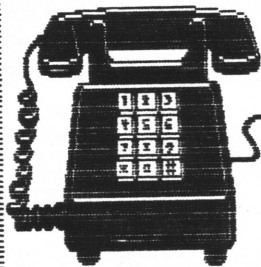

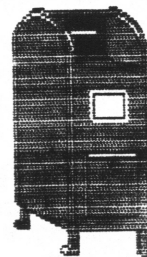

WELCOME.

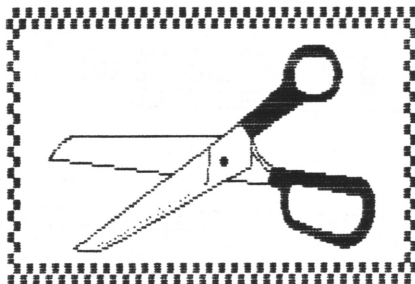
OUR NEWSLETTER IS PRINTED
