A LIST OF THE BEETLES OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

INTRODUCTION

The following is a list of the Coleoptera known to occur in San Diego County, California. The number of forms included, 1649 species and subspecies, I am certain can be greatly increased by more extensive collecting; but, however incomplete it may be, it is hoped that this list will be an aid to collectors in this region. For this reason I have given exact localities, dates of capture, and some ecological data.

As long ago as 1874 a paper on the Coleoptera of San Diego County was written by Mr. O. N. Sanford, first treasurer of the San Diego Society of Natural History, and read before the Society on November 30 of that year. Installments were later published in the San Diego Daily Union of December 2 and 30, 1874, and January 20, 1875. The only other studies of San Diego County beetles to be published as such are the notes on certain families by Dr. F. E. Blaisdell, which appeared in "Zoe," Vol. 3, Nos. 1 to 4, 1892-1893.

For convenience, I have adopted the terminology of the Lengl "Catalogue" and its supplements; and the numbers in parentheses following the names of species are those of the Leng list. All bibliographical references up to and including the year 1932 are to be found in Leng; subsequent references may be located through the Entomological Literature Department of the "Entomological News."

I have freely quoted from the "List of the Coleoptera of Southern California" by Dr. H. C. Fall. 2 which I have found indispensable in many ways. I have used it as a starting point for published records, and have added to the references contained in it all those relating to San Diego County which could be found in entomological literature since its publication.

I want to acknowledge my deep indebtedness to Dr. Frank E. Blaisdell, of the California Academy of Sciences, for his constant and untiring aid in making determinations, for his kindness in reading and checking the manuscript, and for the use of the extensive material in his collection that was secured in San Diego County years ago; to Mr. George H. Field for the thorough collecting he has done within the County over a period of thirty years, the result of which, an outstanding collection that includes a large majority of the species in this list, is now deposited in the San Diego Society of Natural History; to Mr. Clinton G. Abbott, Director, for the use of the collections, library. and other facilities of the San Diego Society of Natural History; to Mr. E. P. Van Duzee for many valuable suggestions and for the use of the collections and library of the California Academy of Sciences; to Mr. L. J. Muchmore for the use of the Los Angeles Museum collections; and to Drs. Myrtle E. Johnson and Robert D. Harwood, of San Diego State College, for interested and helpful cooperation. In addition, the following persons have been most generous of their time in the identification of specimens and in many other ways: Dr. E. C. LIST OF SPECIES

CICINDELIDAE

- Tetracha carolina (L.) (37)

 Two specimens from Jacumba taken by Mr. George H.

 Field. This species is common in Imperial Valley and sometimes can be taken in large numbers from lights.
- Cicindela hirticollis Say var. gravida Lec. (51d)

 Not rare at the bays and ocean beaches. Taken in February, April, and August.
- Cicindela latesignata Lec. (52)

 This species with its form, obliviosa Csy., is found abundantly in midsummer at the bays and ocean beaches. It is not found inland and is less common at other times of the year.
- Cicindela vibex Horn var. viridissima Fall (55a)

 Reported under the name vibex Horn from "the ocean beach at Oceanside (Blaisdell)" by Fall, 1901.
- Cicindela oregona Lec. (61)

 Found commonly throughout the year at water. Most abundant at fresh water in the spring.
- Cicindela senilis Horn (63)

 "Near San Diego in damp places away from the ocean (Dunn)." Fall, 1901.
- Cicindela carthagena Dej. var. haemorrhagica Lec. (86c)

 Formerly abundant about San Diego. Now rare along the inland streams in August and September. "Occurs on the dark sand along the bay beaches at San Diego."

 Leng. 1902.
- Cicindela carthagena Dej. var. pacifica Schp. (86e)
 "San Diego is the type region for this subspecies. I have taken it abundantly on the ocean beach at Del Mar." Blaisdell, 1925.
- Cicindela sommeri Mann. (87)

 "Is reported from the vicinity of San Diego." Fall, 1901.
- Cicindela californica Men. var. praetextata Lec. (97a)

 Taken by Mr. Field at Warner's from June to August;
 not common.
- Cicindela trifasciata Fab. var. sigmoidea Lec. (98b)

 Very abundant at the bays and ocean beaches in the summer. Not found inland.
- Cicindela gabbi Horn (99)

 Formerly found near the salt flats around San Diego.

