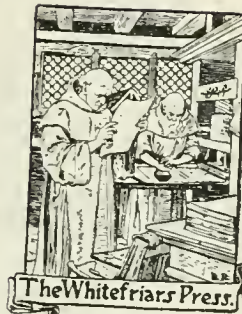
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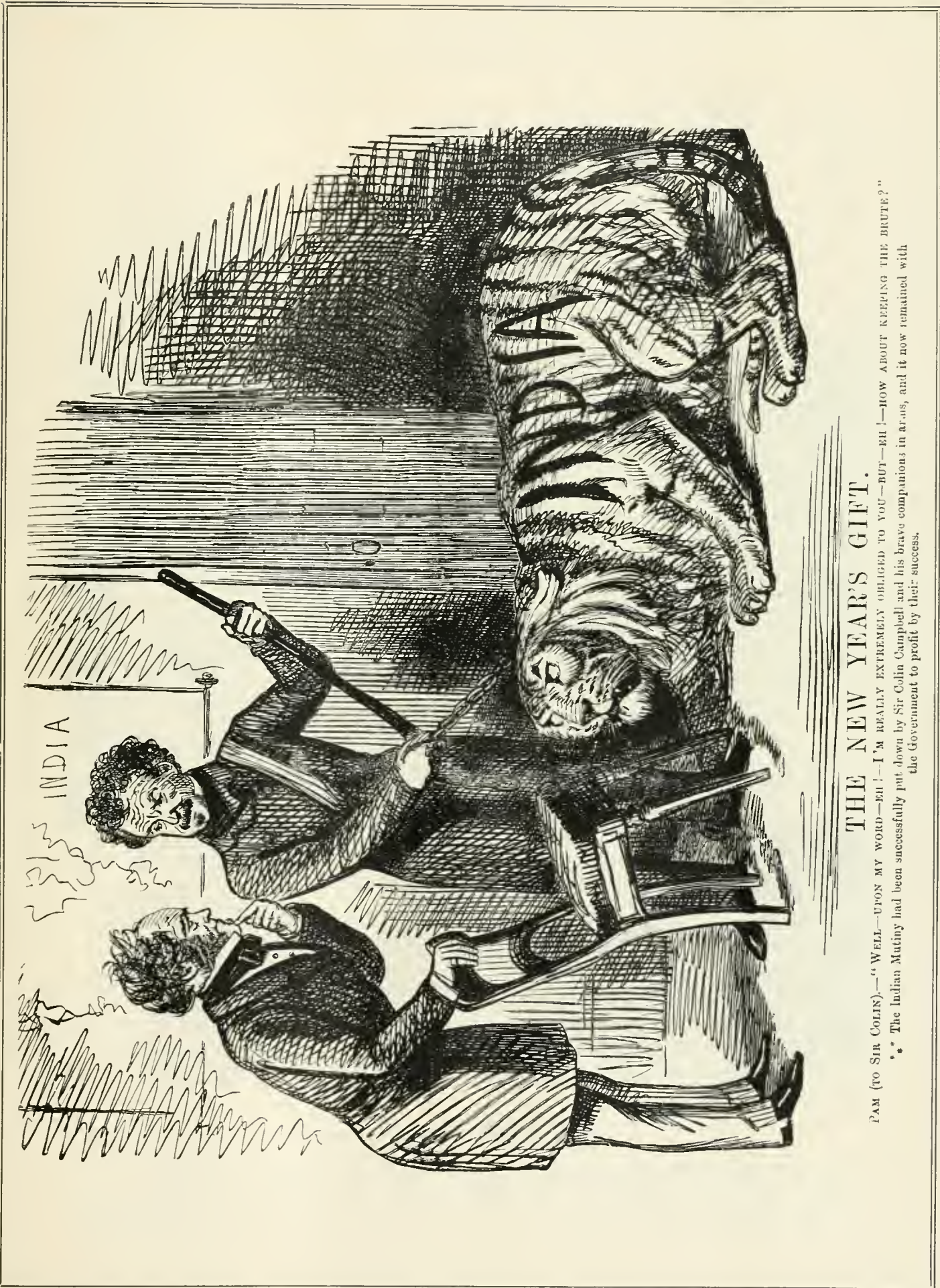

“HEALTH AND HAPPINESS TO THE BRIDE AND BRIDEGROOM! (HOORAH!)”

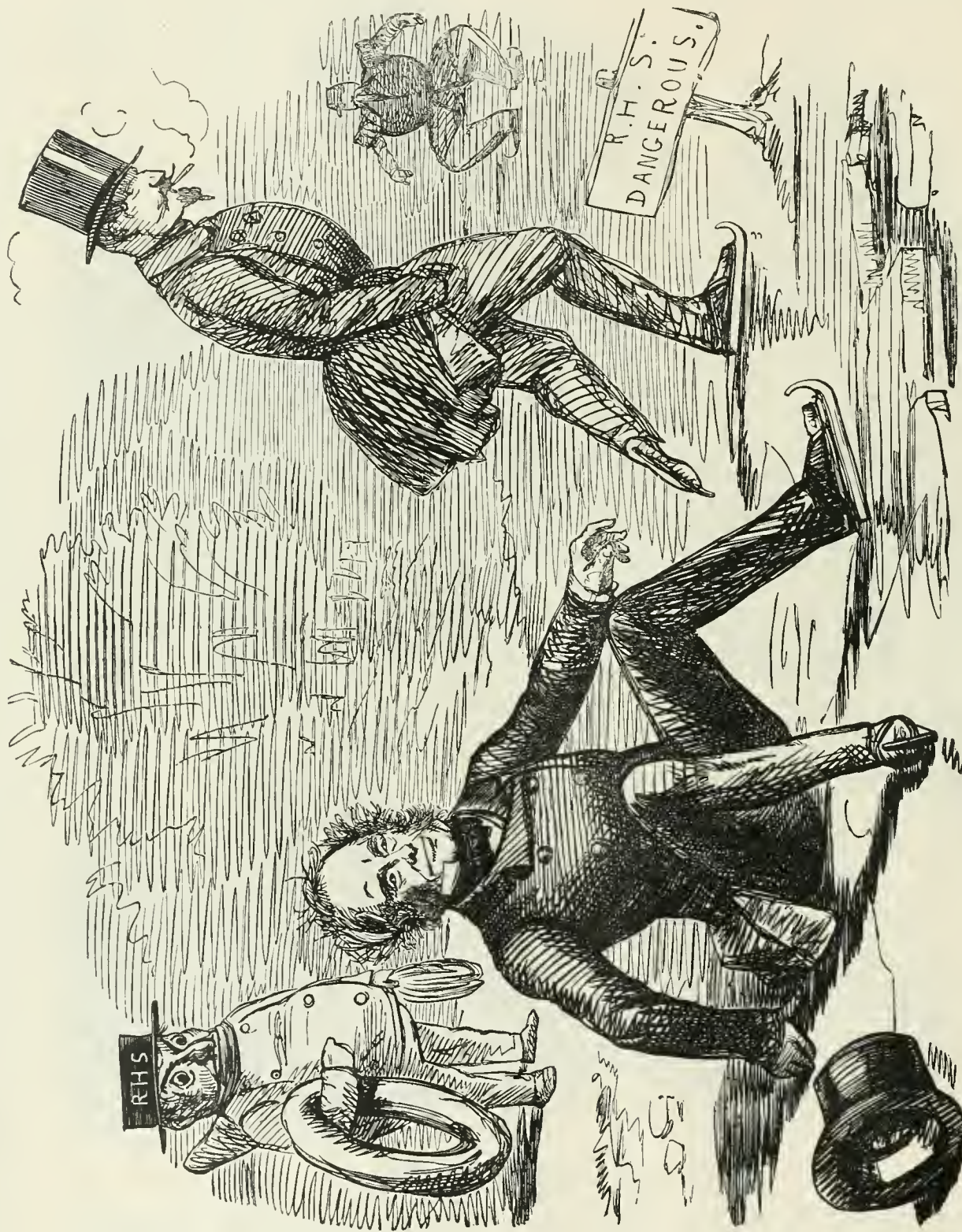
\*.\* The marriage of the Princess Royal of England to Prince Frederick William of Prussia was celebrated at the Chapel Royal, St. James.’

**DIGNIFIED POSITION.**

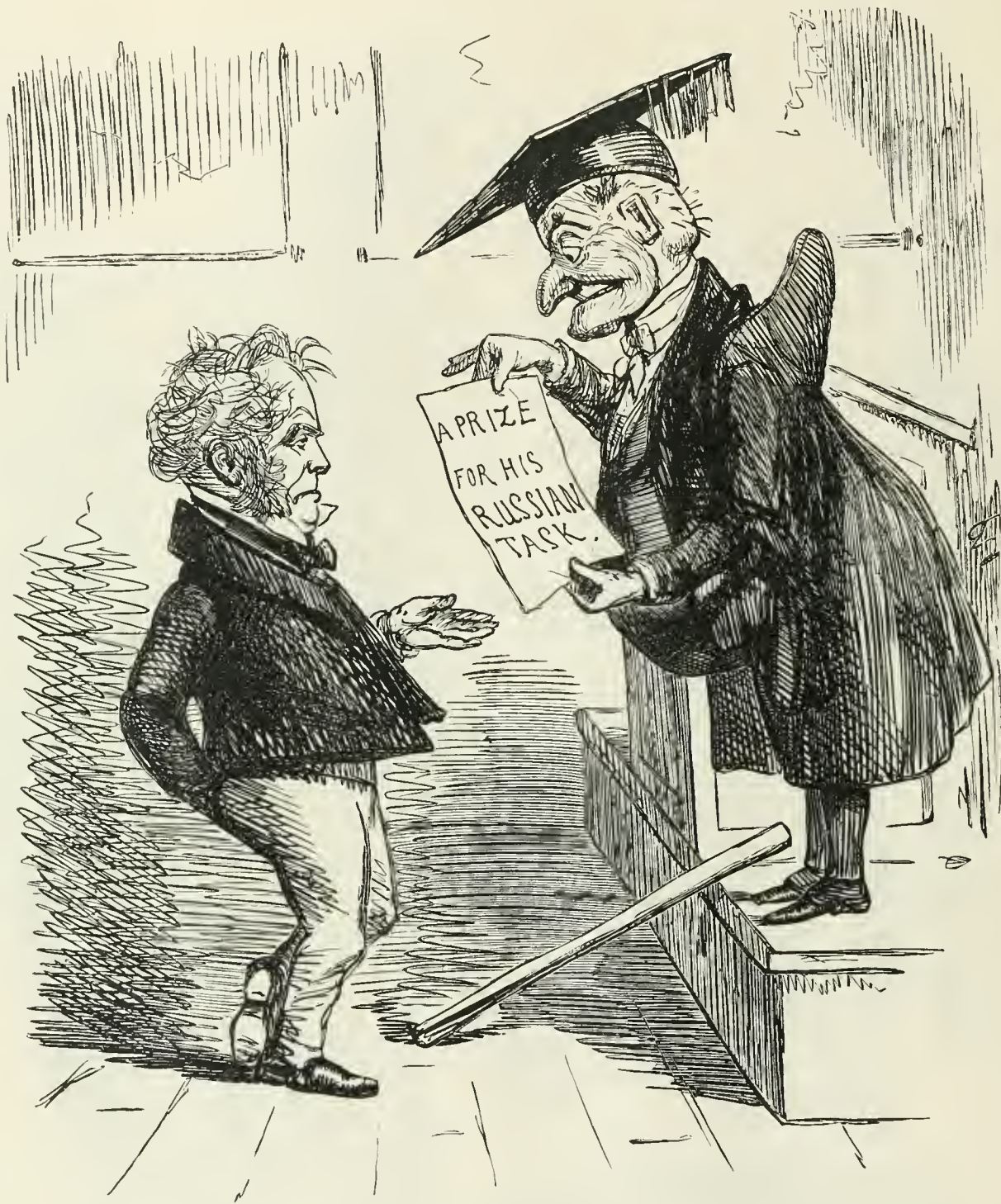

\* \* A feature of Mr. Disraeli's Budget was the imposition of the penny stamp on bankers' cheques. The Budget on the whole was favourably received.



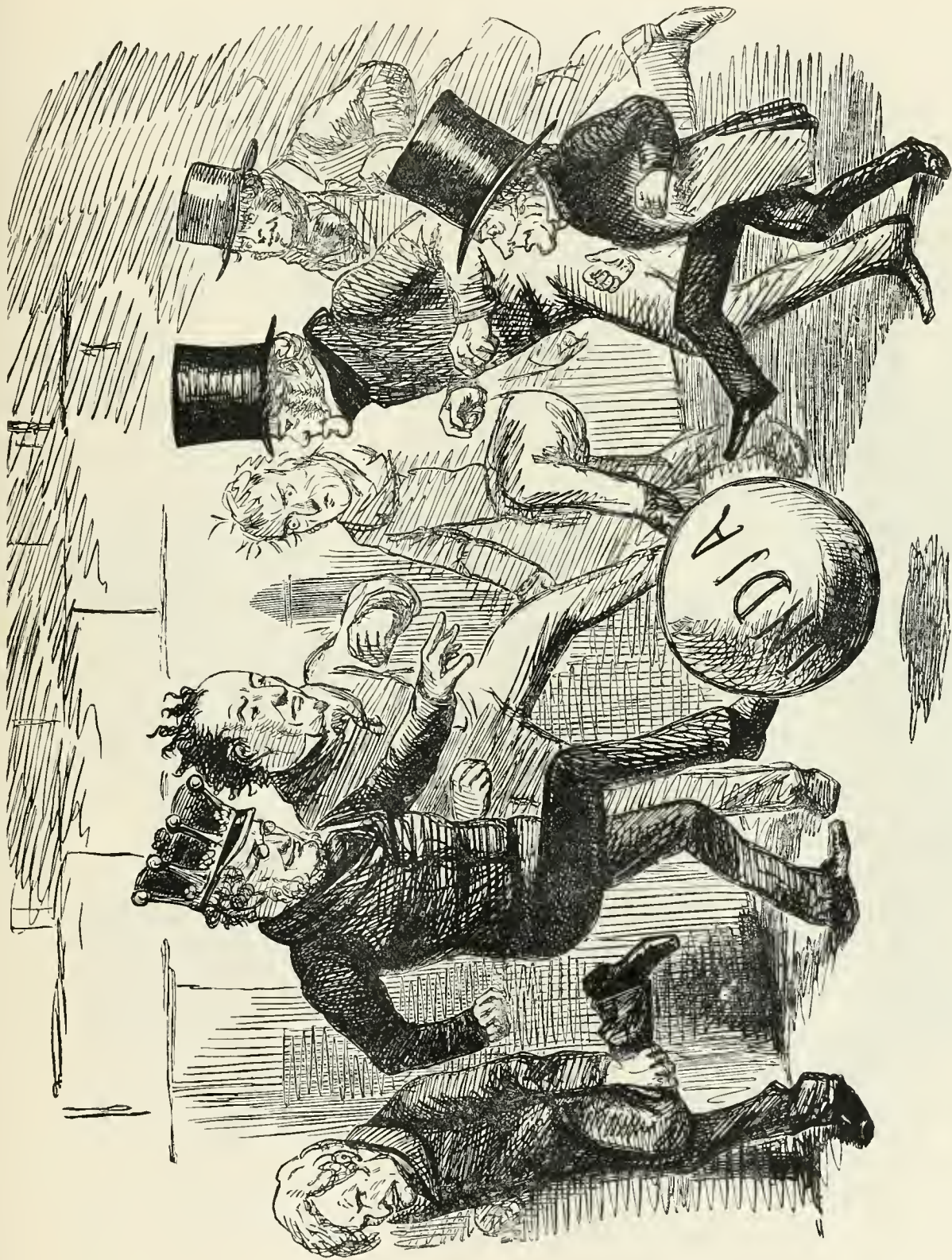
THE GOOD LITTLE ROBINS BURYING THE BILLS IN THE WOOD.

