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

**DOCTOR JOSHUA I. COHEN** was born in Richmond, Virginia, in the year 1801. The family removed during his early childhood to Baltimore, where he continued to reside until his death on November 4th, 1870. He was a graduate of the Medical School of the University of Maryland, and practised his profession for many years, attaining distinction in the treatment of diseases of the ear, to which he especially devoted his attention.

Doctor Cohen was a man of scholarly and scientific attainments, and throughout his life held relation with the scientific world, being perhaps best known as a mineralogist. For some years he filled the chair of Geology and Mineralogy in the University of Maryland.

His tastes, which were also literary, historical and antiquarian, led him to the formation of various collections illustrative of his studies. His cabinet of minerals, and collection of colonial and continental currency, as also his collection of autographs, were more generally known than the collection to which this Catalogue will serve as a guide.

This is, however, inaccurate. They were not the first Hebrew characters printed, but were the first printed in Germany. Hebrew characters were printed as early as 1471 (Steinschneider in Ersch & Gruber's Encyclop., Sec. II, Vol. XXVIII, p. 49 a, note 34), and two Hebrew books רשי על התורה ורבעה טורים were published in Italy in 1475. The first complete Hebrew Bible was not issued from the press till 1488. [C. A.]

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