 Very rare. Six specimens were taken by Mr. Harbison at Monument Beach on July 30, 1934.

CARABIDAE

- Brennus obliquus Lec. (147)
 "San Diego. Not common." Fall, 1901.
- Brennus punctatus (Lec.) (153)

 From the coast to the western slope of the mountains in February, March, and April. Commonest at Dulzura in March. Specimens from: Lyons Valley, San Jacinto, San Diego, Mission Dam, Adobe Falls, and Poway. There is one specimen in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell collected in Julian on July 30.
- Calosoma parvicollis Fall (187)

 One specimen taken in La Puerta Valley in March and one labeled "San Diego, 6-22-1912," both by Mr. George H. Field.
- Calosoma hospes Csy. (189)

 Type locality: "Coronado." Casey, 1913. Can be found in the fields and roads at Coronado and North Island from March to June.
- Calosoma parviceps (Csy.) (190)
 "San Diego County. (Fuchs)." Fall, 1901.
- Calosoma peregrinator Guer. (194)

 Around San Diego March to June. Also found at Carrizo and Poway.
- Calosoma peregrinator Guer. var. ingens Csy. (194a)

 Type locality: "San Diego, California." Casey, 1913.
- Calosoma triste Lec. (198)
 "San Diego County." Fall, 1901. There are specimens from Poway in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Calosoma tristoides Fall (199)

 "Tristoides is based on a good series taken by Mr.
 Ricksecker at or near San Diego, California." Fall,
 1901. There are two specimens in the collection of
 the San Diego Society of Natural History labeled "San
 Diego, III-1908, Ricksecker." Also taken at Poway by
 Dr. Blaisdell.
- Calosoma semilaeve Lec. (201)

 From the coast to the mountains from March to July.
 Specimens from: San Diego, Mission Valley, Poway,
 Descanso, Cuyamaca, and Laguna.
- Calosoma simplex Lec. (202)

 One specimen taken by Mr. Ricksecker at "San Diego" in May, 1909. Taken at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell.
- Calosoma cancellatum Esch. (207)

 Common at Laguna in June and July. Also found in Mission Valley and Poway. Casey described the subspecies esuriens and transversa from "San Diego." They are now not considered valid.
- Elaphrus riparius L. (230)

 Numerous specimens found running about on a patch of

- mud in Mission Valley in May, 1933, and April, 1935, by the author. Also found at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell.
- Notiophilus semiopacus Esch. (256)

 "Found flying around a sewer outlet in December."

 Quoted from the notes of George H. Field. Specimens from Poway and San Diego and in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Scarites subterraneus Fab. var. californicus Lec. (316a)
 Found near the coast and inland valleys from March to
 October. Often found in lawns. Common in May and
 June.
- Dyschirius tridentatus Lec. (319)

 Found by the author on the mud flats in Mission Valley, one specimen on April 27 and one on August 6. Two specimens from Poway in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Dyschirius patruelis Lec. (320)

 Nine specimens taken by the author on the mud flats in Mission Valley on April 1.
- Dyschirius basalis Lec. (321)

 Six specimens taken by the author on the mud flats in

 Mission Valley on April 1.
- Dyschirius varidens Fall (322)

 Taken by the author at Torrey Pines in May and Mission Valley in March, May and August. Two specimens from Poway in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Dyschirius gibbipennis Lec. (326)

 Nine specimens taken by the author in Mission Valley on April 1, and two in Bostonia on April 20. Two specimens "under drift on the bay front" collected by George H. Field.
- Dyschirius unipunctatus Fall (332)

 Two specimens from Poway in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Dyschirius analis Lec. (337)

 Not rare on the mud flats in Mission Valley all year around. Commonest in July and August.
- Dyschirius marinus (Lec.) 343)

 Common on the sand at all the ocean beaches June to August. Is most common at dusk.
- Clivina punctulata Lec. (362)

 One specimen from San Diego in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Schizogenius depressus Lec. (387)

 Taken under oak bark at El Monte Oaks Park in February and under eucalyptus bark at Santee in March. Two specimens in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell from Warner's taken in February. Also taken at San Diego and Poway.
- Schizogenius litigiosus Fall (388)

 Two specimens taken by Mr. Field in Pine Valley on June 3.

