OPINION 1740

Amicytheridea Bate, 1975 (Crustacea, Ostracoda): A. triangulata Bate, 1975 designated as the type species

Ruling

- (1) Under the plenary powers all previous fixations of type species for the nominal genus *Amicytheridea* Bate, 1975 are hereby set aside and *Amicytheridea triangulata* Bate, 1975 is designated as type species.
- (2) The name *Amicytheridea* Bate, 1975 (gender: feminine), type species by designation under the plenary powers in (1) above *Amicytheridea triangulata* Bate, 1975, is hereby placed on the Official List of Generic Names in Zoology.
- (3) The name triangulata Bate, 1975, as published in the binomen Amicytheridea triangulata (specific name of the type species of Amicytheridea Bate, 1975), is hereby placed on the Official List of Specific Names in Zoology.

History of Case 2789

An application for the designation of *Amicytheridea triangulata* Bate, 1975 as the type species of *Amicytheridea* Bate, 1975 was received from Drs S.C. Khosla, S.R. Jakhar & M.H. Mohammed (*M.L. Sukhadia University, Udaipur, India*) on 13 September 1990. After correspondence the case was published in BZN 49: 116–117 (June 1992). Notice of the case was sent to appropriate journals.

Decision of the Commission

On 1 March 1993 the members of the Commission were invited to vote on the proposals published in BZN 49: 117. At the close of the voting period on 1 June 1993 the votes were as follows:
