

[The following Addendum to Mr. H. E. Andrewes' Note on Bonelli's "Tableau Synoptique," pp. 89-92, has been received.—Ed.]

As a result of the publication of this note, my friend Mr. G. de Lapouge, of the University of Poitiers, kindly sent me for examination an original separate of Bonelli's "Observations Entomologiques-Première partie," in which the "Tableau" (printed) is inserted between pp. 12 and 13. Mr. Sherborn has compared the MS. copy of the Natural History Museum Library with this, and corrected one or two copyist's errors. The chief one is the omission of the star against *Agonum* and *Anchomenus*, and these genera must therefore rank with those referred to in the note "Genus novum aut cujus characteres elaborantur."

The reference to the genus *Diplochila* will not, I fear, have been understood, for the line containing the characters attributed to *Carabus impressus* F., and following the genus *Amara*, was inserted in MS. by Bonelli in his own copy and is not to be found in the copy now before me.
