



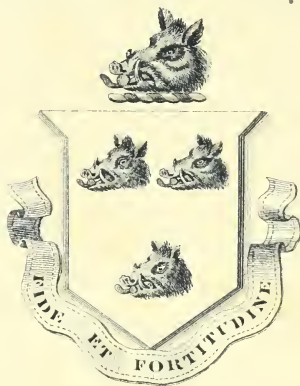

II. No Person to advance less than 1s.; above Five Pounds, 2s. 6d.; and so on in proportion.

III. The Purchasers to give in their Names and Places of Abode, and to pay down 5s. in the Pound, if required, in Part Payment of the Purchase-money; in Default of which the Lot or Lots so purchased to be immediately put up again and re-sold.

IV. The Lots to be taken away at the Buyer's Expense, within Three Days after the conclusion of the Sale; and the remainder of the Purchase-money to be absolutely paid on or before the Delivery, in default of which Mr. W. will not hold himself responsible, if lost, stolen, or damaged, or otherwise destroyed, but they will be left at the sole risk of the Purchaser.

V. - 1085 MARBLE BUST OF THE LATE LORD BYRON, THE SIZE OF LIFE. This beautiful Bust is the work of the celebrated BARTOLINI, the sculptor of Florence. It was executed by the Artist expressly for the late Lord Weymouth, and is the last and only one to which Lord Byron sat previous to his departure for Greece; his Lordship had for some time before leaving Italy altered the style and manner of his hair, bringing it over the forehead, and allowing it to hang long on the back of the neck, which this bust retains, at the wish of Lord Byron. It was taken at Pisa, where his Lordship attended with the Artist nearly a month for the purpose

1086 PAIR OF MARBLE PEDESTALS, sculptured by BARTOLINI of Florence. They are triangular shaped, the corners ornamented with Rams heads, joined to each other with wreaths of flowers, raised full from the marble and most delicately finished; the sides are ornamented with scrolls, the centre containing the armorial bearings of the " Bath Family" with the Coronet, as for the late Viscount Weymouth, for whom they were executed; the Pedestals rest upon Lions claws, placed on triangular slabs of grey marble, and are each 3 feet 9 inches in height