### A GAME OF FOOT-BALL,

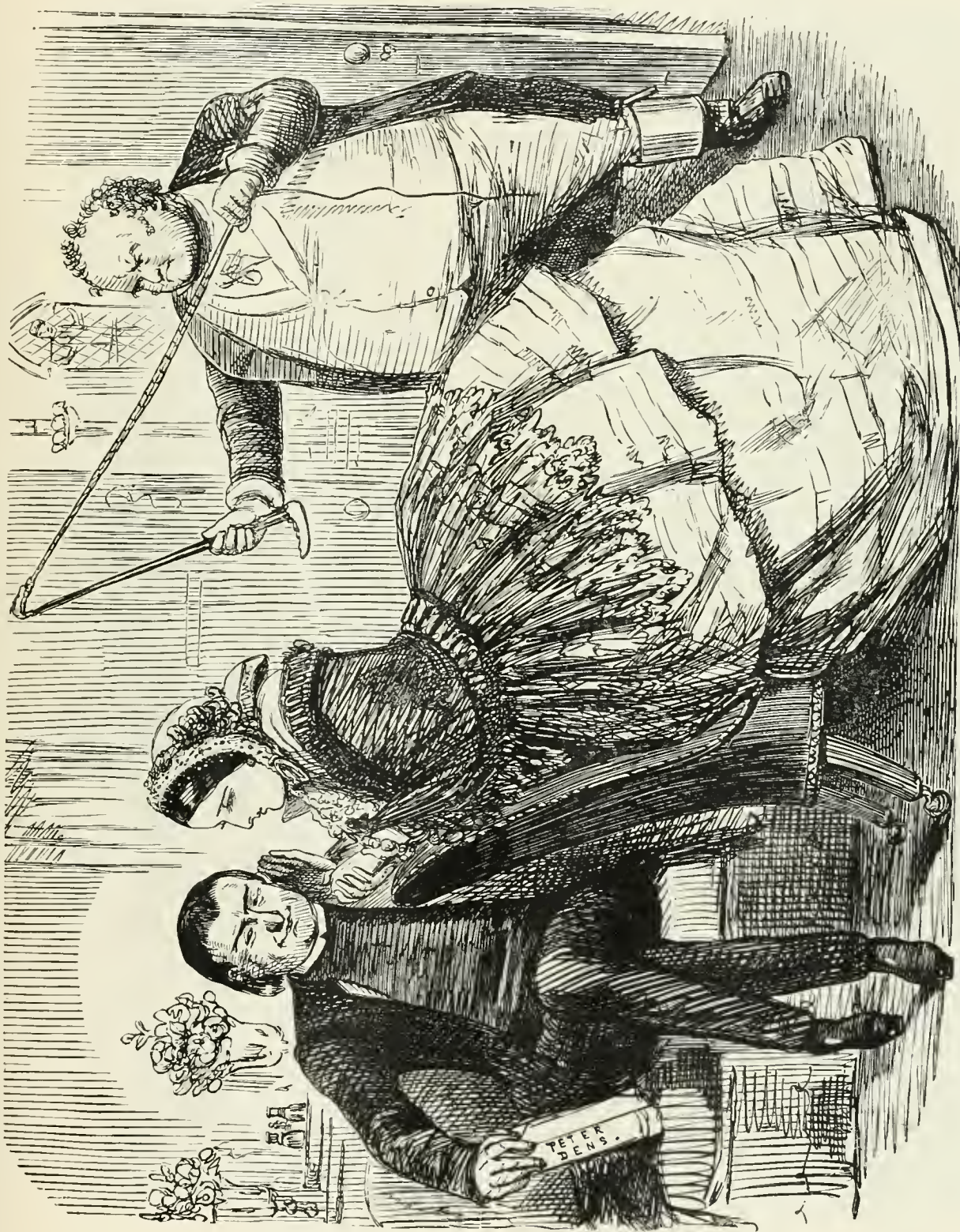
AS PLAYED BY CERTAIN WESTMINSTER BOYS.

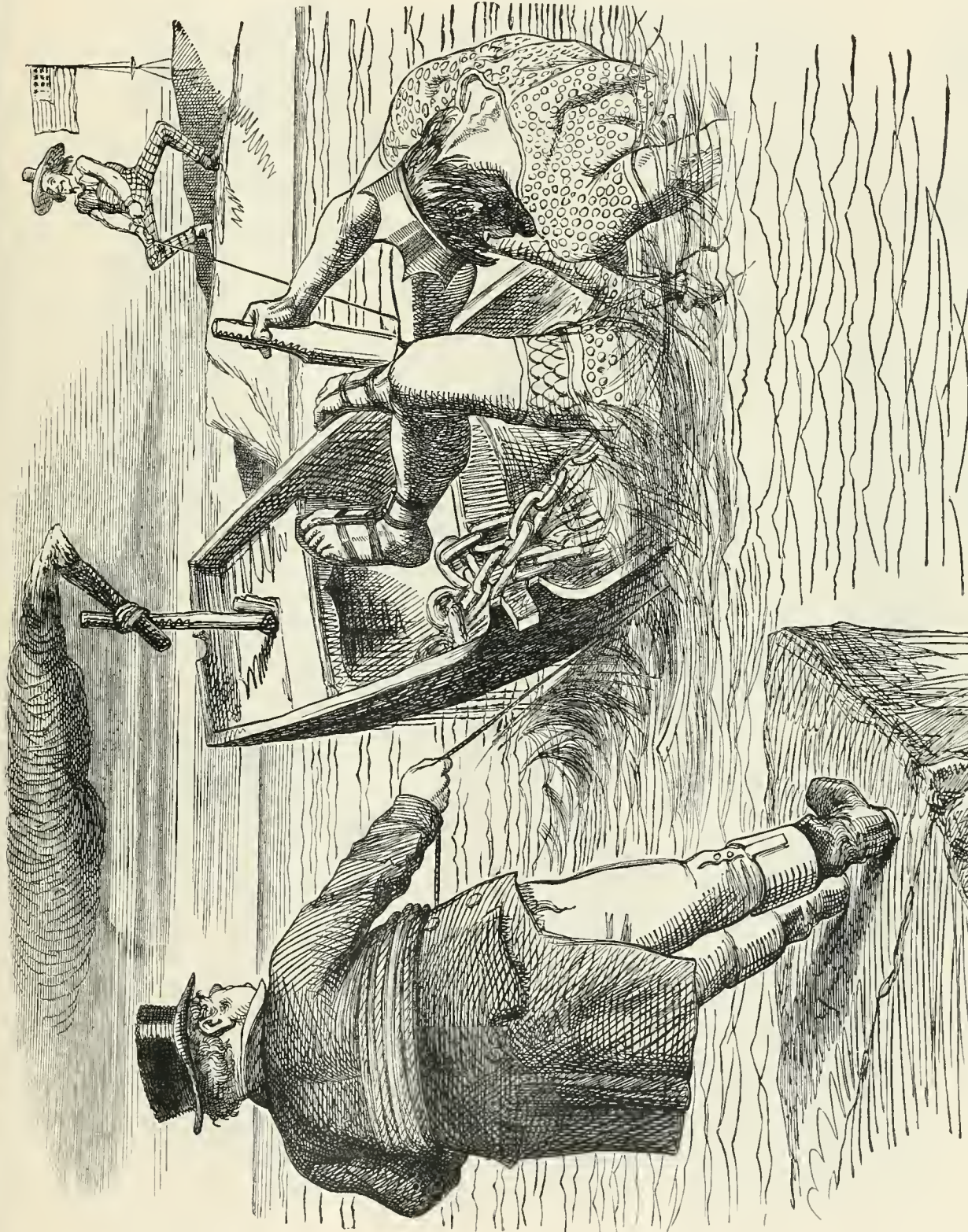
\* \* A grand society fête, held at Cremorne Gardens, for which vouchers were required and tickets were one guinea, was spoilt by the rain which fell in torrents.

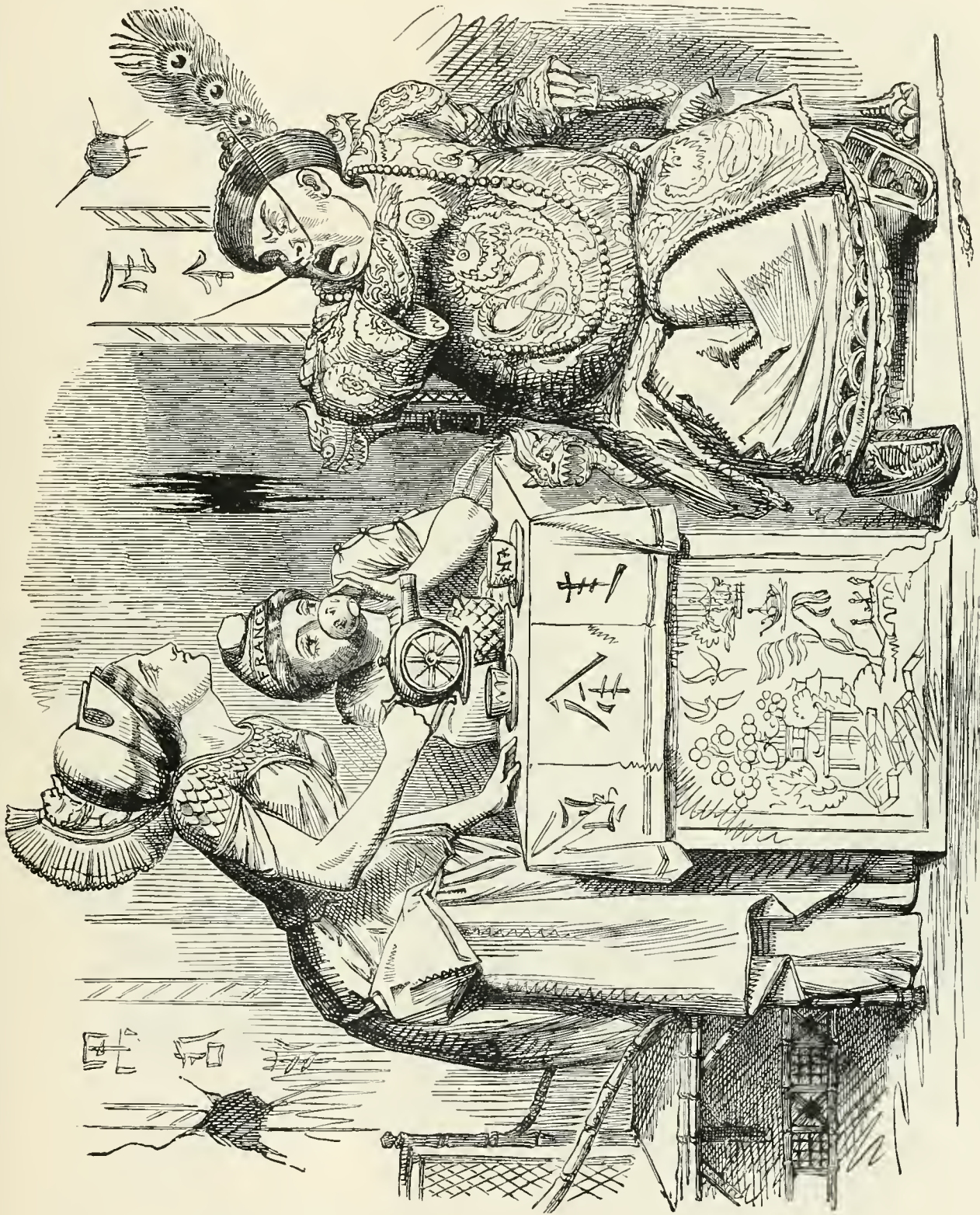

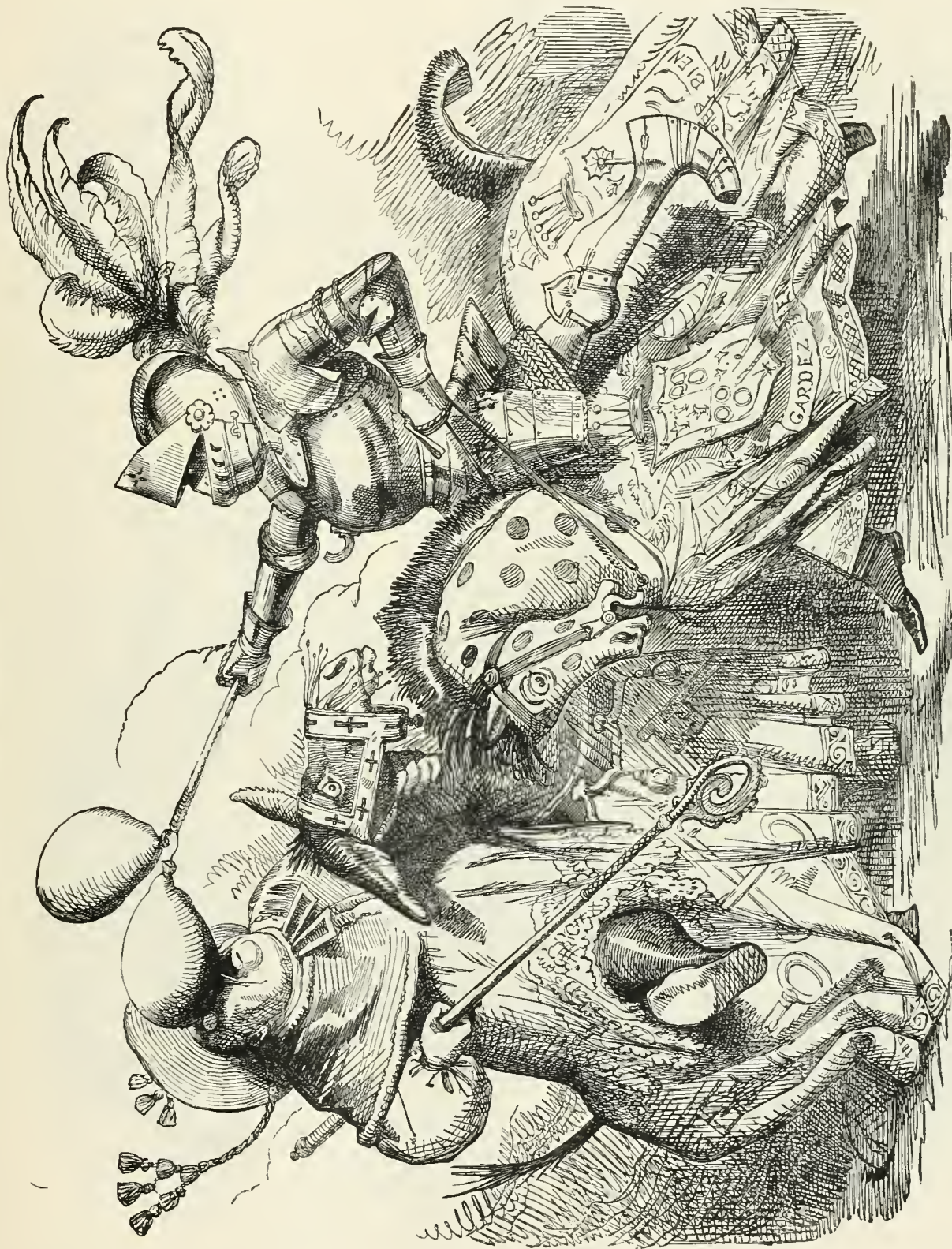
CHINA.—“O—NO—TAN—KE—MUM.”