- Bembidion bifossulatum (Lec.) (431)

 Six specimens collected at Cuyamaca in June by Mr.

 Field. Also "Near San Diego." Fall, 1901.
- Bembidion trechiforme (Lec.) (461)

 One specimen from El Monte Oaks in March. In the collection of Dr. Blaisdell are specimens taken at Warner's in May, at Poway, and at San Diego.
- Bembidion iridescens (Lec.) (467)

 One specimen taken in May in Lyons Valley. Dr. Blaisdell says that it is not uncommon at Poway.
- Bembidion horni Hayw. (508)
 "Taken at light in San Diego and Imperial Counties in April." Notes of Mr. Field. This is a desert species.
- Bembidion bifasciatum (Mots.) (509) "Poway." Blaisdell, 1909.
- Bembidion festivum Csy. (510)

 From Pine Valley in February and El Monte Oaks in March. Two specimens from Poway in Dr. Blaisdell's collection.
- Bembidion transversale Dej. (540)

 One specimen so labeled from Poway in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Bembidion compar Lec.

 Two specimens from Poway in the collection of Dr.

 Blaisdell were so identified by Henry Ulke.
- Bembidion erosum Mots. (545)
 "San Diego, LeConte." Casey, 1918.
- Bembidion lugubre Lec. (547)

 Ten specimens in Dr. Blaisdell's collection from San Diego and Poway taken in September.
- Bembidion lugubre Lec. var. stabile Lec. (547a)
 "San Diego, California, LeConte." Casey, 1918.
- Bembidion platynoides Hayw. (568)

 One specimen from San Diego in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Bembidion striola (Lec.) (579)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Near the coast and inland valleys in March.
- Bembidion tetracolum Say var. rupicola (Kby.) (588a)

 Common near the coast and inland valleys from February to May. Better known by the name of lucidum (Lec.)
- Bembidion ephippigerum (Lec.) (602)

 Common near the coast in May and August and in Mason Valley in July.
- Bembidion suspectum Blais. (624)

 Common in the inland valleys from March to May and in August.

- Bembidion approximatum (Lec.) (625)

 Common from the coast to the mountains from May to August.
- Bembidion consentancum (Lec.) (630)
 "San Diego." Casey, 1918.
- Bembidion extricatum Csy. (627)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Description apparently based on one female specimen.
- Bembidion cernens Csy. (632)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Description apparently based on one female specimen.
- Bembidion jacobianum Csy. (635)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Description apparently based on one specimen.
- Bembidion formale Csy. var. reconditum Csy. (636a)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Description apparently based on one male specimen.
- Bembidion procax Csy. (639)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Description based on six examples of both sexes.
- Bembidion indistinctum Dej. (641)

 Common near the coast and inland valleys from February to August. One specimen from Warner's.
- Bembidion patruele Dej. (651)

 Found in the inland valleys in April and August.
- Bembidion intermedium (Kby.) (655)

 "Occurs wherever there is water in the desert regions of the southwest." Fall, 1901. Two specimens in the J. O. Martin Collection labeled "San Diego, Aug. 15-17."
- Bembidion variegatum Say (660)

 Taken by Mr. Field near Mission Bay in March and at Warner's and La Puerta in July.
- Bembidion vile (Lec.) (676)
 "San Diego, August; rare." Fall, 1901. Three specimens in the J. O. Martin Collection were taken in San Diego in July.
- Bembidion insulatum (Lec.) (683)

 San Diego in June; taken at a light by Mr. Field.
- Bembidion nubiculosum Chd. (687)

 "Occurs wherever there is water in the desert regions of the southwest and is exceedingly abundant." Fall, 1901.
- Bembidion flavopictum Mots. (722)

 Common on mud throughout the County from May to August.
- Bembidion versicolor (Lec.) (723)

 One specimen from San Diego in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.

