

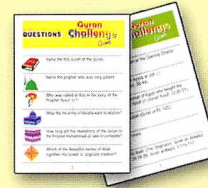
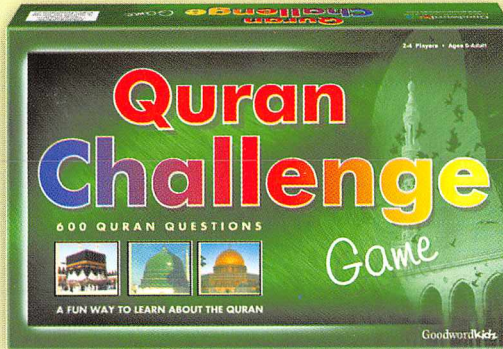

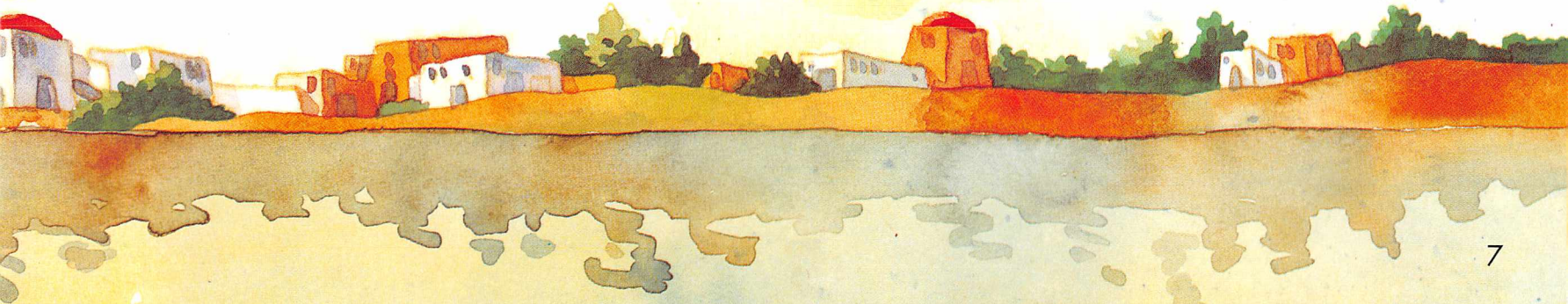




One day his disciples asked him

'Go in fear of Allah,' warned Isa عليه السلام, 'if you are true believers.'