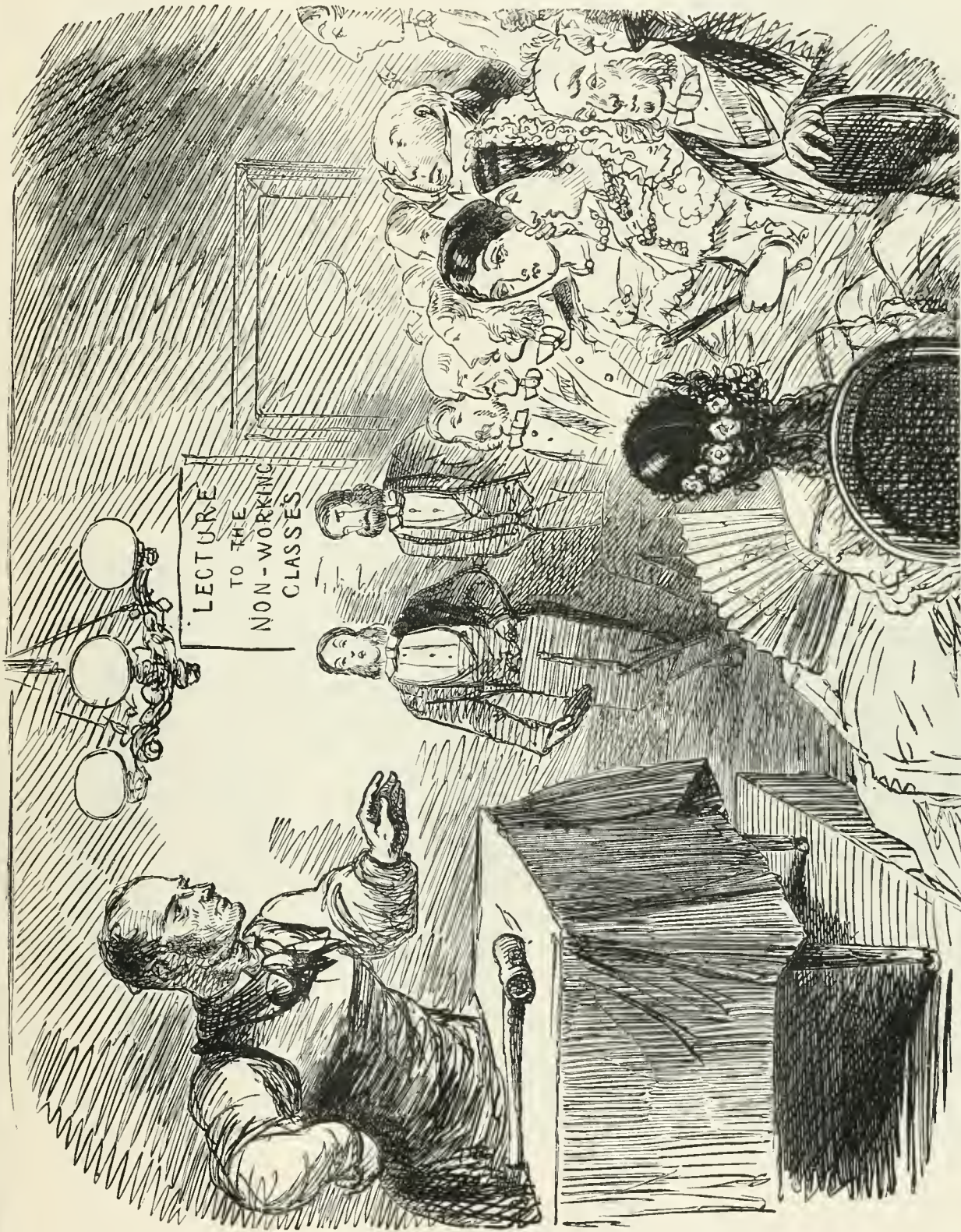

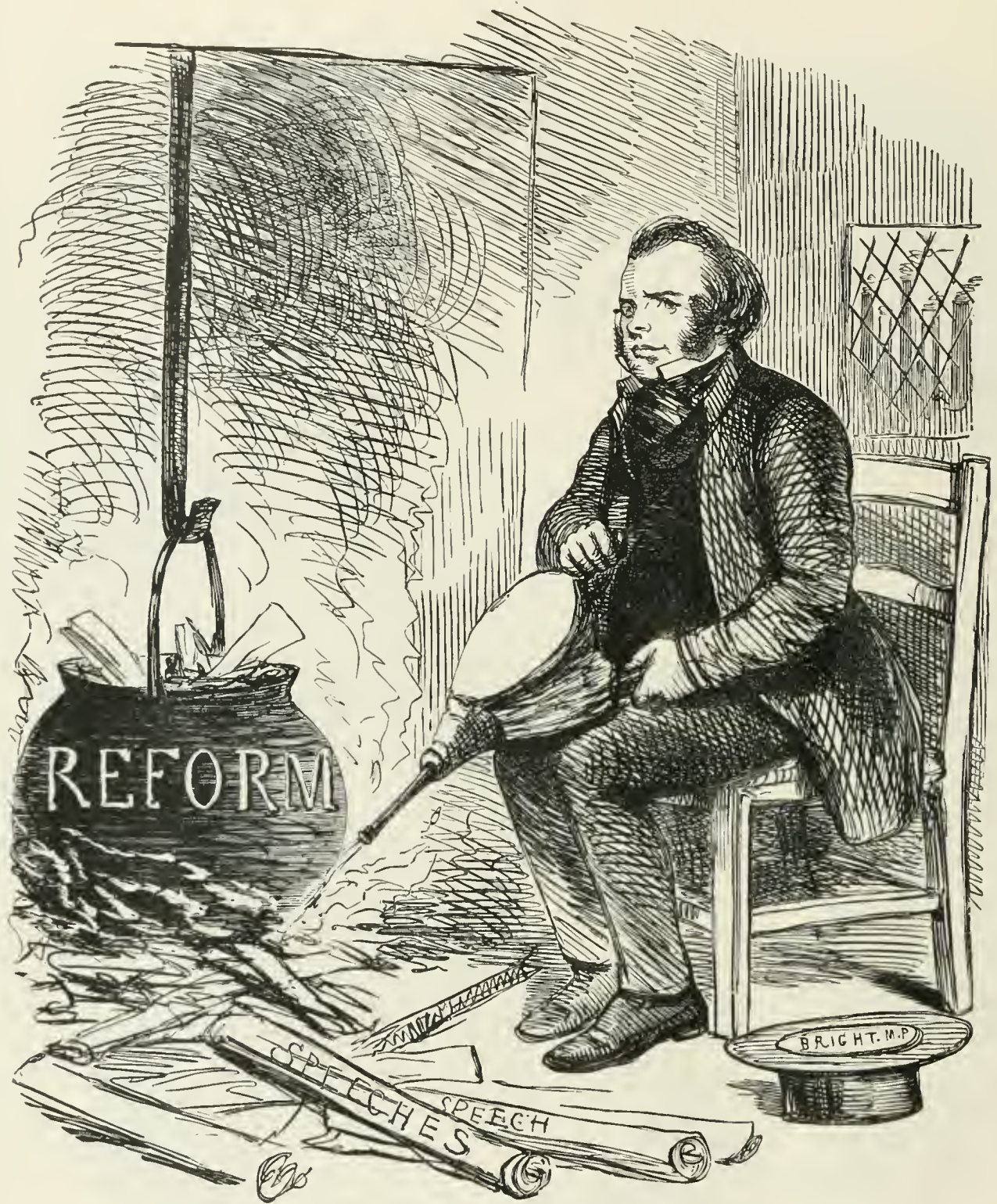
\*.\* The venerable, but still vigorous, Lord Brougham delivered a most admirable address at the meeting of the Social Science Association.

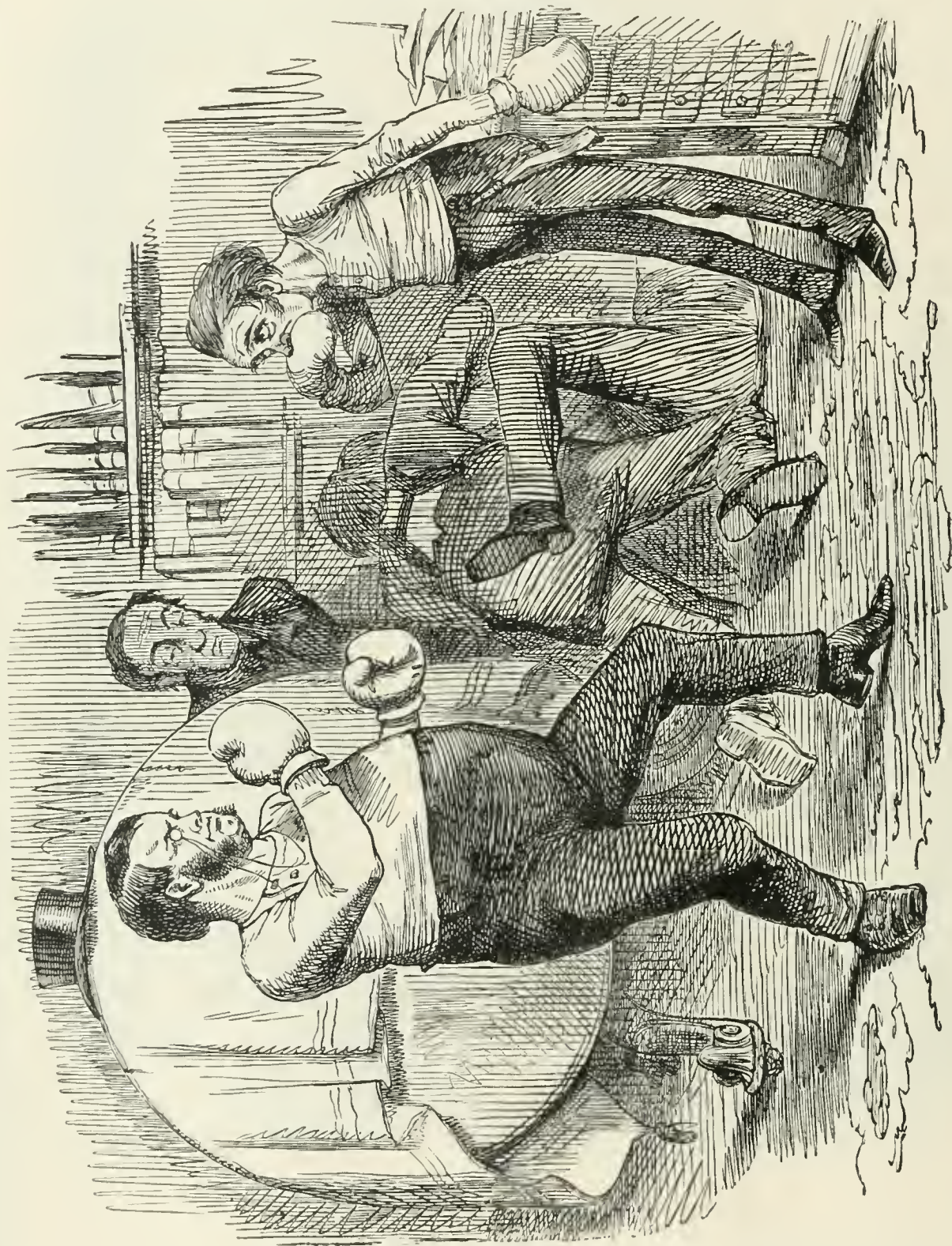
•• The Bishop of London revoked the licence of the curate of St. Barnabas who had become notorious for his practice of Romish ceremonial and observances.

