THE society of the Friends of American Art in Chicago was organized in 1910 "to promote the development of American Art by the purchase of works by American artists to be presented to the Art Institute of Chicago, and by any other appropriate means". Each member subscribes one thousand dollars in installments of two hundred dollars a year. The members now number one hundred and fifty-nine. Up to the present time the society has presented to the Art Institute forty-one paintings, two pieces of sculpture and thirty-seven lithographs and etchings. The present exhibition is undertaken as an appropriate means of promoting interest in the development of American Art.
