A Brief History Of The AMERICAN FASCIST PARTY By Seth Tyrssen

"Time counts, and keeps on counting," as they said in one of the "Mad Max" movies; so, with the passage of time, I must admit, I draw

on memories that are not all-inclusive. But at the request of NBU Leader Gary Raikes, I'm happy to include this brief history.

For my own part, I freely admit to having been a National Socialist since my early teen years -- a fact which did not thrill my parents, but they tolerated me anyway. I'd organized "blackshirts" in my Junior High School, which they weren't too crazy about either. By 1978, I had stood shoulder-to-shoulder with NSM Detroit Capt. Bill Russell on many occasions, against the Reds. During this time I met NSP leader Frank Collin, at a time when rumors were going around that he was actually Jewish -- something that was perfectly obvious to me, though I rather liked Frank at the time; and NSM chief writer James Mason, who was so terrified on the approach of the Reds when he was visiting one weekend, that he had to be driven back to Ohio.

In 1978, the Democratic National Convention was to be held in Detroit; and the mayor clearly didn't want any problems from us. Bill Russell went to jail briefly on some feeble trumped-up charge, and the FBI was sent to my inner-city house to poison me. This they did by spraying something very much like Agent Orange into a pair of work gloves I regularly used outdoors. As a result, the skin of my hands was swollen and burning off, a layer at a time, over the next two years. This didn't prevent Bill and I from showing up at a City Council meeting a bit later, facing down a mob of about 300 howling Reds from the Revolutionary Communist Party. (That incident is recounted both in "The New Fascism" and "Life By Misadventure: Diary of an American Fascist.")

Eventually, I was forced to retreat to my parents' new home in New Jersey, to see a string of doctors and gradually get myself on the road to recovery. This hiatus gave me ample opportunity to look back, and examine my own views more closely. And I came to the conclusion that I was no longer a National Socialist. About half the people I'd met were perfectly good chaps, and half were stark, raving bonkers.

I could see that "the movement" wasn't moving anywhere; and most involved thought of themselves as some high-ranking figure in their vision of an America under National Socialism. If you think of yourself in a more common occupation, the whole thing becomes a lot less attractive. Too, I had met many people of other races that were perfectly decent folks -- contrary to the stereotyping I'd had pushed at me for decades.

So ... what was I?

After spending some considerable time in both thought and study, I realized that I was a Fascist, in the spirit of the great Sir Oswald Mosley. I thought I was probably the only one. Years later, when I got dragged kicking and screaming into the computer age, I found that this wasn't necessarily the case. I stumbled across a Yahoo site called "American Fascist Party," but it had apparently been created and then abandoned; there was no moderator, no one in charge, nothing.



But I did meet up with a damn good bunch of people, all asking "is anyone in charge, here?" It was decided that, just by virtue of seniority and experience, that I should lead the AFP. From this group, I was able to assemble an excellent officer corps. But we were plagued by a few half-wit "neo-Nazis" that insisted on posting, and with no control over that site, we couldn't get rid of them. So en masse, we left



that particular site, and created our own. Things were still largely informal, but we assembled (on paper at least) a Fascist Institute of Technology, an Iron Guard (our Blackshirts,) a Youth Corps, and various ministries.

Things got serious when, on the night of George Bush's ("King George I") illegal invasion of Iraq, I sent him a message, promising the American Fascist Party's complete and total opposition.



It was obvious that my phone was tapped, and it remains so to this day; nor do I care. They took to calling at regular hours, and saying nothing. This was supposed to scare me. Instead, I made a little tape recording of the opening to the old radio show, "The Shadow," and when the phone rang promptly at 7:30 PM, I'd hit the button and they'd hear "who knows ... what evil ... lurks in the hearts of men? The Shadow knows, heh heh heh!"


With officers in numerous states, and connections with groups and individuals throughout America and abroad (including Spain and Japan,) we had a presence which far outweighed our actual numbers.

As mentioned earlier, I was fortunate in having an excellent officer corps; in particular, Deputy Leader Stuart Young and Minister of Information Mike Cessna. Both wrote reams of excellent material which was posted on our site.

During this time, "The New Fascism" was written, and membership grew. Even now, when I re-read that book, I see nothing I'd really change, even after almost 13 years.

I was also writing a regular column for the Arizona newspaper, "Apache County Reporter." Its publisher had originally been leery of the "F word," but by the time the paper folded, he was writing some excellent Fascist material himself.

