

The Black Cat (1895-1922) was a monthly literary magazine, publishing original short stories, often about uncanny or fantastical topics. Many writers were largely unknown, but some famous authors also wrote original material for this magazine.

The fourth issue of Volume 3, contains the following five stories:

- > "In the Cabin of the Ben Bolt", by Bert Leston Taylor: why does Miss Annerly need to get to Sydney so fast?
- > "Bigler's Barometer", by Sam Davis: meet two die-hard gamblers betting on the weather forecast
- > "The Skyland Treasure", by Frank Bailey Millard: adventure ensues when an artist stumbles over a buried treasure
- > "In the Mohawk Club", by Theodore Roberts: a lady's heart is not won by a billiard game
- > "Reincarnation", by Stanley Edwards Johnson: find out what happens when a farmer gets influenced by theosophy