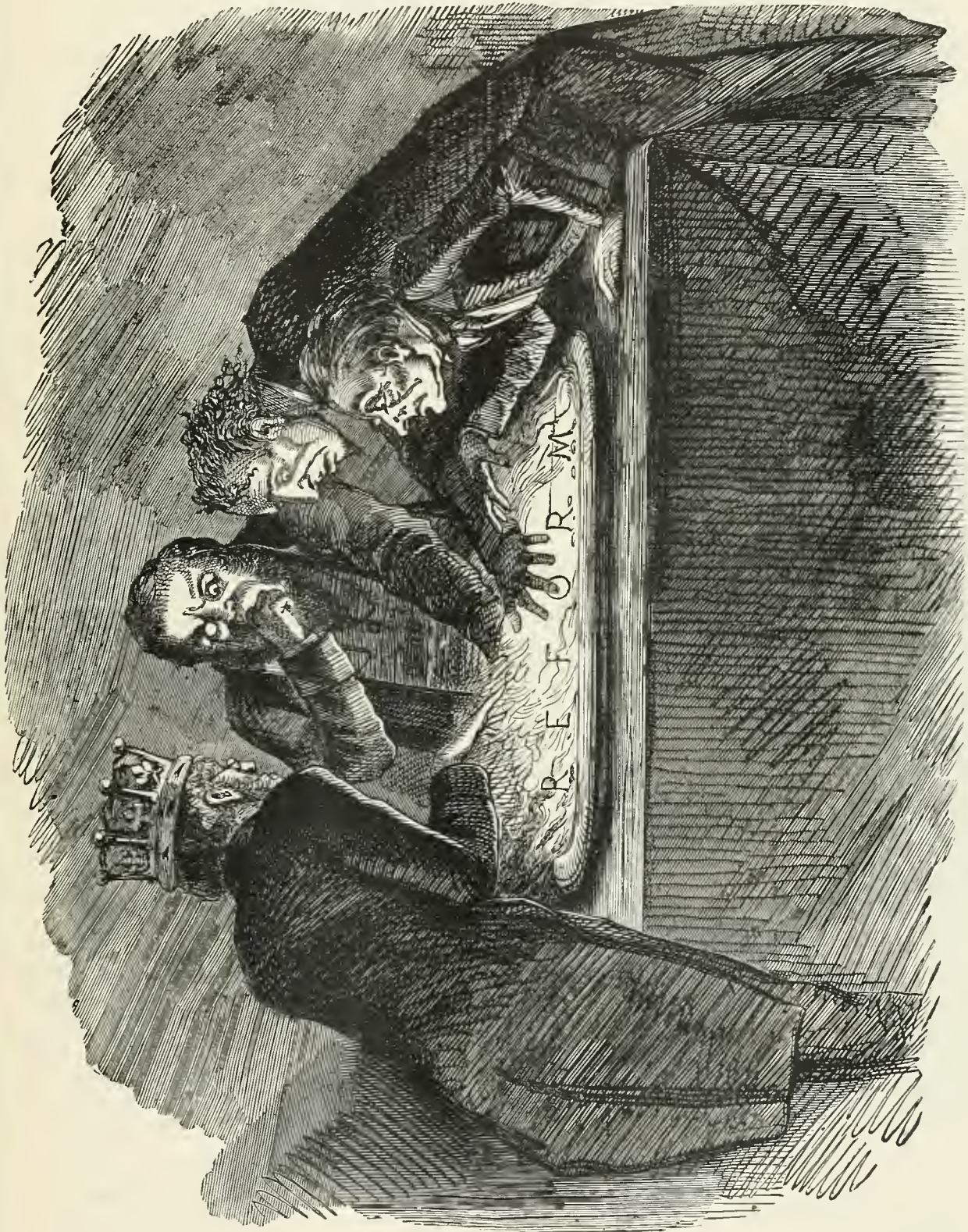

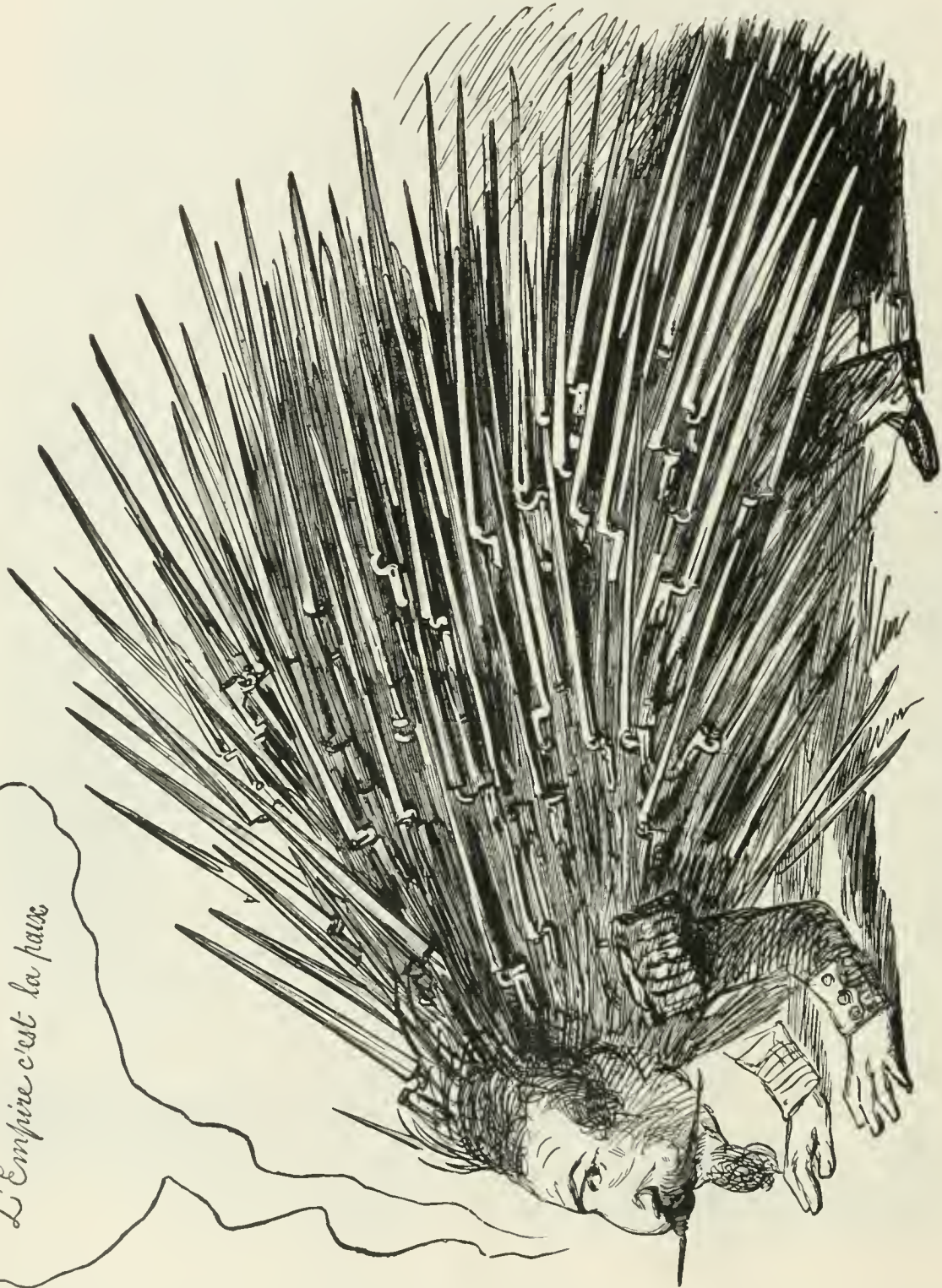




## THE TORCH OF HYMEN.

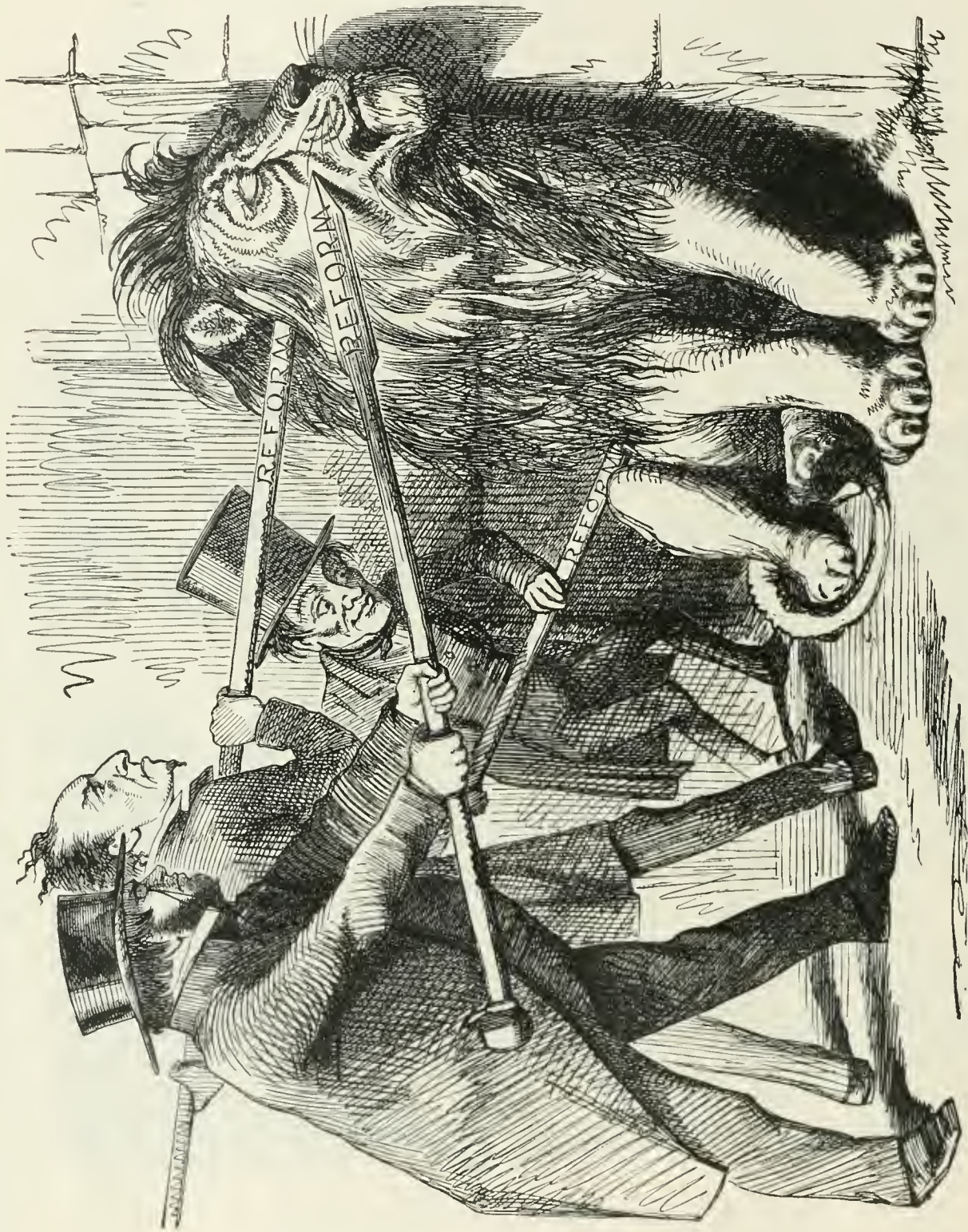

## THE QUEEN IN HER STOREROOM.

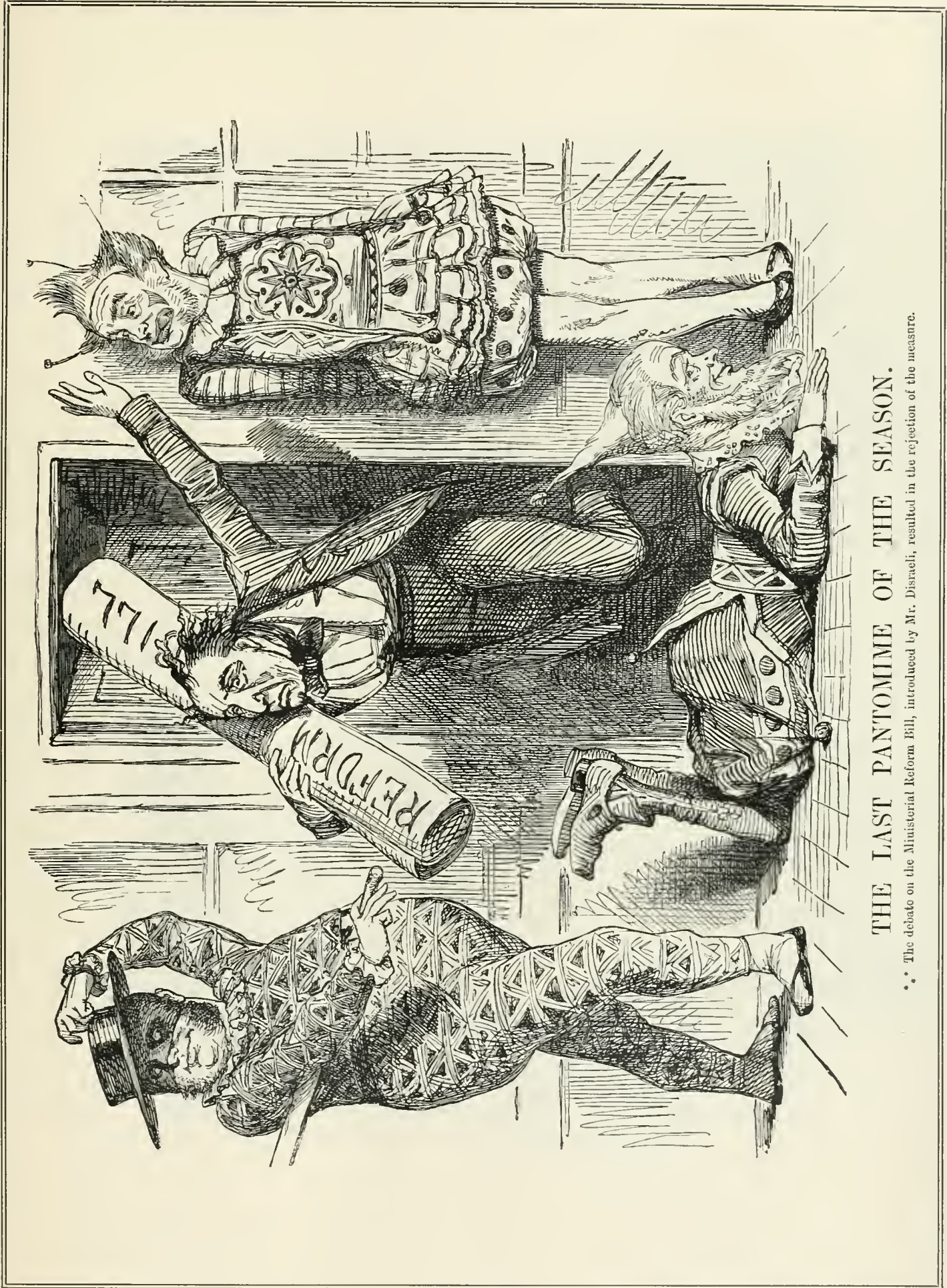

\*.\* Public attention was at this time directed to the menacing aspect of Continental affairs.



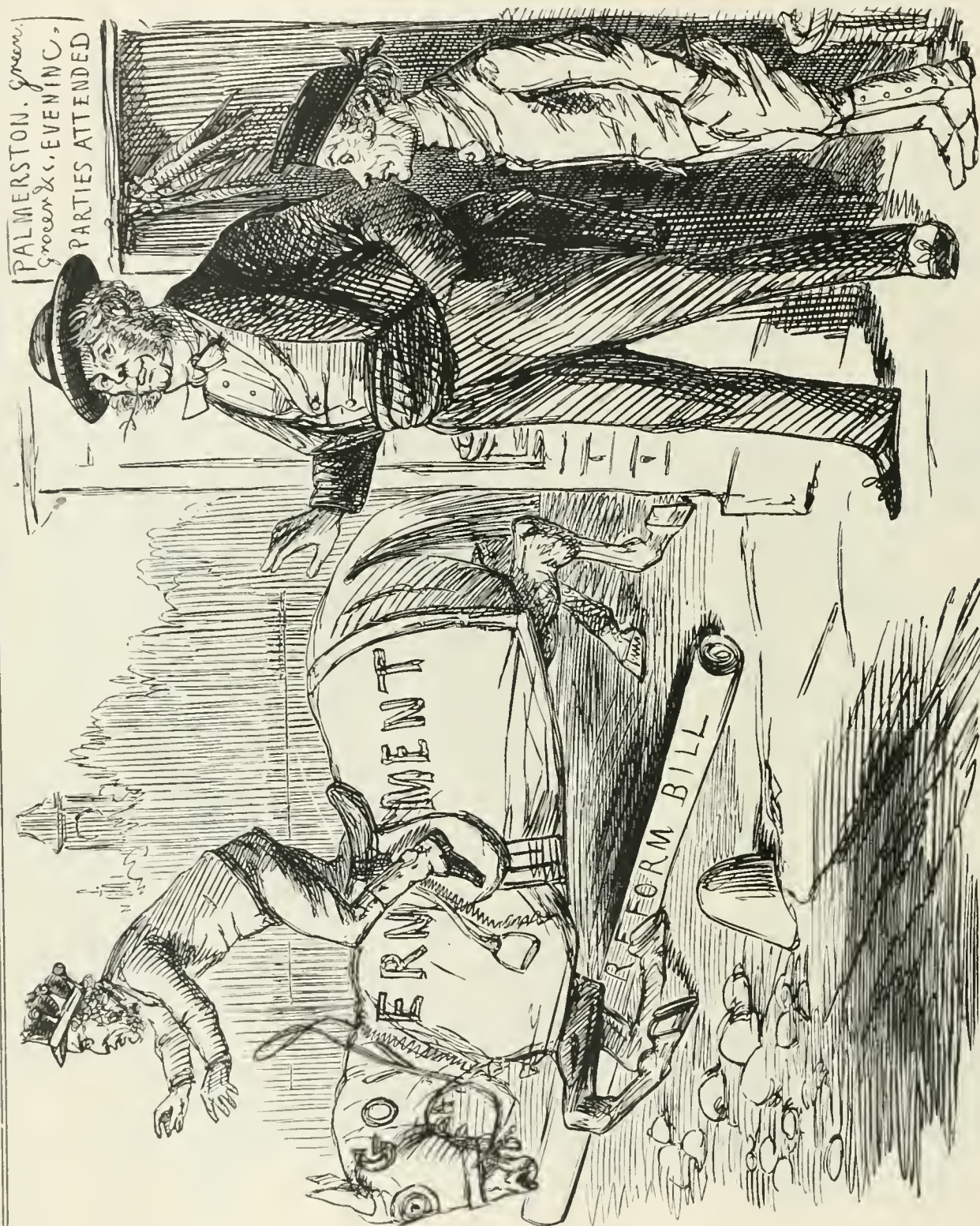
### WHO WILL ROUSE HIM?

\*.\* Tory, Whig and Liberal were all devoting themselves in words, at this time, to the interests of the working man.