- Bembidion grandicolle (Lec.) (733)

 Three specimens from Poway and one from San Diego in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Bembidion dubitans (Lec.) (741)

 In the immediate region of the coast and coastal valleys from March to August.
- Bembidion connivens (Lec.) (767)

 Common near the coast and coastal valleys from March to May. Also taken at Warner's by Mr. Field.
- Lymneops laticeps (Lec.) (789)
 "San Diego, very few specimens known." Fall, 1901.
- Tachyura anthrax (Lec.) (799)

 In the collection of Dr. Blaisdell are six specimens taken in San Diego in April and three from Poway.
- Tachys vorax Lec. (838)

 Taken by the author in Mission Valley in April and May; not common.
- Tachys vittiger Lec. (863)

 Abundant near the coast and coastal valleys in wet places in May and August.
- Tachys esurialis Csy. (875)

 Type locality: "San Diego. Two female specimens; one doubtful." Casey, 1918.
- Tachys corax Lec. (876)

 Near the coast and inland valleys in May and August.

 Five specimens from La Puerta Valley in October.
- Tachys virgo Lec. (878)

 Two specimens in the collection of the California Academy of Sciences taken in San Diego in August by J. O. Martin.
- Tachyta nana (Gyll.) (890)

 Nine specimens taken by Mr. George H. Field in Laguna
 Mountains in April.
- Pogonistes planatus Horn (927)

 Described at Pogonus depressus by Leconte from "San Diego, Cal."
- Pterostichus californicus (Dej.) (972)

 Taken at Laguna in May and July, and at Ramona in September.
- Pterostichus vicinus Mann. (974)

 Common in the Laguna Mountains from March to August.

 Also found at Pine Valley and Palomar.
- Pterostichus isabellae Lec. (984)

 Common throughout the County, spring to fall.
- Pterostichus jacobinus Csy. (985)

 Type locality: "San Diego, California." Casey, 1913.

 Described from a single specimen.

- Pterostichus congestus Men. (989)

 Found throughout the Count, from spring to fall. Common except in the mountains.
- Pterostichus castanipes Men. (991)

 Not common. Found at Julian and Warner's in November, and at Laguna in June.
- Poecilus subcordatus Lec. (1152)

 Not common. Found near the coast, inland valleys and mesas from March to June.
- Poecilus laetulus Loc. (1154)

 One specimen from Poway in the collection of Dr.

 Blaisdell.
- Poecilus occidentalis Dej. (1155)

 Three specimens from Laguna taken in June by Mr. Field.
 One specimen from Coronado and four from Poway in Dr.
 Blaisdell's collection.
- Omaseus corvinus (Dej.) (1176)

 One specimen from San Diego in Dr. Blaisdell's collection.
- Parargutor lustrans (Lec.) (1179)

 Taken in July at Warner's by Mr. Field, and at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell, and in Mission Valley in January, March, and June.
- Curtonotus jacobinus Lec. (1235)

 Taken at Monument in February, and at San Diego in April and May. Not common.
- Curtonotus stupidus Lec. (1238)
 From San Diego and Poway, taken by Dr. Blaisdell.
- Bradytus specularis Csy. (1275)

 One specimen from Warner's and one from Laguna, both taken in July by Mr. Field.
- Celia californica (Dej.) (1299)

 Common throughout the County, spring to fall.
- Celia jacinto Csy. (1338)

 Type locality: "San Diego. Three specimens." Casey, 1918.
- Celia aurata (Dej.) (1339)

 Rare but found throughout the County from spring to fall.
- Amara insignis Dej. (1380)

 Found throughout the County from spring to fall.
- Amara tarsalis Csy. (1381)
 Type locality: "San Diego." Casey, 1918.
- Amara mystica Csy. (1388)

 Four specimens from Laguna in July taken by Mr. Field.
- Amara conflata Lec. (1406)
 One specimen taken at Potrero in June by Mr. Field.

