Fig. 1. Simple hair.

2. Hair, with slight swelling near the base, as found in scopæ of *Andrena albicans* ♂.
3. Straight spiral hair, stomach of *Megachile argentata*.
4. Ordinary plumose hairs off *Megachile maritima*, found also on the metathorax and body of many species.
5. Branched hair, metathorax of *Colletes cunicularia*.
6. Do. do. *Colletes succincta*.
7. Do. scopæ of *Macropis labiata* ♀.
8. Hair, with filamentary branches; pollen-brush of *Chelostoma*.
9. Do. tuft on metathorax of *Andrena dorsata*.
10. Hair, with branches on one side only, off scopæ of *Andrena Afzeliella* ♀.
11. Do. do.
12. Rigidly-branched hair from scopæ of *Colletes cunicularia* ♀.
- 12a. Do. do.
13. Spiral hair, with flattened and dilated apex, off inner side of scopæ of *Andrena varians*.
14. Metathoracic hair of *Prosopis communis*.
15. Scopæ hair of *Cilissa leporina* ♀, showing pollen grains adhering.
16. Portion of a hair off scopæ of *Dasygaster hirtipes* ♀, showing the club-shaped ends of the branches.