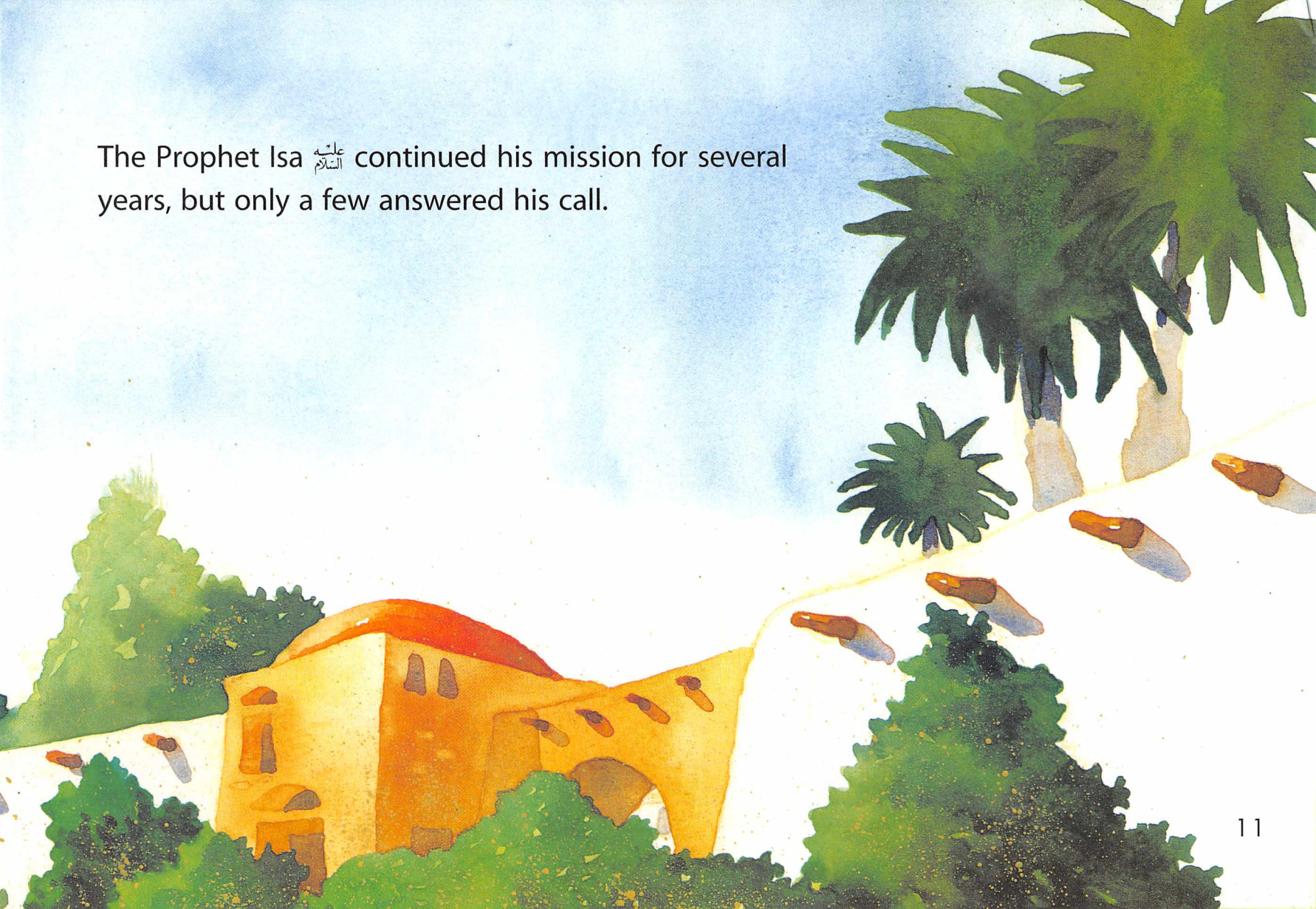



But they insisted and in answer to the Prophet

The Prophet Isa عليه السلام continued his mission for several years, but only a few answered his call.

