THE CORCORAN GALLERY OF ART has among its permanent collections, through the generosity of its honored founder, the late William Wilson Corcoran, proof engravings of over 800 portraits by M. Favret de Saint Memin, assembled and indexed by the artist himself, and now placed on public exhibition.

M. Favret de Saint Memin, a member of a family of rank and fortune, was born in Paris, in 1770. He became an officer of the French Guards, attached to the Court of Louis XVI; was an accomplished amateur artist, and had an aptitude for mechanics. By the revolution of 1790, he, with his family, had to flee to Switzerland, and afterwards came to America by way of Canada.

About 1796, St. Memin came to New York, and his family being deprived of their estates in Santo Domingo, as well as in France, the ex-guardsman had to rely upon his accomplishments for means of support, showing that ready adaptation to circumstances peculiar to Frenchmen, as was shown in the career of the exiled Duke of Orleans, afterwards Louis Philippe of France.

St. Memin began his artistic career by taking views of New York, beautifully tinted, and his success led him to taking life-size crayon portraits, in profile, on paper of a pinkish color. He invented a machine to do this with greater accuracy, and another

to reduce the portraits to a small size for engraving. He next undertook to engrave them himself, and, with nothing but an Encyclopædia at hand, and with instruments of his own invention, his mechanical genius enabled him to engrave on copper, in the beautiful, sharp, and finished style his works displayed.

For two years, a fellow-exile, M. Valnuit, was associated with him in this vocation, and during that time the engraved heads bore the names of both. Valnuit returned then to France, and St. Memin's name alone is found on the subsequent prints. For a life-size portrait in crayon, and the engraved copper-plate, with twelve impressions, he charged thirty-five dollars.

Having prosecuted this business in New York from 1796 to 1798, St. Memin, after a short stop in Burlington, New Jersey, went to Philadelphia, remaining there busily employed until 1803. During 1804 he was in Baltimore, and thence came to Washington, where he remained three years, visiting Georgetown and Alexandria, with a fruitful field for his pencil and burin among the dignitaries and citizens of the Federal Capital. In 1808, he visited Richmond and Norfolk, passed 1809 in Charleston, South Carolina, and returned to New York in 1810. At this time, Napoleon having relaxed the measures against immigration, St. Memin returned to France, where he studied painting and engraving. He returned to America in 1812, and resumed his vocation of artist and engraver until 1815, when, on the downfall of Napoleon, he returned to France, never to leave it again.

In 1817, Louis XVIII appointed him Curator of the Museum of Dijon, France, for which post his artistic and mechanical skill fitted him, and which he filled until his death in 1852, aged 82 years.

St. Memin left two copies of his collection of engraved portraits—all choice proofs of his own selection. One of them contained 820 portraits, and the other, in possession of the Corcoran Gallery, 818; the former owned by a New York publisher, who, before our civil war, published a photograph copy of them, accompanied with interesting biographical notices of most of the

persons represented. A copy of this volume is also owned by the Corcoran Gallery, and, by comparing these photographs with the original engravings, the excellence and fine execution of the latter are more manifest.

As but few of these portraits were made for public use, St. Memin placed no names on the plates, but wrote them with his own hand beneath the portraits owned by the Corcoran Gallery, which were also indexed by him.

In his progress from New York to Charleston, from 1796 to 1810, St. Memin's portraits embrace many of the distinguished men of that period and of those cities, with many of lesser fame and in private life, with a number of ladies and children, and the pictures present a curious transition of style of dress within that period. Among them are likenesses of the artist and his family. The portraits of Washingtonians are of great interest, not only to our old citizens who remember them, but to their descendants, who see in them their sires "in their habits as they lived." Among them are President Jefferson, Genl. Van Ness, Col. Wm. Brent, Dr. Thornton, Capt. Laval, John McDaniell, Robt. F. How, Dr. Fred'k May, Genl. Macomb, Commodore Stewart, Genl. Wade Hampton, etc.

There are many single copies of these prints extant, and also some of the portraits in crayon on pink paper.

These engravings were offered to Congress for purchase, but declined, and Mr. Corcoran at once bought them as one of the most valuable acquisitions of the Gallery.
