

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Article 5. Uniform Accounting System for Municipal Courts
and Justice Courts

116c. The State Controller shall establish, supervise, and as necessary from time to time modify a uniform accounting system, including a system of audit, for municipal courts and justice courts, to the end that all moneys received and disbursed by such courts shall be properly and uniformly accounted for.

116d. Such system shall provide for trust bank accounts for each municipal or justice court, in which all moneys received by such court shall be deposited and from which all disbursements by such court shall be made, and for such records, reports, and procedures as the State Controller may deem necessary to carry out the purposes of this article.

116e. Every judge of a municipal court or justice court, or the clerk of any such court who wilfully fails to keep accounts in accordance with said system or to account for the moneys paid into and disbursed by his court in accordance with the system established by the State Controller pursuant to this article is guilty of a misdemeanor.

116f. The accounts of each municipal court and justice court shall be audited at least once a year. The county auditor shall supply the State Controller with a certified copy of each such audit. If the accounts of any municipal or justice court are not audited annually, the State Controller shall audit such accounts.

116g. This article shall supersede any existing provisions of law which are in conflict therewith.

116h. In counties having a population in excess of 2,000,000, the system established pursuant to this article may provide for the deposit of all moneys collected by municipal and justice courts in the county treasury and for disbursement therefrom and for the audit of such accounts by the county auditor.