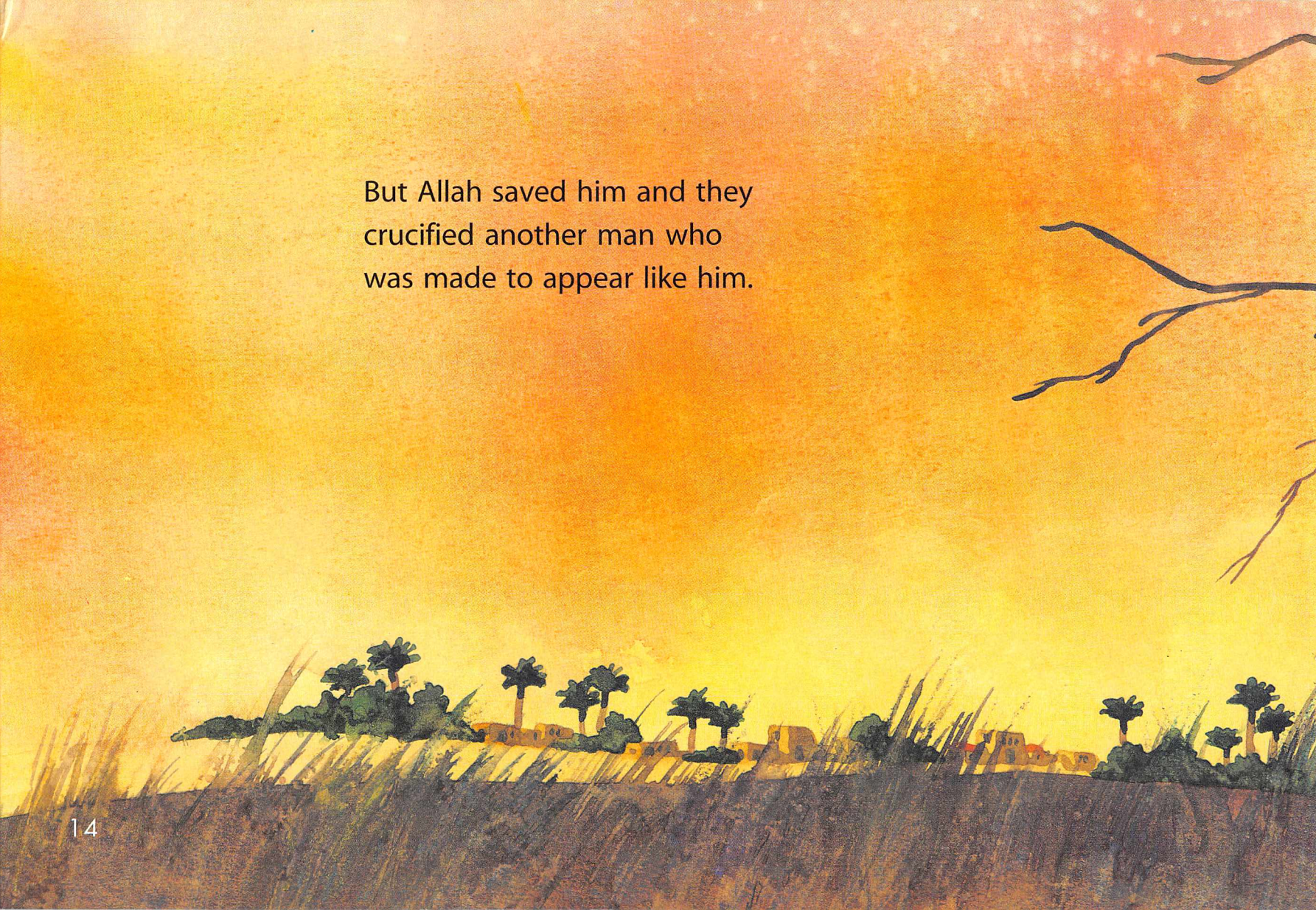







Lo, I am the servant of Allah:

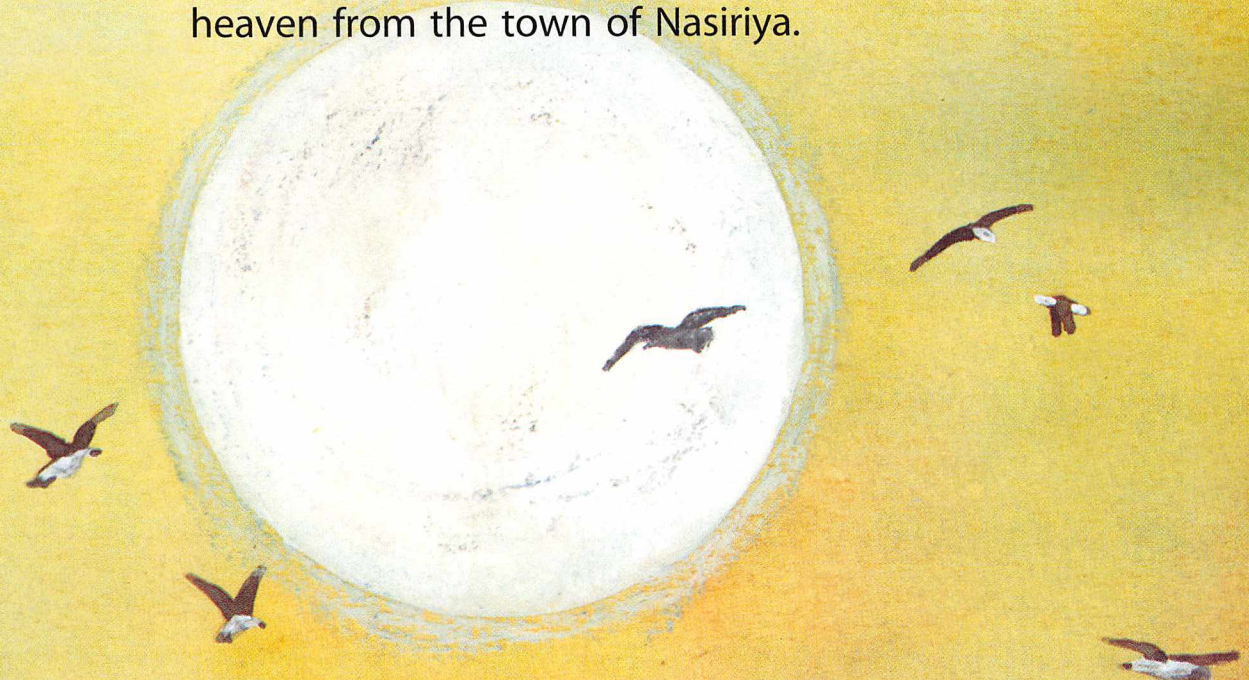
The Prophet Isa عليه السلام said that the scriptures which had been revealed earlier, were true, and told the people about the last prophet.



