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### **GRADING OF VIOLIN COMPOSITIONS**

The Violin Compositions listed in Part I of this catalog have been carefully graded, by an experienced teacher and musician from the practical teacher's point of view, according to the following classification:—

### Grade I. EASY.

Pieces in this grade are wholly in the First Position.

### Grade II. INTERMEDIATE.

Consisting of pieces in the First and Third Positions, with easy florid passages, occasional harmonic tones, and very easy double stops.

### Grade III. ADVANCED.

Includes brilliant pieces of moderate difficulty, employing double stops, brilliant bowings, and the higher positions.

### Grade IV. DIFFICULT.

Includes compositions demanding great refinement of performance, or virtuosity.

N. B. — Compositions advanced in their grade and bordering upon or overlapping the next higher grade are marked I-II, or III-III, or III-IV, as the case may be.

The Violoncello music listed is graded upon substantially the scheme given above.
