending in tornus, between first and second a parallel fascia of fuscous suffusion not reaching dorsum, third slightly excurved and meeting second on tornus; a dark fuscous dorsal line from  $\frac{1}{5}$  to  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; a suffused dark fuscous line round posterior part of costa and termen: cilia whitish-fuscous speckled fuscous. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; rather dark grey; cilia pale grey.

Forewings rather broad, broadest in middle, costa strongly arched, apex rounded off, termen rounded, rather oblique; 2-4 approximated, 6 to apparent (false) apex; pale greyish-ochreous, slightly greyer-tinged along costa towards apex; an indistinct acutely dentate whitish line running round upper margin of cell, and a transverse mark on end of cell; an almost marginal series of small indistinct whitish spots round apex and termen: cilia whitish-ochreous. Hindwings 3 and 4 very short-stalked; ochreous-whitish; cilia white.

Forewings widest before middle, costa moderately arched, apex rounded, termen somewhat obliquely rounded; 2-5 approximated, 6 to apex (apparent); ochreous-grey-brownish, with strong violet gloss; extreme costal edge white; a rounded rosy-ochreous spot on end of cell, obscurely edged whitish; several minute whitish dots on apical margin: cilia purple-greyish. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; blackish-grey; cilia grey, a dark grey subbasal line.

Forewings suboblong, apex rounded off, termen rounded, vertical; 2-5 approximated, 6 to apex (apparent); light greyish-ochreous strewn dark grey dots and strigulæ; costal edge light ochreous except towards extremities; an undefined spot of grey suffusion about middle of costa; a round ochreous-greenish spot on end of cell, enclosing a more or less expressed blackish dot, beneath this is a small white dot; in one specimen an indistinct spot of greenish tinge before tornus: cilia light grey, tips paler. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; pale greyish; cilia pale ochreous, whitish towards tips.

3. 20 mm. Head ochreous-whitish, sides of face ferruginous. Palpi whitish, second joint infuscated except apex. Thorax ochreous, a grey posterior spot. Forewings slightly broadest before middle, costa anteriorly moderately arched, apex rounded, termen rather obliquely rounded; 2 from near angle, 6 to apex (indefinite); light brown strewn grey dots and strigulæ; costal edge ochreous-yellowish; a light moss-green somewhat darker-mottled patch occupying posterior part of wing except a narrow terminal fascia of greyish suffusion, anterior edge running from costa at  $\frac{2}{5}$  directly half across wing, then outwards to end of cell, and again directly to dorsum at  $\frac{2}{3}$ , a white dot on lower angle of cell: cilia whitish-ochreous tinged grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; whitish-yellowish, basal half partially suffused pale grey; cilia whitish-yellowish, yellower round apex.

### Stenoma horometra, n. sp.

3.25 mm. Head whitish, more or less greyish on crown. Palpi whitish, second joint greyish. Thorax light grey. Forewings somewhat dilated, apex obtuse, termen slightly rounded, scarcely oblique; 2–5 closely approximated, 7 to termen, 8 to costa; whitish closely irrorated fuscous; several suffused dark brown lines, viz., one slightly curved subdorsal from base to tornus, two parallel oblique from costa before  $\frac{1}{3}$  and at middle running into this, one from costa at  $\frac{3}{4}$  running into second of these below middle, one rising out of this above middle, running halfway to termen, then right-angled to subdorsal line near tornus, and one round apex and termen; some fine dark brown interneural lines towards termen but not reaching it or preceding line: cilia light grey. Hindwings 3 and 4 connate; grey; cilia whitish-grey, a grey subbasal shade.

Forewings widest about middle, costa strongly arched, apex rounded, termen rather obliquely rounded; 2-5 approximated, 6 to apex (indefinite); dark violet-fuscous, lighter and browner anteriorly; second discal stigma small, grey-whitish; a terminal series of blackish marks preceded by more or less obscure whitish suffusion: cilia fuscous, basal half on termen ochreous-whitish spotted dark fuscous, on costa dark fuscous. Hindwings 3 and 4 very short-stalked; rather dark grey, on basal half more blackish-grey; cilia grey, a darker subbasal shade.

Forewings and hindwings beneath with broad yellow-ochreous costal bands, sometimes some grey suffusion at apex of forewings.