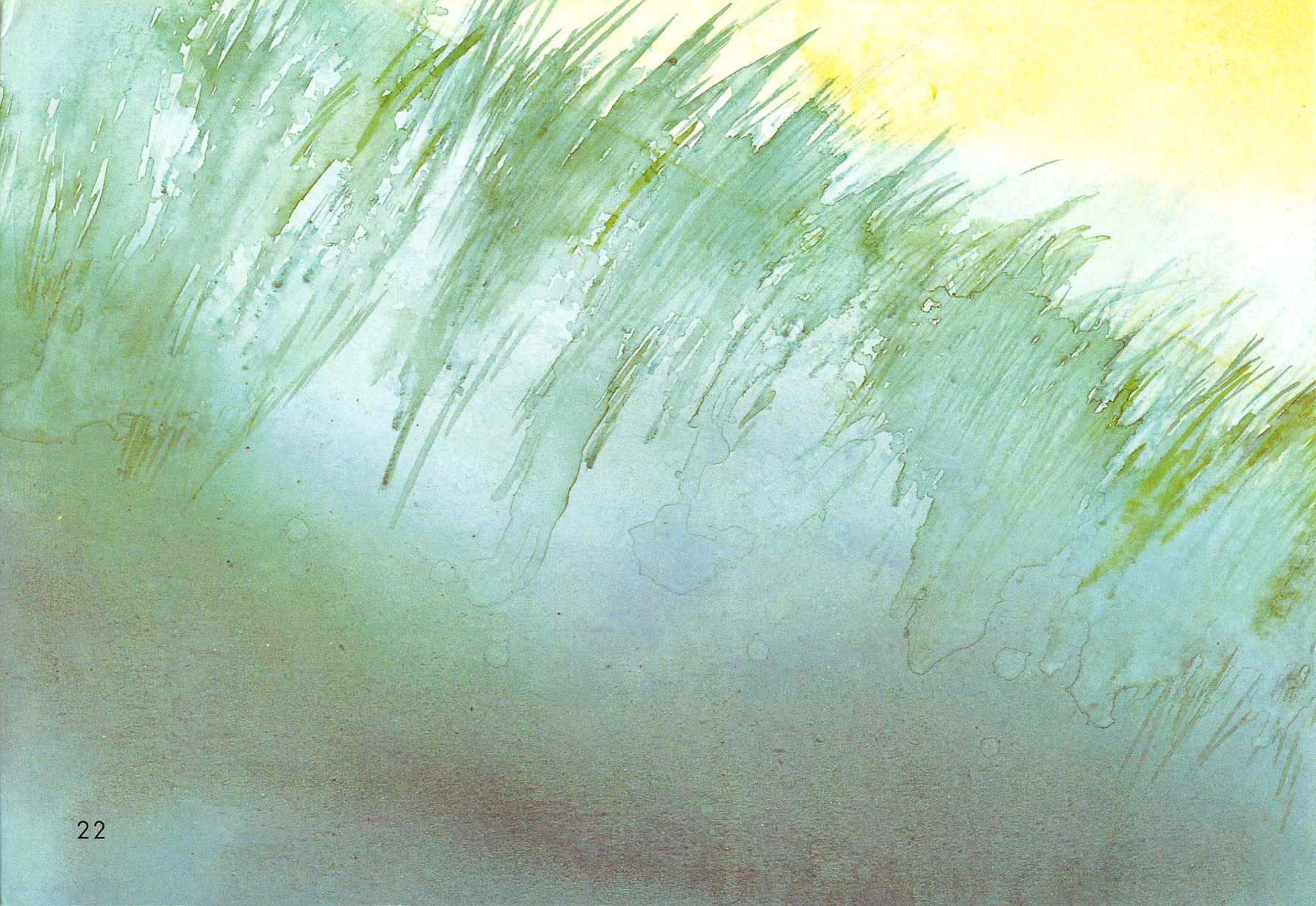
He said, 'I am sent forth to you from Allah to confirm the Tawrat already revealed, and to give you news of a messenger who will come after me whose name is Ahmad.'