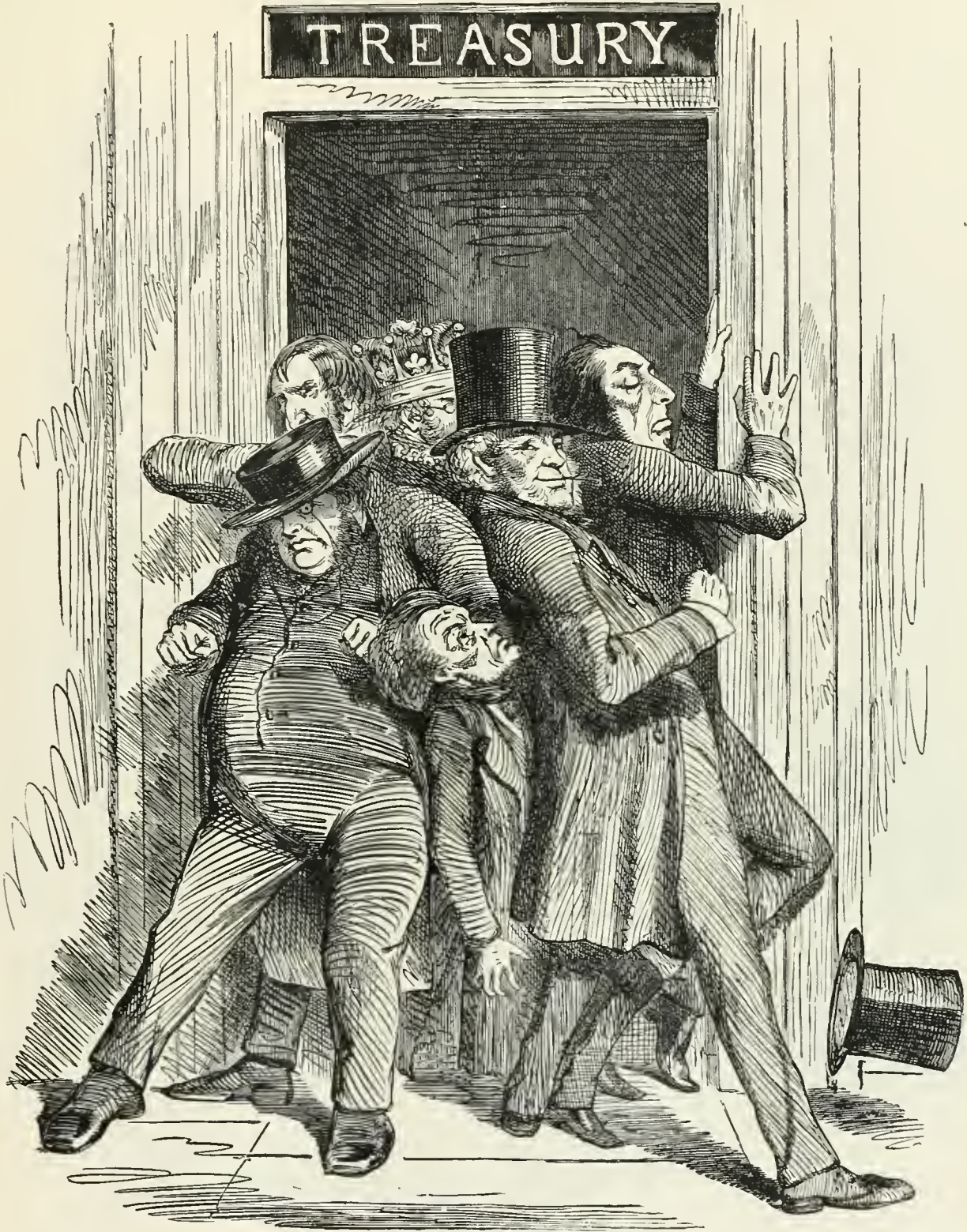

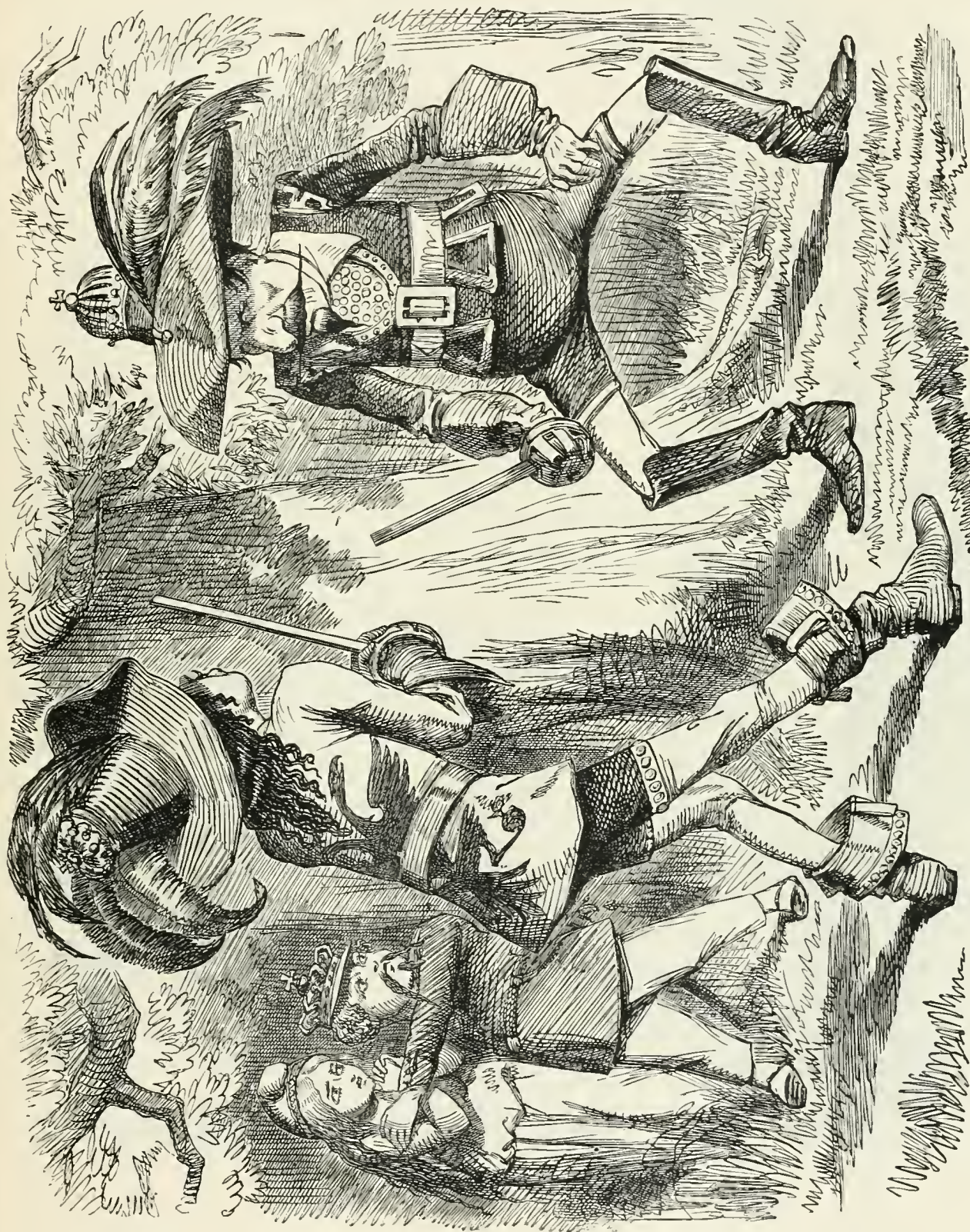

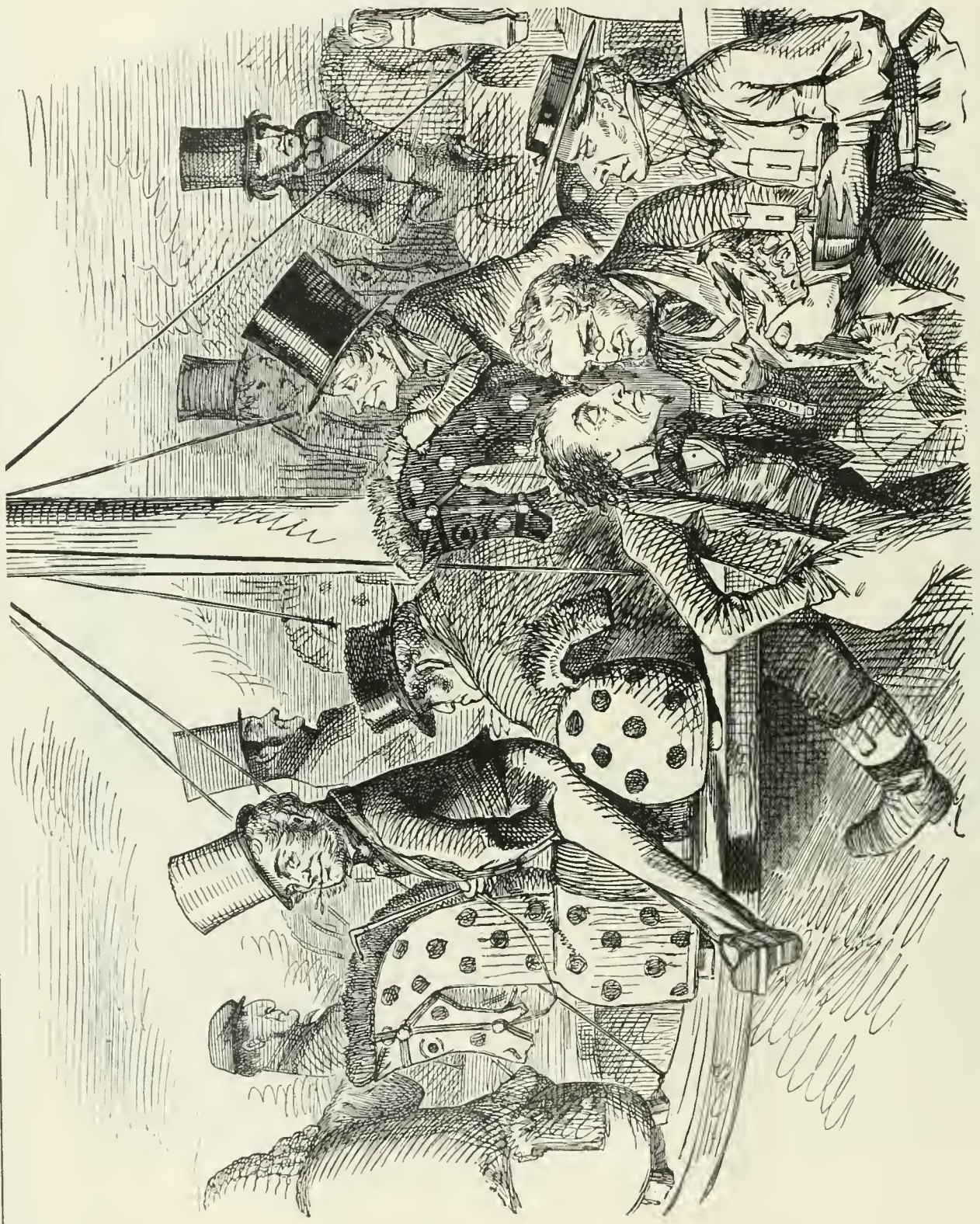
•• It was not altogether believed that the French Emperor’s desire to emancipate Italy from the yoke of Austria was disinterested.

