## Leptognathus Pratti.

Body strongly compressed. Eye moderately large, its diameter equalling its distance from the oral border. Rostral as deep as broad, just visible from above; internasals about half as long as the præfrontals; frontal as long as broad, shorter than its distance from the end of the snout, which equals the length of the parietals; nasal divided; loreal longer than deep, bordering the eye; præocular partially fused with the prefrontal; two postoculars; temporals 2+3; eight or nine upper labials, fourth and fifth or fifth and sixth entering the eye; first two pairs of lower labials forming a suture behind the symphysial; two pairs of chin-shields, broader than long. Scales in 15 rows, vertebrals strongly enlarged. Ventrals 173; anal entire; subcaudals 71. Dark brown above and below, with paler brown cross-bars, one scale wide, disposed in pairs; belly with interrupted light longitudinal streaks.

Total length 770 millim.; tail 150.

A single specimen (a female) was obtained by Mr. A. E. Pratt at Medellin, Republic of Colombia.
