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## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

NEW APPLICANTS must clear all admission requirements with the Registrar's Office by January 17, 1959, as follows:

1. Complete the application form provided by the Registrar's Office.
2. Submit a satisfactory transcript of credits.
  - a. BEGINNING FRESHMEN must request the high school principal to mail a transcript of credits to the Registrar's Office.
  - b. TRANSFER STUDENTS must request the registrar of *each college attended* to mail a transcript of college credits to the Registrar's Office.
3. Pass successfully a qualifying examination. Request a letter of instructions concerning the examination from the Registrar's Office.
4. Submit the required Health Service Record Card.

FORMER STUDENTS, including those not registered at Memphis State University for the 1958 Fall Semester and/or who have attended another college since last attending Memphis State, must clear admission requirements with the Registrar's Office as follows:

1. Complete the application for readmission form provided by the Registrar's Office.
2. Request the registrar of each college attended, if any, to mail a transcript of college credits to the Registrar's Office.

AFTER having completed entrance requirements, an applicant will be notified of his admission status. If he is accepted, a card of admission will be issued by the Registrar's Office. This card should be presented at the time of registration.

REGISTRATION PACKETS will be ready only for those students who have completed the above requirements.

## REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

PROCEDURE—Pick up your registration packet from Room 204 and go to your adviser. He will retain your packet and will give you a registration envelope showing your approved course of study. Take this envelope to the Card Center and pick up your course cards. Course cards will be issued only to a student who presents an approved registration envelope. Return to your adviser and complete your official material for your adviser's approval. Leave your registration envelope with your adviser. Take your packet to the Director of your school for final approval before you go to the Bursar to pay your fees. Have your ID picture made or your Fall Semester card validated.

RESIDENCE APPROVAL—The Dean of Women must approve the residence of all women students. Residence approval may be obtained in the Dean of Women's Office.

VETERANS—After your adviser approves your registration packet, go to Mr. Leo Davis in the Office of Veterans' Affairs in the Student Center and get your veteran's file approved before you go to the Bursar.

## CHANGE OF COURSE PROCEDURE

APPLICATION FOR ADDING OR DROPPING COURSES is made in the office of the director of the School of Arts and Sciences, the School of Business, or the School of Education.

ADDING—No course may be added after February 10.

DROPPING—No course may be dropped after March 11.

WITHDRAWAL—A student may withdraw from the University by advising the Dean in person or in writing. Failure to give the Dean official notice of withdrawal will result in a grade of "F" in each course for which the student is registered. Students who withdraw after the drop period (March 11) will have their courses recorded as WP (withdrawn passing) or WF (withdrawn failing).