**TURN AND TURN-ABOUT.**

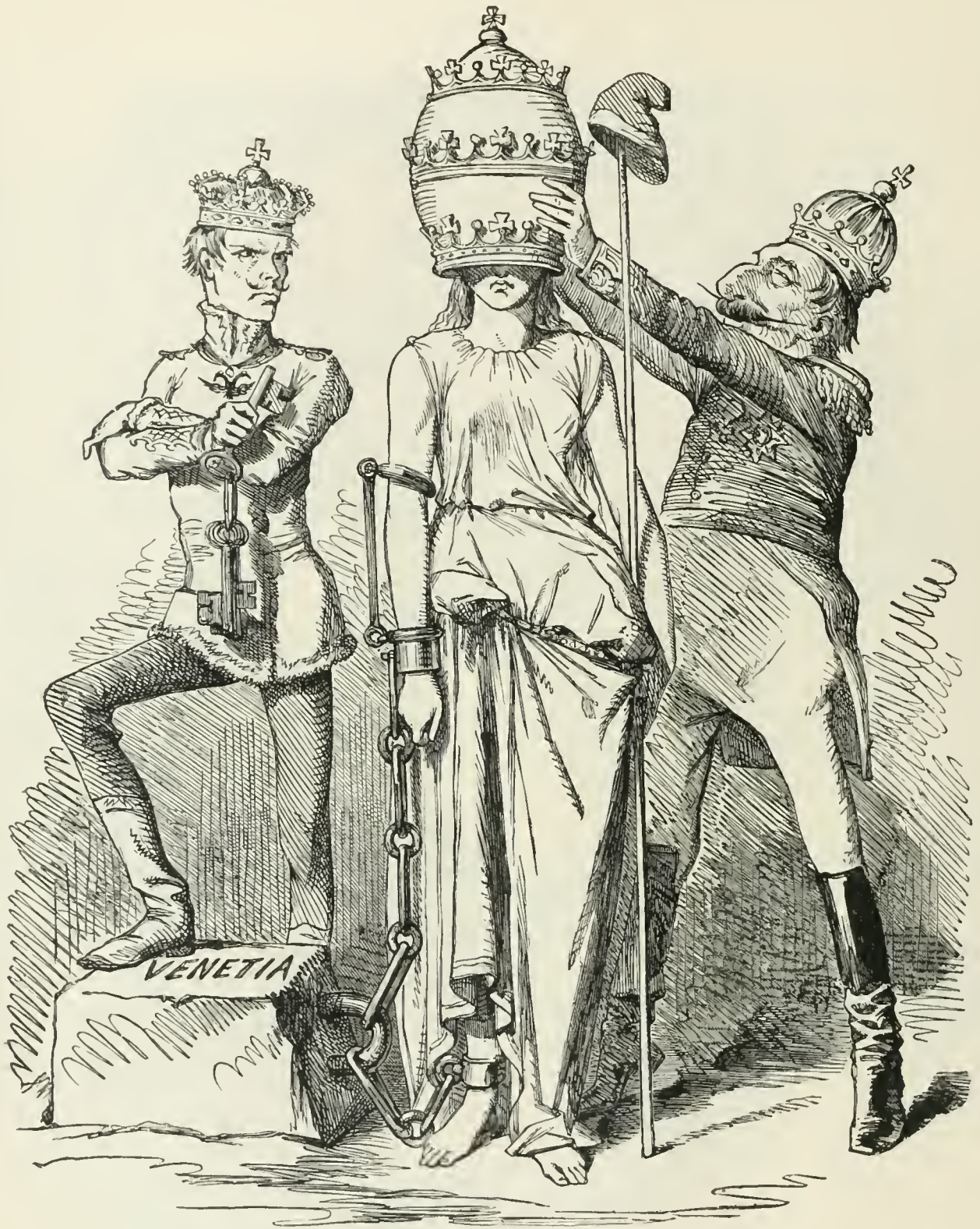

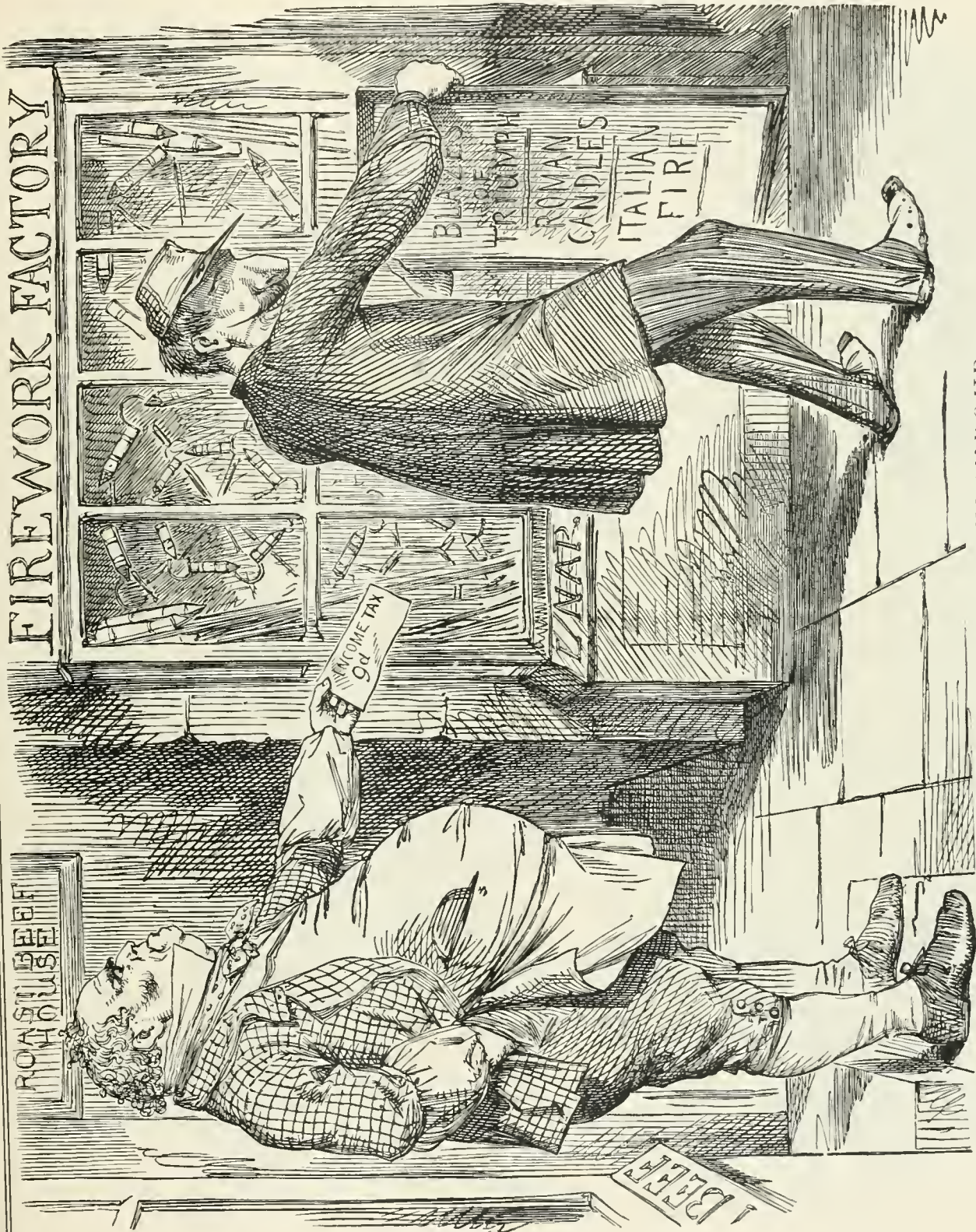


### FREE ITALY (?)

### PEACEFUL—VERY!

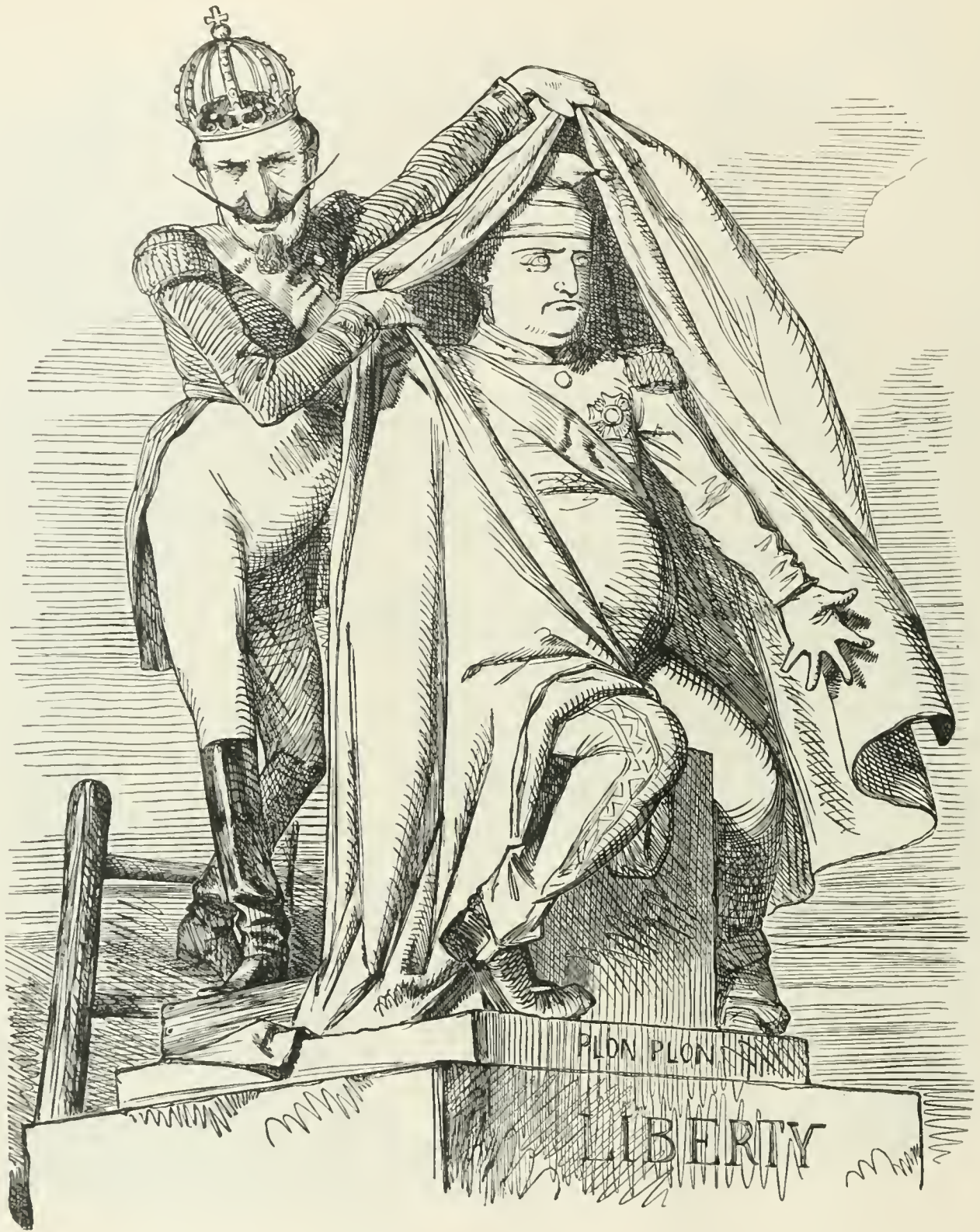
•• The French Emperor was loud in his professions of peace. In England he was not altogether trusted.



## THE FIRST LESSON.

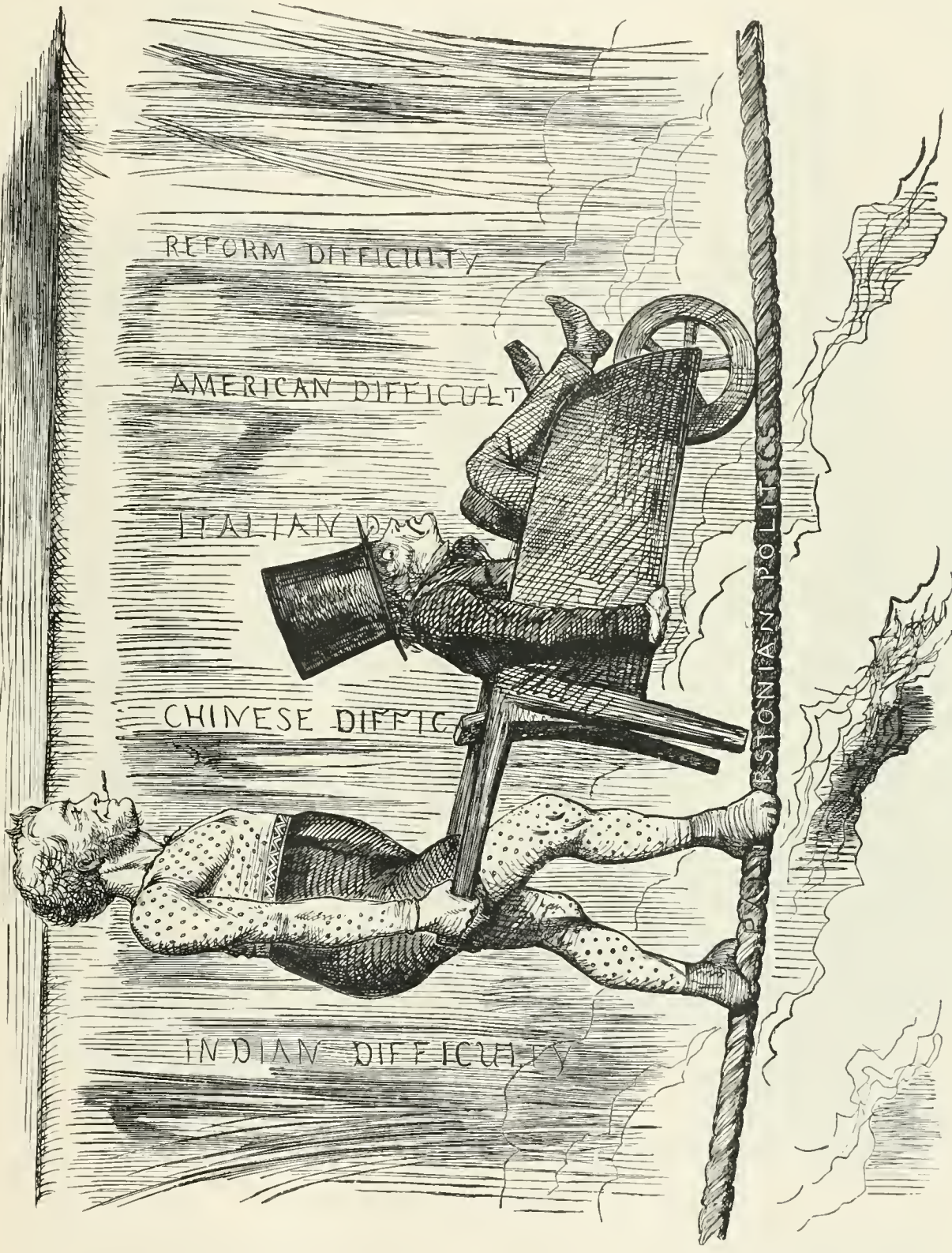
NOT SO BAD FOR A BEGINNER!

\*.\* The veteran reformer, Lord Brougham, in a speech at Bradford, strongly condemned the continued prevalence of bribery at Parliamentary elections.

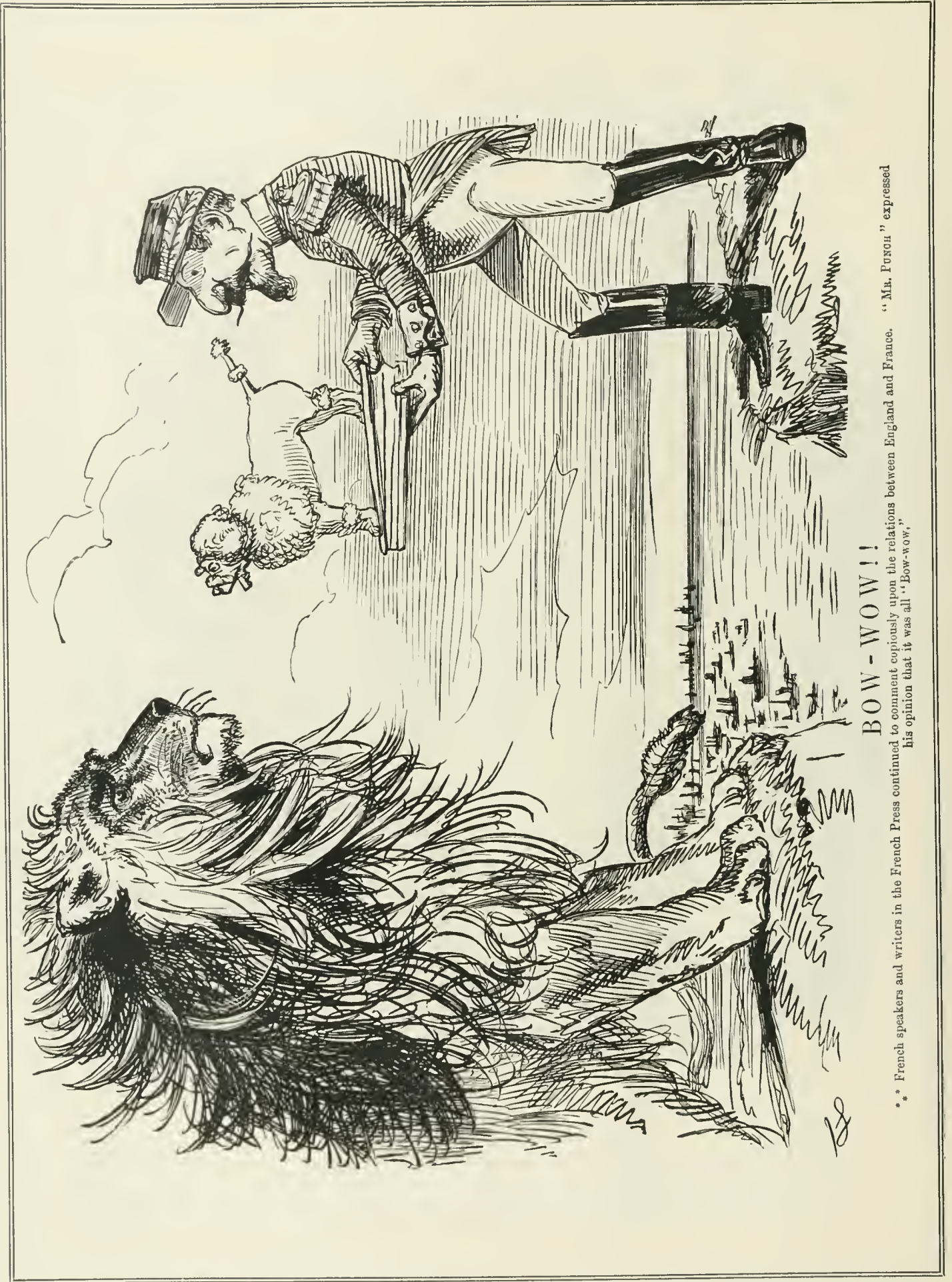




WIDE AWAKE.

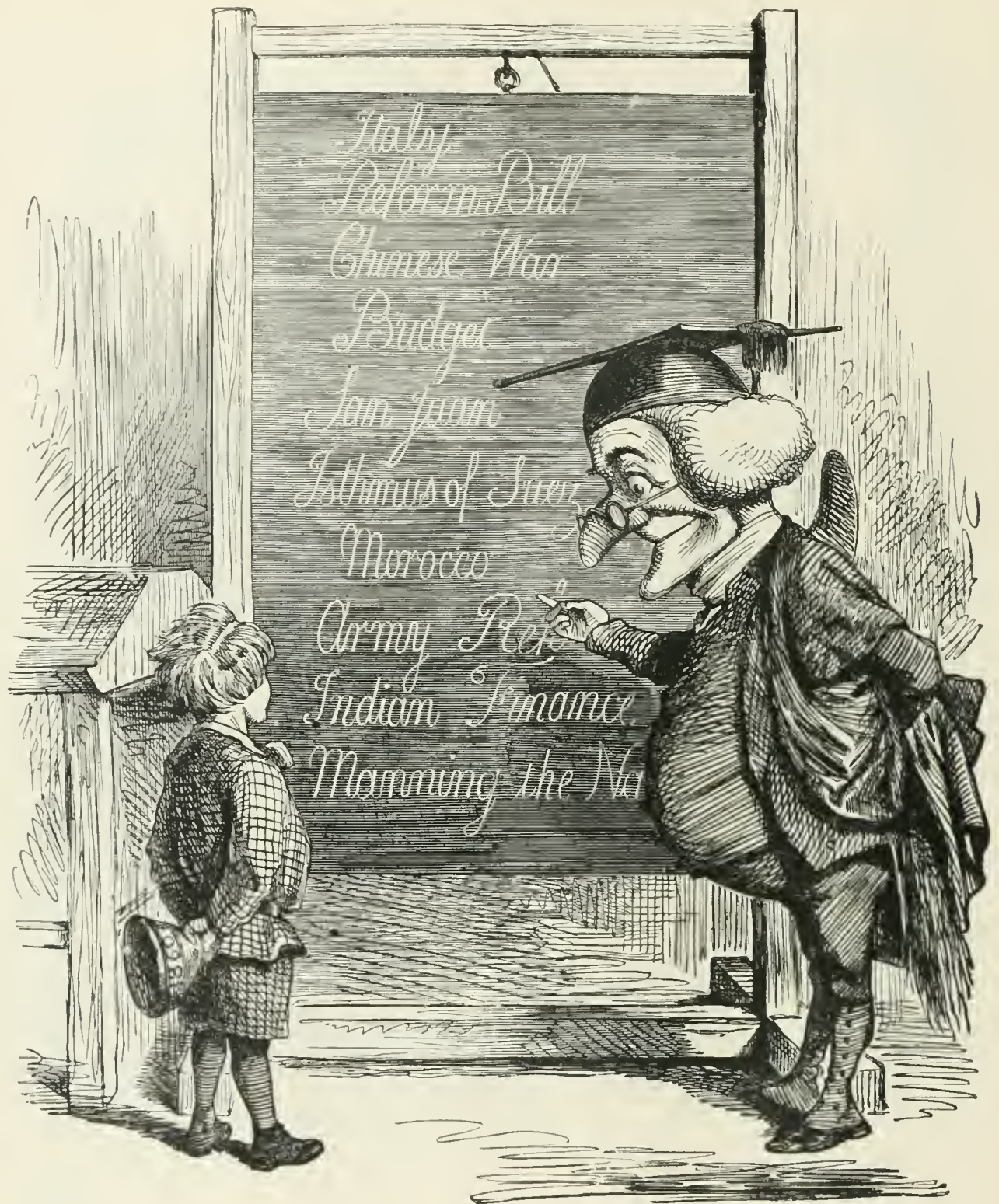

MR. PUNCH.—“THERE, MY DEAR, PUT AWAY THAT NASTY THING, AND PLANT THIS.”