- Amara littoralis Mann. (1428)

 One specimen in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell taken at Poway in July.
- Triaena longula Lec. (1432)

 Four specimens taken by Mr. Field in the Laguna Mountains in June.
- Triaena scitula (Zimm.) (1435)

 Rare throughout the County from March to July. Taken at Mission Valley, Lyons Valley, Palomar, Laguna, Volcan Mountain and Mason Valley.
- Calathus ruficollis Dej. var. obscurus Lec. (1485c)

 Very common throughout the County all year around.
- Calathus tenuistriatus Csy. (18787)

 Type locality: "California (San Diego). A single example taken by the writer." Casey, 1920.
- Calathus piceolus Csy. (18791)

 Type locality: "San Diego." Specimens in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell are from San Diego, Warner's Springs in June and July, and La Puerta in October.
- Pristonychus complanatus Dej. (1493)

 Not rare in the vicinity of San Diego all year around.
- Platynus agilis Lec. (1510)

 "Found at San Isabel, San Diego County (LeConte)."

 Fall, 1901. Laguna Mountains in April, May, August, and September; Pine Valley in June, all taken by Mr. Field.
- Platynus brunneomarginatus Mann. (1521)
 Two specimens from Mission Valley in March and one from Dulzura in May.
- Platynus brunneomarginatus Mann. var. bicoloratus G. & H. Common throughout the County spring to fall. (1521a)
- Platynus californicus (Dej.) (1524)

 Not common, but found throughout the County the year around. On the "shores of permanent pools." Fall, 1901.
- Platynus funebris Lec. (1535)

 Very common throughout the County the year around on the "margins of natural water courses." Fall, 1901.
- Platynus frater Lec. (1549)
 "Is recorded as from San Diego." Fall, 1901.
- Platynus maculicollis (Dej.) (1561)

 Very common throughout the County the year around.
- Platynus variolatus Lcc. (1562)
 Found throughout the County, but not very abundant, from June to July. Occurs on the "shores of permanent pools." Fall, 1901.
- Platynus variolatus Lec. var. coronadina Csy. (1562a)
 Type locality: "San Diego, Ricksecker." Casey, 1920.

- Platynus fossiger (Dej.) (1568)
 Very common throughout the County the year around.
- Platynus viridissimum Csy. (18892)
 One specimen taken by Mr. Field at Laguna in July.
- Platynus suffusum Csy. (18893)
 One specimen from Laguna and one from Potrero, both taken in July by Mr. Field.
- Platynus sybariticum Csy. (18896)

 Taken at Laguna in July and September by Mr. Field and at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell.
- Lachnophorus elegantulus Mann. (1603)

 Taken near water west of the mountains throughout the year. Occasionally found in abundance in the Sweet-water Valley.
- Euphorticus occidentalis Horn (1605)

 One specimen from Mission Valley in August and one in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell from San Diego in August.
- Galerita lecontei Dej. (1618)

 Not common, but found throughout the County all year around.
- Tetragonoderus pallidus Horn (1638)

 Four specimens from Mason Valley in November, February, and March.
- Lebia cyanipennis Dej. (1652)

 Found near the coast and inland mesas from spring to fall.
- Lebia ruficollis Lec. (1653)

 Found near the coast from spring to fall.
- Lebia viridis Say (1655)

 Throughout the County from April to June.
- Lebia furcata Lec. (1677)

 One specimen in the Van Dyke collection labeled "San Diego County, IV. 8. 25."
- Lebia guttula Lec. (1685)

 Seven specimens from Mason Valley and from Warner's Springs taken by Mr. Field in July. Also two specimens in Dr. Blaisdell's collection taken at Poway.
- Lebia bilineata Mots. (1687)
 Ramona, Poway, and San Diego in June. Rare.
- Dromius piceus Dej. var. quadricollis Lec. (1691a)

 Two specimens from "San Diego County" in November in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell.
- Apristus laticollis Lec. (1695)

 Found throughout the County, but not common, May to August.

