Hypera punctatua. 6 - taken during spring and summer of 1947 under wood.

Not taken elsewhere in Wellington District. I have one from Nanaimo and one from Tofino on the West Coast.

Brachyrhinus ovatus. Fairly common. Not frequent elsewhere, usually in dry situations.