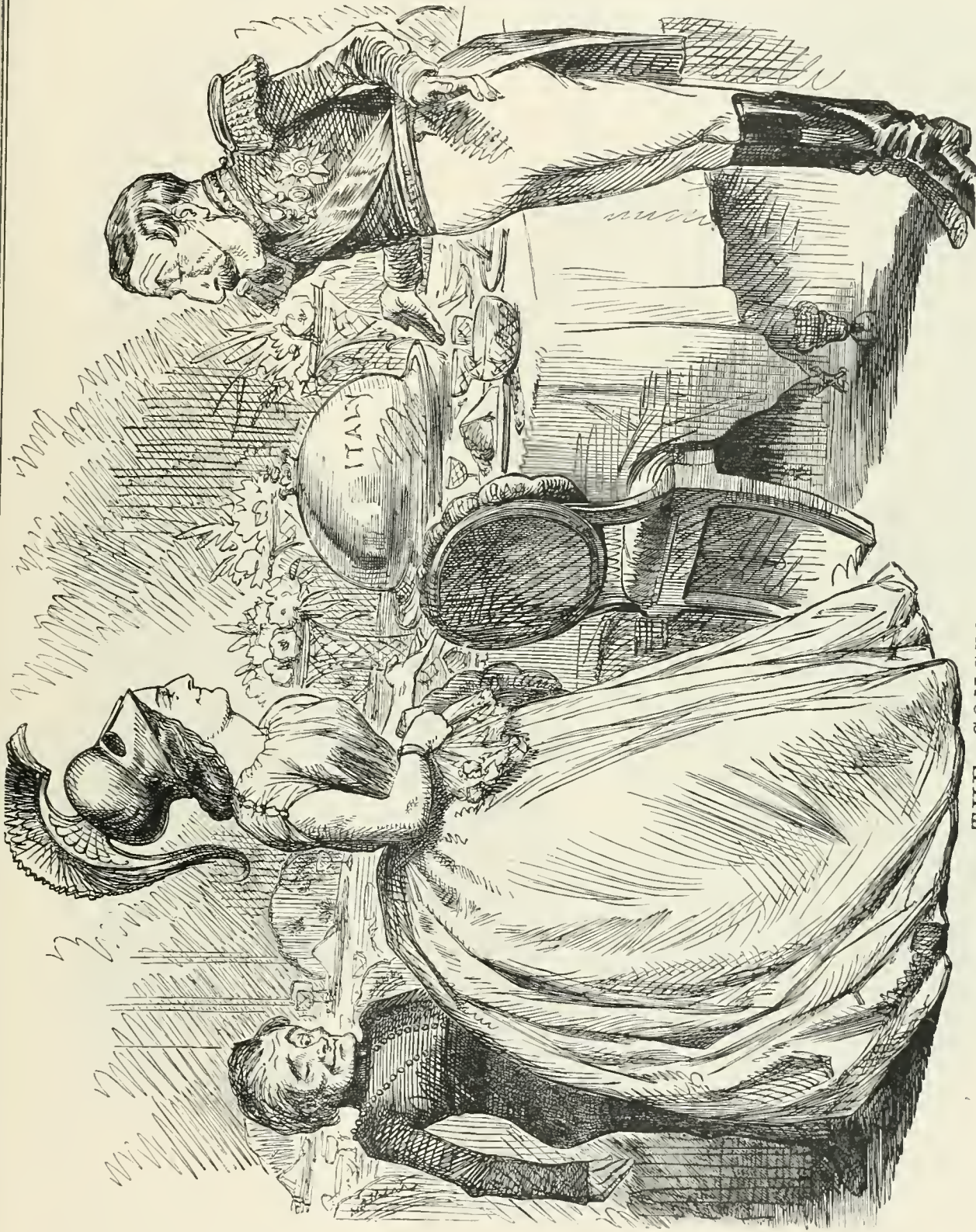

## THE CONGRESS PARTY.

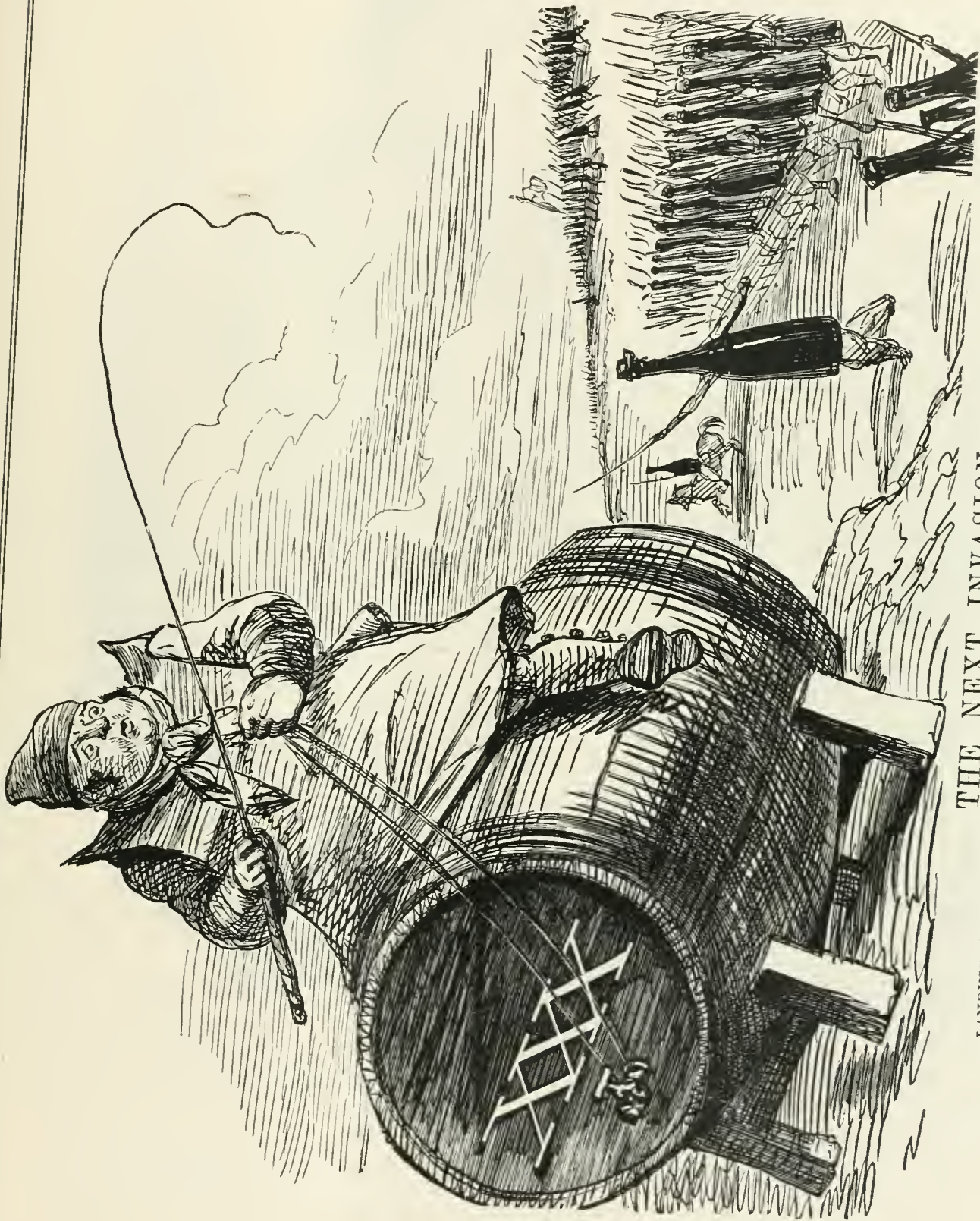

### DAME COBDEN'S NEW PUPIL.

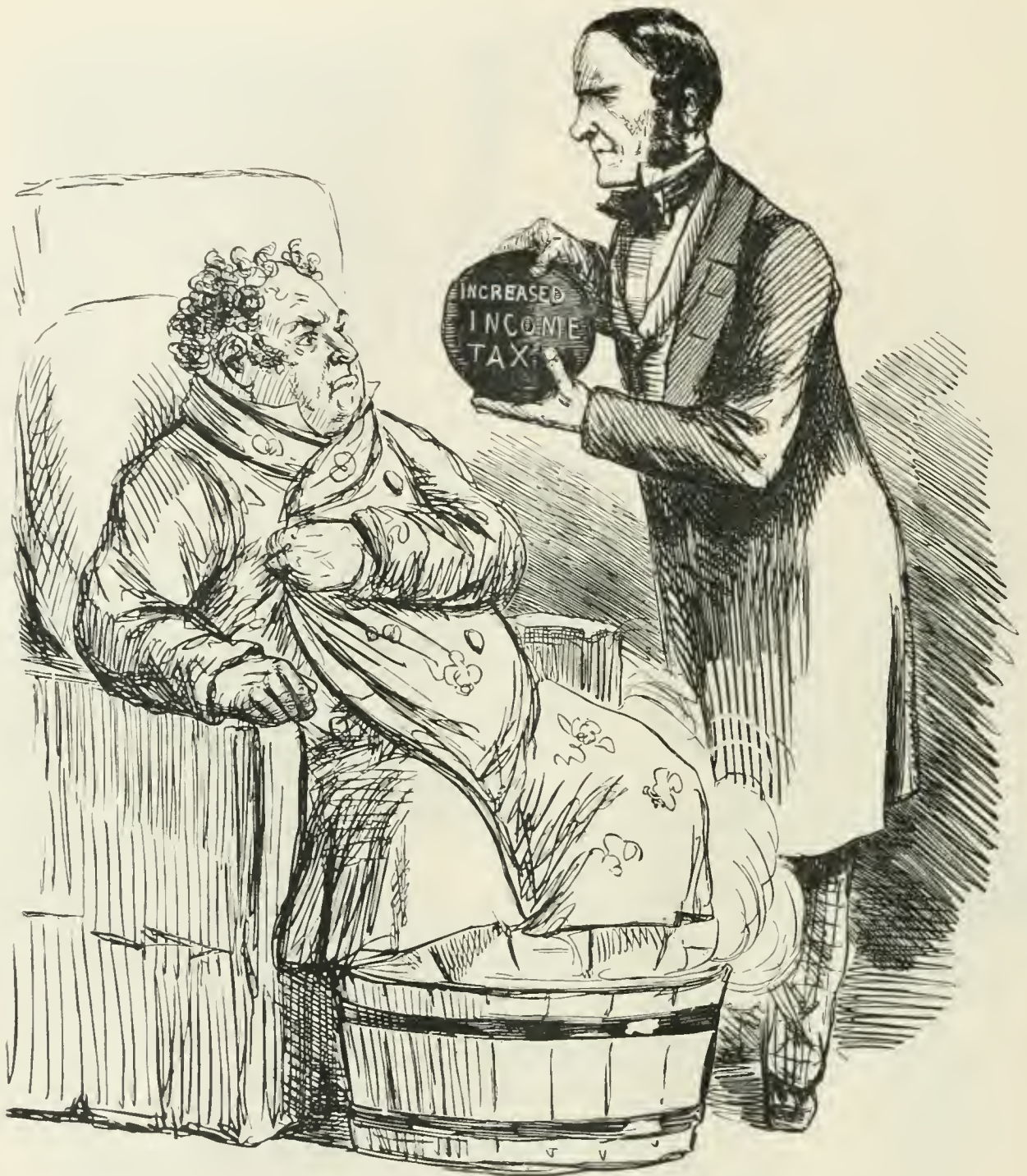

## THE OLD NEWS BOY.

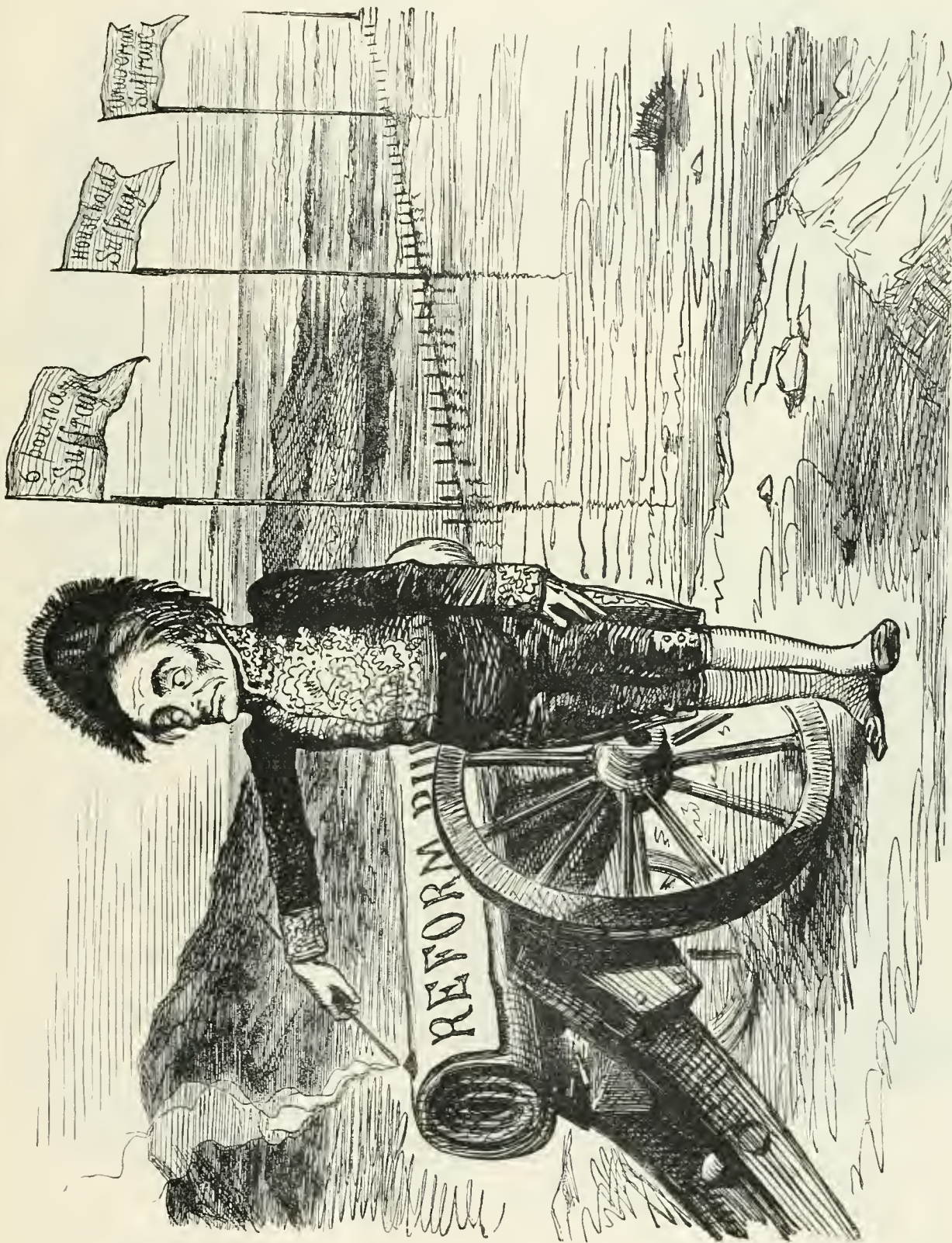
BOY.—"SECOND EDI—TI—ON! REFORM BILL!"

