the regulations for the use of visitors, and other matters of interest. A research laboratory has recently been erected and several investigations of considerable importance, chiefly botanical, have been initiated. The committee in their report regret to have to state that although the Terns arrived in the colony in their usual numbers in 1913, the number of young birds was much smaller than usual, owing, it is believed, to the late arrival of the whitebait on which the young are fed.

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