- Apristus liratus Csy. var. agitatus Csy. (18996a)

 Type locality: "San Diego. A single male, taken by the writer." Casey, 1920.
- Blechrus lucidus (Lec.) (1697)

 Eight specimens taken at Laguna in August and one taken at Potrero in June by Mr. Field.
- Axinopalpus biplagiatus (Dej.) (1700)

 Foothills to the coast spring to fall.
- Tecnophilus croceicollis (Men.) var. pilatei Chd. (1702c)
 One specimen from San Diego in the collection of Dr.
 Blaisdell.
- Calleida platynoides Horn (1706)

 Found at Monument, San Diego, and Poway in February and March.
- Plochionus timidus Hald. (1723)
 One specimen taken in July at Warner's by Mr. Field.
- Pinacodera punctigera (Lec.) (1727)

 Mason Valley from November to March; not rare.
- Cymindis laticollis Say (1731)

 Four specimens in the collection of Dr. Blaisdell are labeled "San Diego County."
- Cymindis cribricollis Dej. (1738)

 Two specimens from San Felipe Valley taken by Mr.
 Ricksecker in November.
- Brachinus lateralis Dej. (1785)

 Rare. Found near water in the coastal region from spring to fall.
- Brachinus tschernikhi Mann. (1797)

 Common in damp places throughout the County from spring to fall.
- Brachinus costipennis Mots. (1799)

 Common in damp places throughout the County from spring to fall.
- Chlaenius pennsylvanicus Say (1817)
 Two specimens taken at Laguna by Mr. Field in May.
- Chlaenius tricolor Dej. (1821)

 Found throughout the County in damp places from spring to fall.
- Chlaenius variabilipes Esch. (1826)

 Not abundant, but found throughout the County from spring to fall.
- Chlaenius obsoletus Lec. (1829)

 Found throughout the County from spring to fall in damp places.
- Chlaenius cumatilis Lec. (1835)

 Very common throughout the County from spring to fall.

- Chlaenius regularis Lec. (1846b)

 Very common along the coast and in the foothills from January to July.
 - Harpalus pennsylvanicus DeG. (1925)

 Around San Diego from June to September.
 - Harpalus cautus Dej. (1941)

 In the foothills and mountains from May to July.
 - Harpalus sommulentus Dej. (1961)

 Common in the mountains from May to July.
 - Anisodactylus semipunctatus Lec. (2094)

 Very common throughout the County from spring to fall; commonest in July.
 - Anisodactylus consobrinus Lec. (2098)

 Not common. Found in the mountains in July. Also found at Poway.
 - Anisodactylus angustus Csy. (2100)
 Type: "San Diego, Dunn." Casey, 1914.
 - Anisodactylus californicus Dej. (2102)

 Very common from the mountains to the coast from spring to fall.
 - Anisodactylus amaroides Lec. (2106)

 Not common in the mountains in July. Taken at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell.
 - Dicheirus angulatus Csy. (2118)

 Type: "San Diego, six examples." Casey, 1914. Found around San Diego from March to May.

- Monarthrum dentiger (Lec.) (18300)

 A specimen was taken at Poway by Dr. Blaisdell.
- Gnathotrichus retusus (Lec.) (18398)

 Two specimens taken at Laguna in May by Mr. Field.
- Pseudopityophthorus pubipennis (Lec.) (18418)

 One specimen taken at Laguna in August by Mr. Field.
- Pityophthorus carmeli Sw. (18431)

 Found in March at Torrey Pines on Pinus torreyana.
- Pityophthorus digestus (Lec.) (18453)

 There are four specimens in the Blaisdell collection labeled "San Diego County, December."
- Ips confusus (Lec.) (18465)

 Abundant in pine forests of the County, sometimes causing serious damage to the trees.
- Ips latidens (Lec.) (18470)

 Numerous specimens were taken by Mr. Field at Laguna in September.
- Ips oregoni (Eich.) (18478)

 Found under the bark of dead pines "which they have killed" in Laguna Mountains and Pine Valley from May to July by Mr. Field.
- Xyleborus xylographus (Say) (18507)

 Taken at Poway and San Diego by Dr. Blaisdell.