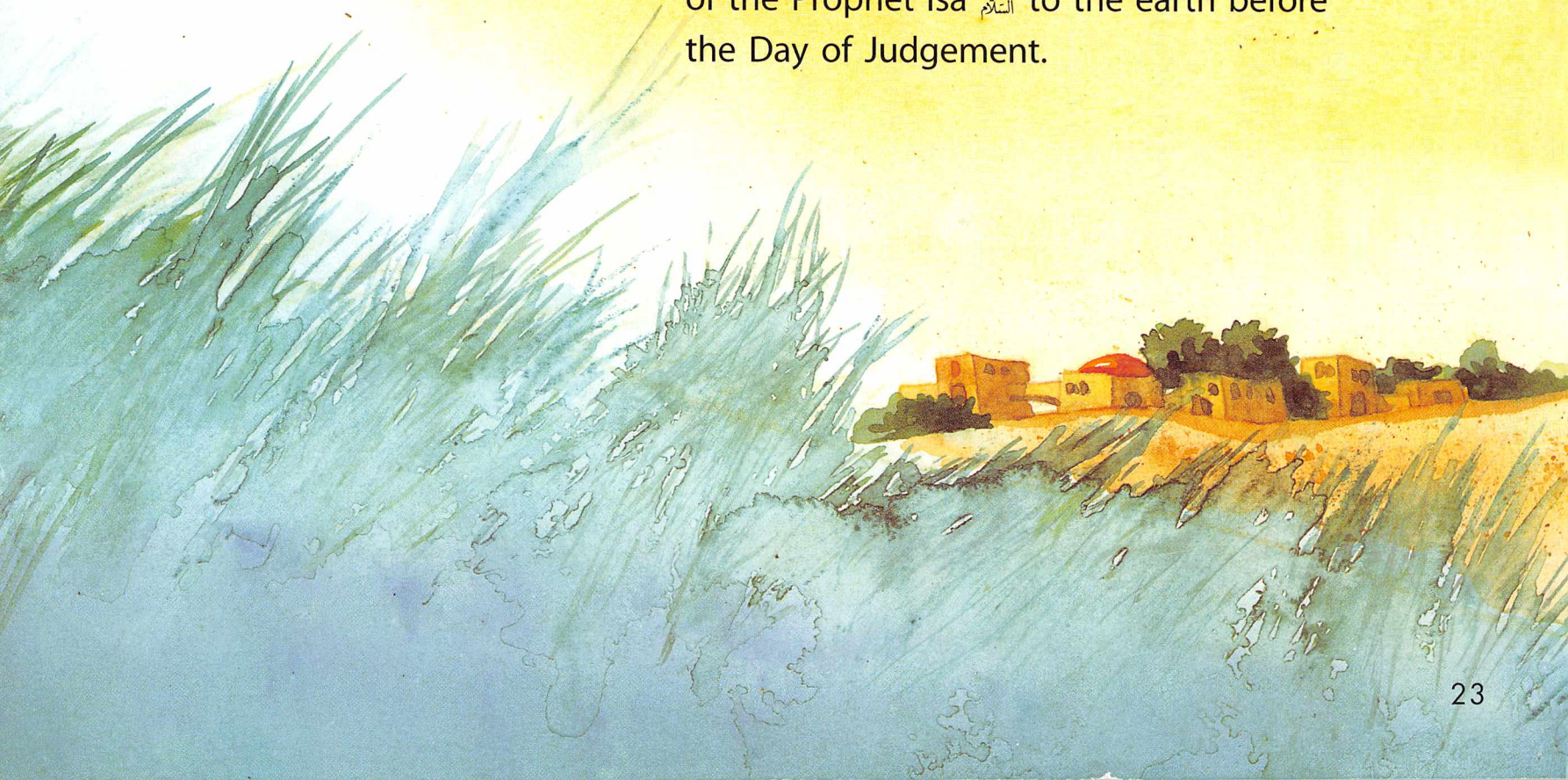
The Prophet Isa عليه السلام went up to
