

## THE CANTERBURY AND YORK SOCIETY.

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**R**EPORT of the Council for the year ending, 30th June, 1922, to be presented at the Eighteenth Annual General Meeting to be held, by kind permission of the President and Fellows of the Royal Historical Society, at their rooms, 22, Russell Square, at 5 p.m., on Wednesday, November 29th, 1922.

This date is considerably later than usual, and the Council hopes that a larger attendance of Members may be the result.

The Meeting is likely to be one of some importance in the life of the Society.

The Rev. F. N. Davis, Rector of Rowney, who has been General Editor since May, 1906, and Joint Honorary Secretary since October, 1910, owing to greater distance from London, has found it necessary to resign. Mr. Davis gave his time and labour whole-heartedly to the Society. Not only did he undertake the very important work of seeing the various parts through the final stages of publication, but he also made himself responsible for the packing and distribution to the Members, a very heavy and troublesome business. Moreover whilst at Crowell, he stored all the sheets and reserve stock, thereby saving great expense to the Society. It was with great reluctance that his resignation was accepted. Happily Mr. Davis' knowledge of the work and affairs of the Society is not entirely lost, for he has consented to accept a seat on the Council, where his advice will be of the greatest service.

Miss Rose Graham, F.S.A., has consented to undertake the work of General Editor, and for the present, Mr. Banks will continue to act as sole Honorary Secretary. To confirm this arrangement, it will be proposed that Rule IV. shall be altered as follows:—after the word “Treasurer,” to delete “Honorary Secretaries,” and insert instead, “Honorary General Editor and one or more Honorary Secretaries.”

Fresh plans will have to be made for the storage of stock and distribution in the future. Negotiations have been opened with the Oxford University Press, and if an agreement is arrived at, they will undertake all the Society's printing, publishing and storage. This arrangement will have many advantages, but may involve some extra expense to the Society.

During the year 1921-22, the following parts have been issued:—

Part LXVIII.—The Hereford Registers of Bishops Bothe, Fox and Bonner.

This part brings to an end the Hereford Series, and the Society takes the opportunity of offering its thanks to the Cantilupe Society for the pleasant and profitable co-operation which has subsisted between them for more than sixteen years.

Part LXIX.—Continuation of the Winchester Register of John de Pontissara.

Part LXX.—Chapters of the Augustinian Canons. This volume was presented to the Society by the Rev. H. E. Salter, to whom thanks are recorded for his valuable gift.

In the course of the coming year, it is hoped that we shall be able to issue the concluding part of Pontissara's Register, and also that of Gravesend. Much progress has been made by Mr. H. E. Malden, in editing the Register of Stephen Gardiner, Bishop of Winchester, and the transcript will be ready for the press in the near future. The Society was enabled to undertake this work by the gift of a sum of £74 received from the surviving Members of the old Hampshire Record Society. The Council hopes to proceed with other work as occasion allows, more particularly in continuing the issue of Registers already commenced, those of Rochester, London and Salisbury.

The Treasurer's financial statement will be found on a previous page of this report. The Council desires to call the attention of the Members to the heavy arrears of subscriptions. Members should realise that delay in paying their subscriptions impedes the work of the Society. Thanks to the generosity of the Rev. H. E. Salter, the expenditure on printing was reduced, and we are enabled to carry forward a balance of £59 15s. 8d., instead of a deficit. The sum of £74 received from the Hampshire Record Society, being ear-marked for a specific object, has been placed on deposit with the Society's bankers.

The Council regrets to have to report a still further decline in the Membership; several new Members have joined since the last Annual Meeting, but deaths and resignations outnumber the accessions. Members now only number 164, and other resignations will take effect at the end of the current year. Members would greatly help if they would bring the Society to the knowledge of all who are interested in the records of the period covered by the publications of the Society. They are reminded that special terms are being offered to those who wish to make up sets.

The Council have to record the loss by death of three Members,—

Chancellor Sir A. B. Kempe,  
Sir Edward Fraser, and  
Mr. W. E. George,

and, amongst others, the resignation of His Grace the Duke of Northumberland, one of the Vice-Presidents. The Venerable Archdeacon of Monmouth, having been consecrated Bishop of the new See of Monmouth, becomes a Vice-President.

## RULES OF THE SOCIETY.

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I.—The object of this Society shall be to print, for distribution among its members only, Copies, Abstracts, and Indexes of the Bishops' Registers and other Ecclesiastical Records in the Provinces of Canterbury and York.

II.—The Annual Subscription shall be One Guinea, payable in advance on the 1st July.

III.—Each member of the Society, having paid his subscription, shall be entitled to a copy of every work produced by the Society, and to vote at the general meetings, within the period subscribed for.

IV.—The management of the Society's affairs shall be vested in a Council consisting of the Presidents, the Vice-Presidents, Chairman of Council, Treasurer, Honorary General Editor, and one, or more, Honorary Secretaries, and twelve ordinary members, to be elected annually; but vacancies occurring between the general meetings shall be filled up by the Council. The Council may, if they think fit, elect a Chairman from outside their own body.

V.—A General Meeting of the Subscribers shall be held annually in the autumn to receive the Secretary's Report on the work and proceedings of the Society, and the Treasurer's Financial Statement; to elect officers for the ensuing year; and to transact the business of the Society generally. Notice of any business to be brought forward shall be given to the Secretary at least three weeks before the date of this Meeting.

VI.—The Council shall meet when necessary for the dispatch of business, three forming a quorum, including the Secretary. Presidents and Vice-Presidents shall not be summoned to meetings of the Council unless they shall have given notice in writing to the Secretary of their desire to serve upon it. The Chairman of the Meeting shall have a casting vote.

VII.—These Rules may not be amended or altered except at the Annual General Meeting, and notice of any proposed change shall be given to the Secretary at least three weeks before the date of the Meeting at which it is to be considered.
