## Note

New synonymy in the genus *Anisops* Spinola (Notonectidae: Heteroptera)

Anisops nasuta (Fieber) is a very widespread species in the Indo-Pacific Region. N. Nieser and P. Chen (1991. Tijdschrift voor Entomologie 134: 57) give its range as "India and Sri Lanka through China and Indochina to Australia and Samoa." Recently Gou-Oing Liu and Le-vi Zheng (1990. Acta Zootaxonomica Sinica 15: 351) described a new species, Anisops protracta, and compared it to A. kuroiwai Matsumra and A. nasuta. Their description of the head of "A. nasuta" is not correct, matching instead that of A. sardea Herrich-Schäffer, whereas the splendid figures and description of their new species protracta match nasuta in every respect, thus Anisops protracta Liu & Zheng 1990 is here placed as a junior synonym of *Anisops nasuta* (Fieber, 1851) (New Synonymy). In response to a query, Dr. Zheng informed me that the comparison was made with determined material furnished to their laboratory; it is quite apparent that in this material *A. sardea* was unfortunately wrongly labelled as *A. nasuta*.

This synonymy is needed for the Catalogue of Palearctic Heteroptera (B. Aukema and C. Rieger, editors) now being prepared for publication by myself and others.
