Mission San Fernando-Mission San Fernando Rey de España is the full name of the Mission whose ruins still remain a distance of twenty-two miles from Los Angeles. It was ounded on the eighth day of September, 1797. Present a Californimonies was Father Francisco Dumetz, who came to San Gaia with the great Junipero Serra. Like its neighbor a material and spiritual view point, and marked the begin ning of a new era for the entire region.