In 2004, I was a candidate for the presidential race; though I always freely admitted, in our case it was more of a slow walk. We were just there to help spread the word. Even so, the night of the election, I got calls from all over the country from folks saying "hey man, I voted for ya!"

Clearly, it was time for an organizational conference. The "Fascist Executive" was to have been held in Texas in 2005.

Unfortunately, in spite of an enthusiastic following on-line, not enough people could manage to attend. Thus did I learn, you can't build a real movement on a computer. We never did establish the street presence that's needed, and in that respect, the NBU

has gone much farther than we did. A later meeting in New York City took place, between myself, Dan Gustin (leader of our "sister organization," the American Fascist Movement) and a British comrade who always wished to remain anonymous but influential. As seen here. Not sure he's even still alive, he was none too well when we last spoke -- and that was over two years ago.



listening to some geezer drone on and on with a litany of his health problems. Alas, I must inflict a bit of that on you, here -- because a certain amount of it can be blamed squarely on the FBI, and will explain why I hate them so very thoroughly.

I mentioned in the last article that they'd sent their dirty tricks squad over, to poison me. How did I know this, you may well ask? Simple: they were seen.

It never occurred to them that a National Socialist (which I was, at the time) living in a primarily Black neighborhood would get along well with his neighbors, but I did. And when my skin troubles began, my neighbor across the street (a prominent Black Muslim, back in the days when Islam was less odious) told me that he'd seen a squeaky-clean "telephone company" pull up to the house while I was at work. Two squeaky-clean "repairmen" got out, with their perfectly clean uniforms and carefully ironed pants with creases -- this is an FBI trademark. They entered my house, and emerged about a half hour later. They sprayed something akin to the notorious "Agent Orange" into a pair of work gloves I always used outdoors, and thus began years of Hellish nightmare. Skin swelled, burned off a layer at a time, and itched beyond belief; it was rather like having both hands stuck in jars of hungry mosquitos, 24/7, for two years.

I saw more doctors than I can count or remember. Most were puzzled. Some had a look of outright fear; they knew what the real deal was. But only one finally had the courage to say "someone's been fucking with you," and prescribed heavy doses of the steroid prednisone. It worked -- but at a cost.

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The cure was not instantaneous by any means, and though the worst of it was over in two years, I had to go back on prednisone for about the next decade. And this resulted in avascular necrosis, which to us laymen means that the bones are rotting away from the inside-out.

My street-action days were over, but the fiery spirit remained. "That which does not kill me, only makes me stronger." I never liked "keyboard commandos," but if that's all I could do, then by damn, that's what I'd do. Which, as recounted in the previous article, is what led to the formation of the AFP. We eschewed the usual "uniform fetish" trip, to avoid looking like all the costume Nazis. We even

eschewed armbands, since they usually evoke a carefully programmed response from the masses: "Nazi Nazi Nazi," or "that guy looks like something out of the 1930's." Instead, we went with the "tri-patch," shown at right; it loosely resembles one worn by Mussolini, but the masses don't know that.

The "fencing shirt" gave way to the more modern black pullover "turtleneck," with a fasces pin on the front (thanks to our "sister organization," the AFM.)

We could, therefore, walk around in public without really drawing any notice or disapproving glances (or outright physical attacks.) We forbade "jackboots," though I strongly suspect we all had a pair, and "Sam Browne" belts, both of which might be worn in private now and then. (Below right: guilty as charged, yer honor!)

Considering that we had just over a hundred members scattered around, we actually did pretty well. We had contacts around the world, and powerful enemies -both indicators that you're doing something right.

Perhaps the most useful thing we did was to pin down what modern Fascism actually is, and what it wanted to accomplish in the modern age. We could back up our rather radical approach with the bedrock of original Fascist philosophy, from both Mosley and Mussolini.



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Even the Duce's grand-daughter, Euro MP Alessandra Mussolini, was nice to us.

Those radical and more modern policies included being open to any American citizen, of any race or religion, that agreed with us. Consequently we had people from many walks of life, and one of my best and most loyal officers was a proud Hispanic gentleman whom I still keep in touch with.

