I HAVE thought it desirable to give a figure (Pl. XXIII. fig. 7) of this interesting species, as it is the only one which has yet been discovered in the New World, and will form a good appendix to my notice of the genus *Ceria*, vol. iv. p. 63, of the Transactions of this Society. It was found by Mr. Gosse in Jamaica, and appears to be rare, as only a single specimen was sent home. The specimen is imperfect, wanting the antennæ.