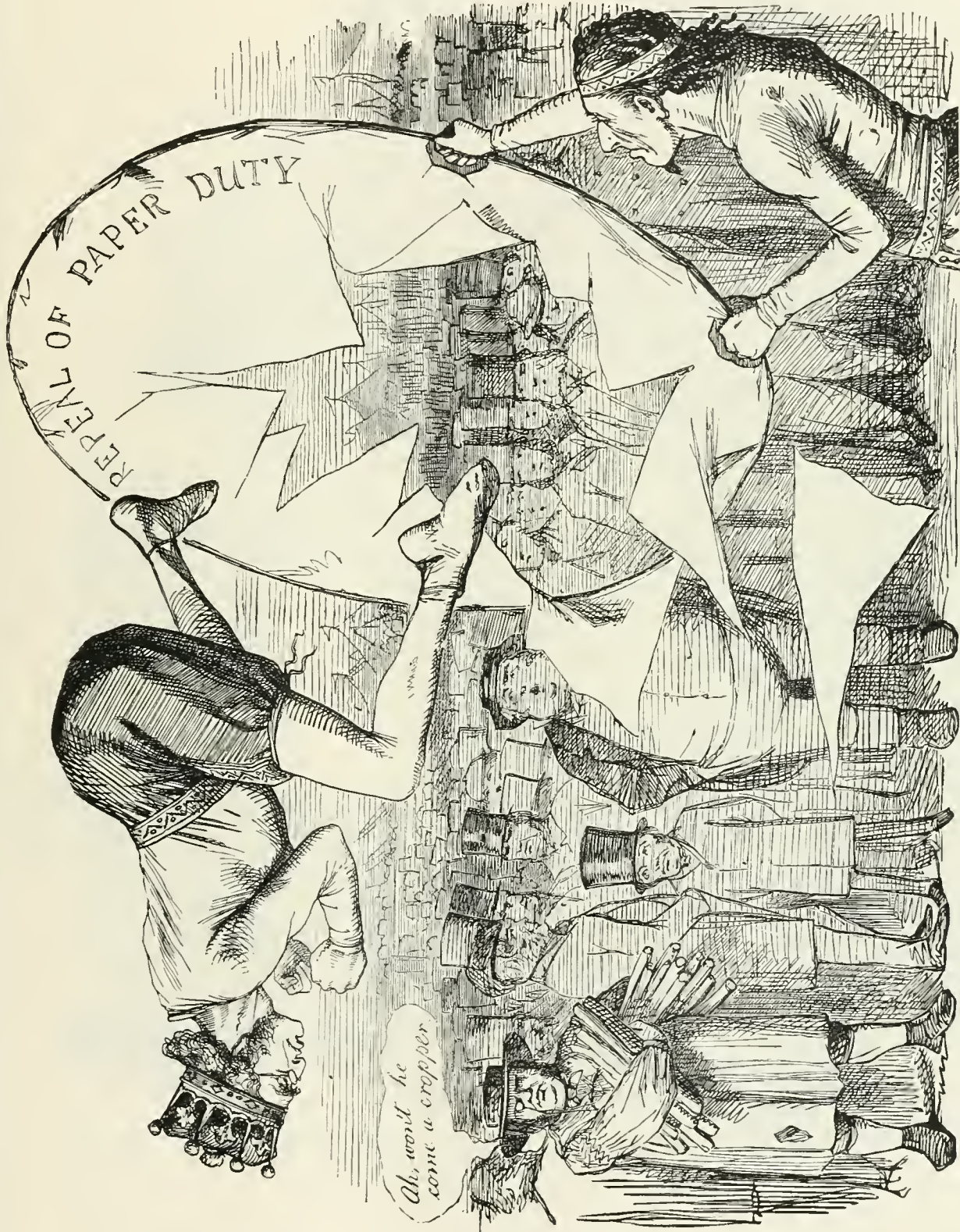

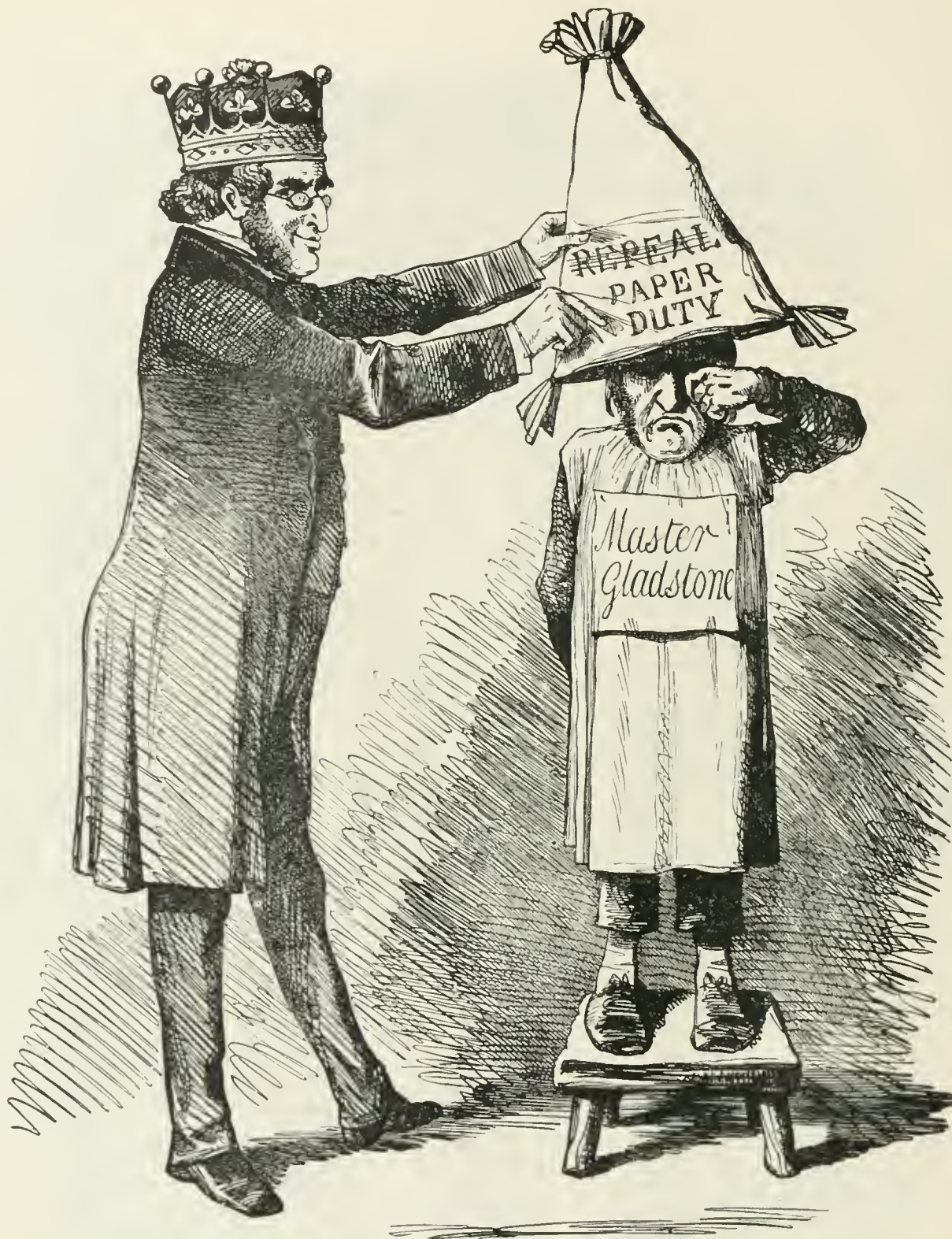
•• Lord John Russell's Reform Bill satisfied neither the earnest advocates nor the vehement opponents of Reform.





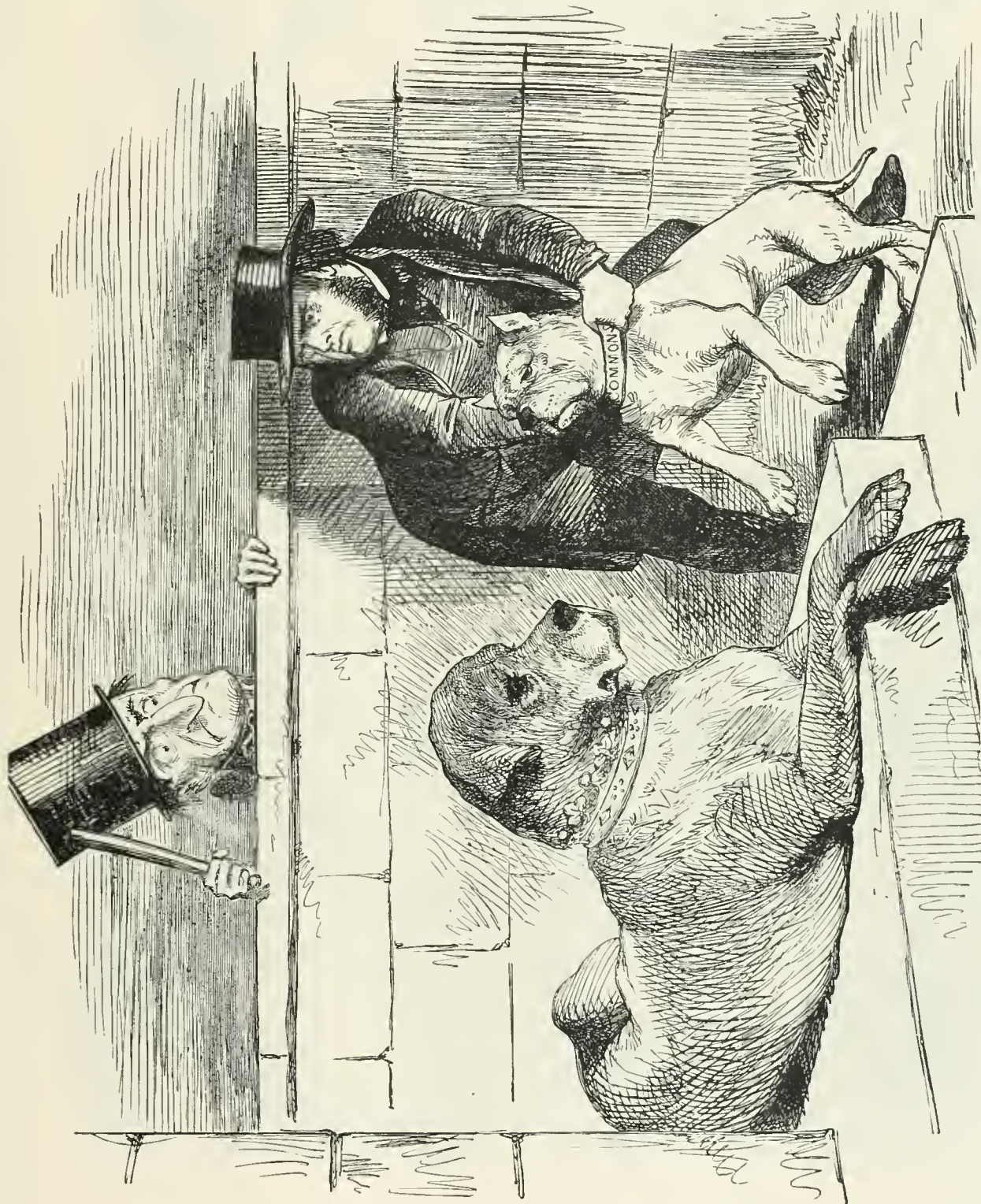
### A DERBY COURSE INCIDENT.

.. In consequence of the rejection of the proposal to repeal the Paper Duty, Mr. Bright fulminated very vehemently against the privileges and prejudices of the House of Lords.

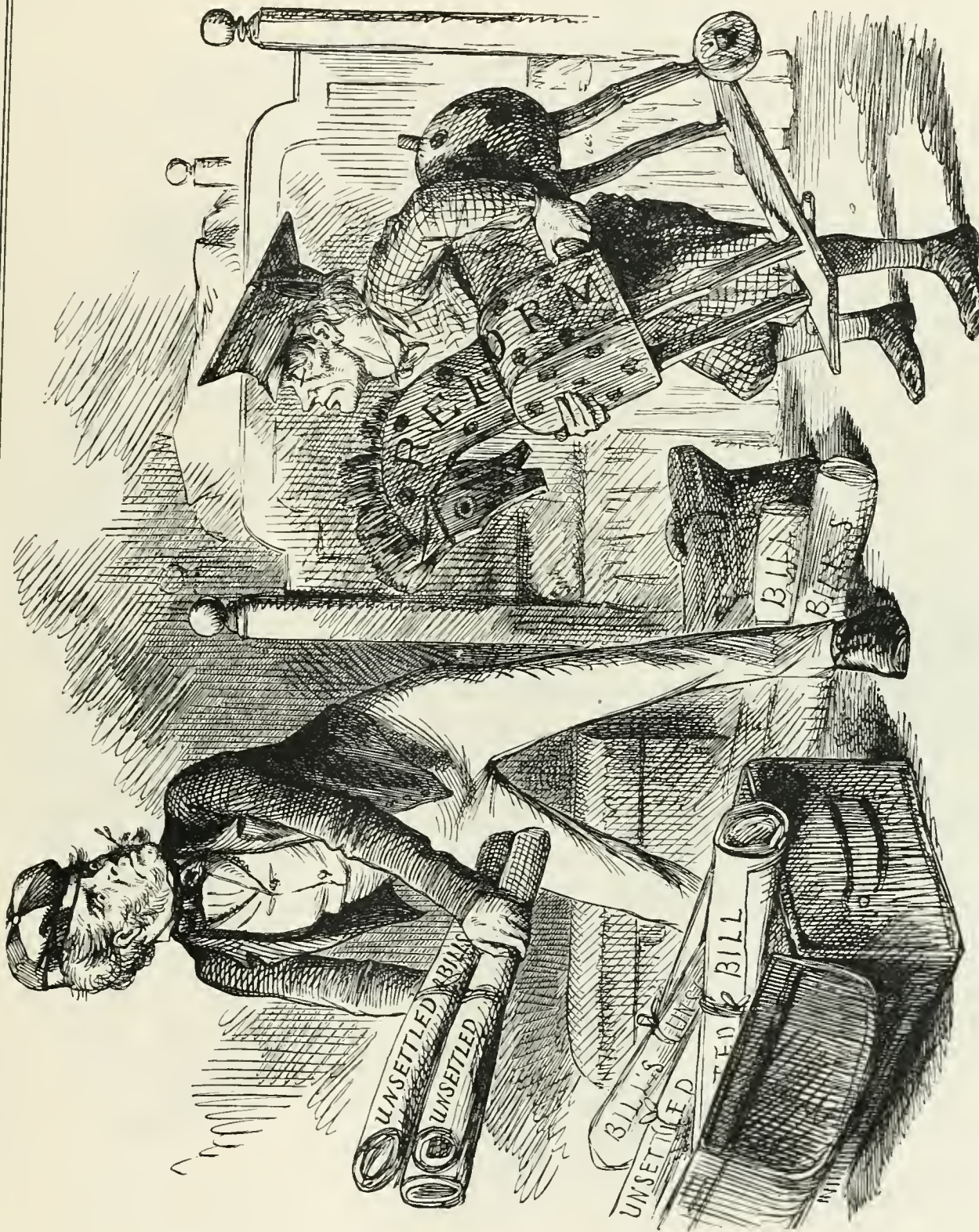
## RETRIBUTION, OR THE GREENWICH DINNER.

LORD PALMERSTON.—“OH, YES! YOU WOULD MAKE IT SO LATE IN THE SEASON.”

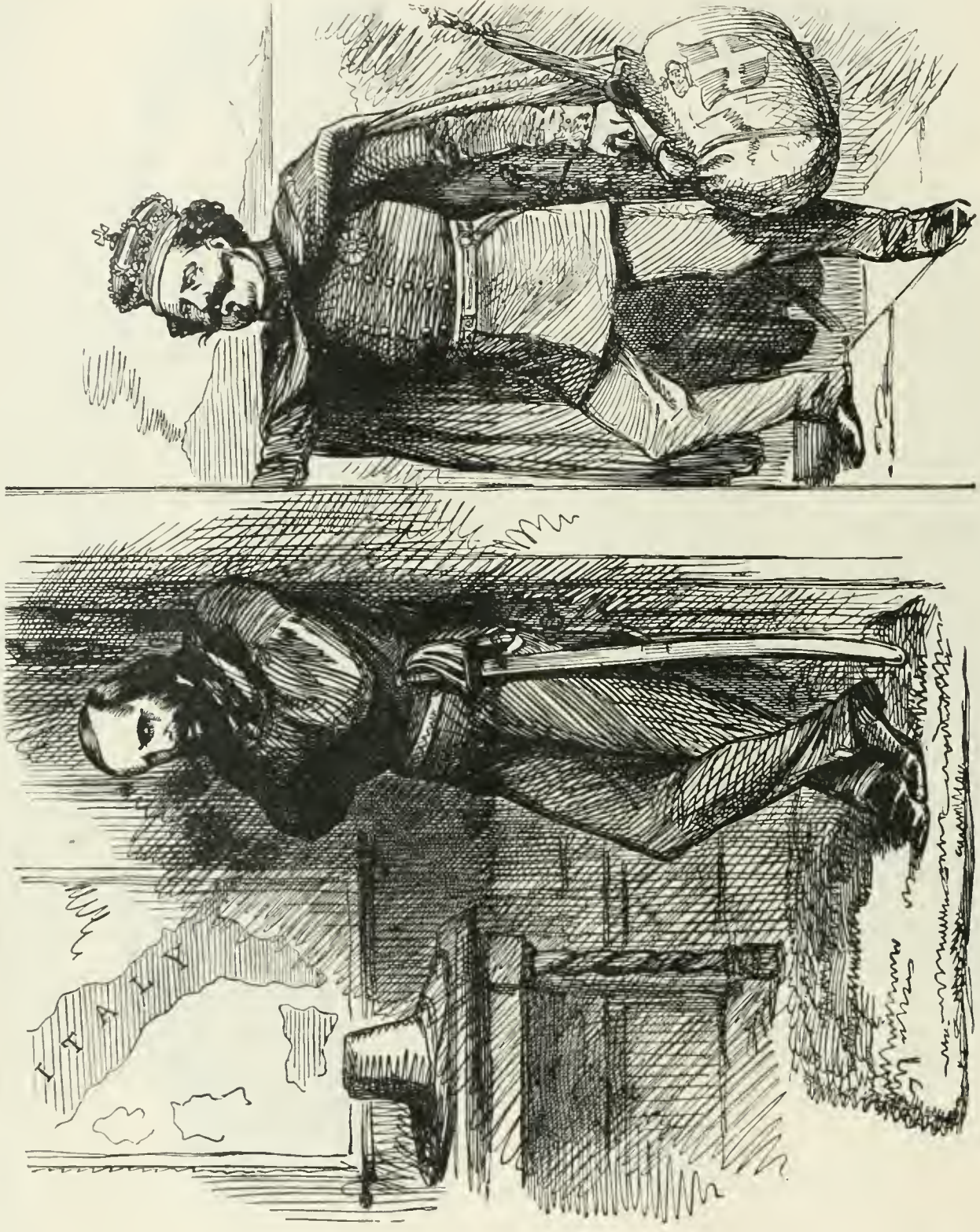
•• The Session was very prolonged and the Ministerial whitebait dinner at Greenwich was held much later than usual.