The issue of "gays" was admittedly a touchy one. We had exactly one gay member, and he served well. After some discussion, we decided that Mosley's dictum "in public life, service ; in private life, liberty" was the way to go. The guy was a good sound engineer, and re-mastered a number of Mosley speeches, which we offered on CD. But tiring of the controversy, he left shortly thereafter.

Such radical policies horrified the closet Nazis and the Puritans-in-Blackshirts, both here and abroad. One group in Italy, and one prominent individual in England, starting raving against us. And at that point, I quit, saying that the barrage of insult from our enemies was of no importance, but getting that from those who were supposed to be friends and allies, was more than I wanted to deal with. I was effectively burnt out.

Others tried to carry on; the second administration had no more luck than I'd had, in getting a proper meeting together.

The third was to be led by my former Minister of Defense, but he came back from active duty in "the sandbox" so screwed up with PTSD, that there was just no way he could take on leadership of a very public, very radical group. Disaffected, the membership faded away, and that was the quiet end of the AFP.

Or was it?

Now, barely over a decade later, we live in an age where rapefugees swarm over Europe, and people in America are getting damn sick of the Libtard way of running things. "If it looks like a rich RepubliCrat, don't vote for it!" So who knows, if there are any younger and fitter chaps out there with the serious cajones to get out there in the streets and make it a reality, in spite of the dangers, the AFP may see a revival. Any number of "tin fuhrers" have come and gone; it will take someone with real personal courage and real intelligence to make it work. Hopefully they'll have read and understood "the Good Book," as I often call The New Fascism. We shall see ... We shall see. -ST

A Few Thoughts On "TALKIN' THE TALK" By Seth Tyrssen

This is probably geared more towards those who are representing the NBU out there, in public; but for each and every one of the folks who are doing so, it's actually important.

We all know the expression "walk the talk," which means, have the courage of your convictions, and "put your money where your mouth is." But I'd like to diverge a bit here, and focus on "talking the talk."

I recently received an email from a prominent nationalist, who was unimpressed with the speaker he heard, from a certain group, because that speaker not only couldn't answer the question, "what is your policy on repatriation?", he didn't even know what the word meant.

No, I won't name names; it could be anybody, anywhere, from any group. The same lesson holds true: HOW YOU PRESENT YOURSELF is going to be the main impression the public takes away, regarding your group and its views.

If you're dull, not very animated, and speak in a monotone, no one is going to be impressed. You don't have to be a fiery screamer; in fact, that's a major turn-off to most people, as well. Not all of us can be the gripping speaker that Sir Oswald Mosley was; but we can all learn from his example!

Every single public representative should get some training in public speaking. My personal favorite came naturally to me; I'd been on stage since I was a kid, and later, did a few movies as well. (Nope, no starring roles, sorry.) In all those years, however, I learned quite a bit about presenting myself. For those still in school, *take some acting classes.* Participate in the school plays. Join the debate club, if such things still exist. And dash it all, if you're going to represent Britain, *learn English.* Yes I know, that sounds odd; of course you "know" English. I mean expand your vocabulary. There's no reason you shouldn't know what a word like "repatriation" means.



There have been a few -- just a few -- really great speakers that I can think of. Certainly, Adolf Hitler comes to mind; he was the greatest showman of the 20th century, in spite of a voice made raspy by mustard gas in WW1. His timing, his inflection, his careful use of gesture, all combined to make him the foremost speaker of his time. If you just look at what he's actually *saying*, lots of it is pretty banal and ordinary. It was the *way* he said it.

John F. Kennedy, Winston Churchill, Martin Luther King, and Franklin D. Roosevelt were attention-getting speakers -- mostly because of their unique vocal qualities. Even if you were only listening to them on a radio, they got your attention. And of course, Benito Mussolini had his own inimitable style, which resonated with his audiences.

You have a voice; learn to use it. You have a body; learn to use it. Study the great speakers of the past (no matter which side of the philosophical fence they may be on. Lenin, it is said, was a lousy speaker!)

Of them all, Sir Oswald offers the best example I can think of. He *connected* with his audience, he was *engaged*, not standing up there like some separate and superior demogogue. *Watch* him. Pay less attention to what's being said, and more to the way it's being said.

Practice in front of a mirror, if possible. Yes, you'll feel silly. So what? You'll soon get a feel for what works, or doesn't work, for you. No, there's no point in trying to be a *copy* of anybody. An audience will see that, and blow it off, immediately. But if you work hard at making your presentation as great as your message ... it will be. --ST
