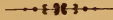

*My dear Sir,—*

I perceive by last night's papers that the question of the Library is to come before the City Council this morning, and that there is some danger of the object in view being misapprehended. The Library, as will be seen on reference to the catalogue, is an excellent one, containing upwards of 3000 volumes, and among them several of the best English classics. It represents the accumulations of more than thirty years, has cost a large sum of money, and having been recently purged of every objectionable work, is admirably fitted for the instruction and amusement of both sexes. Were it a Free Library, accessible for two or three hours a day, and the books given out on the same principles which have succeeded so well in Boston and New York, how many hundreds are there in this town shut out at present from the literature of the day, to whom it would be a source of perpetual improvement and delight? If it were to cost the city, as a friendly critic declares, some twelve or fifteen hundred dollars a year, prudent men might pause before incurring such an expense. But, according to my ideas, a much cheaper and simpler experiment is all that should be tried. What may be hereafter achieved in the rapid progress of our city, or as the fruit of private liberality, none of us can anticipate. At present all I would propose is the fitting up of a room in some one of the public buildings, with the shelves which are to accompany the books,—the appointment of a librarian at a very moderate salary, and the throwing open of the Library as a free institution, with the few and simple guards which experience has suggested elsewhere. There is not the slightest difficulty in all this, and the expense would be trifling. It was an accidental conversation

with Dr. Hume, and a subsequent inspection of the catalogue, that led me to make the proposal, and I cannot help thinking that its rejection by the City Council, as representing the body of the citizens, would be a reproach to our public spirit and to our literary taste. I offer it to the corporation as a free gift, to be used for the benefit of the whole public, without distinction of creed or origin, and confess I should be sorry to see it dispersed and lost to the community, by whom it would be felt at once as a blessing, while it may be the germ in future years of a noble institution, familiarizing our people, and especially our youth, with the delights of literature, and the solid advantages of science.

*Extract from Minutes of City Council, Halifax, Feby. 19, 1864.*

Read communication from His Honor the Chief Justice, submitted this day, when the following resolution is introduced:—

*Therefore Resolved*, That the offer of His Honor be accepted, and that the grateful thanks of this community be tendered to His Honor for his very liberal and handsome donation for the benefit of his fellow citizens.

Moved by Alderman Jennings, and seconded by Alderman Conway, which on being put is passed, and a copy of the same directed to be transmitted to His Honor.

# RULES & REGULATIONS

FOR THE USE OF THE

## CITIZENS' FREE LIBRARY.

---

1st.—The following persons shall be entitled to borrow Books from the Library for home use, upon signing a promise to obey the Rules and Regulations.

All Rate payers, Volunteers, Firemen, and all other inhabitants of Halifax above the age of 18 years, known to the Committee as proper persons to enjoy its privileges, or so recommended by some responsible citizen, who shall thus make himself liable for any loss resulting therefrom.

2nd.—All Clergymen, Professors and Teachers, and any Student or pupil recommended by them.

3rd.—Any other inhabitant of Halifax, depositing the value of the volume asked for, if permitted to circulate (or of the set to which it may belong) for which a receipt will be given; which sum shall be repaid, whenever the book and receipt are returned—after any fines incurred for injury to the book or its improper detention have been deducted.

4th.—The Library will be opened every day except Sundays and Holidays, from 4 P. M. to 7 o'clock, until the first of October: and from that time to the first of May 3 to 6 o'clock; and the books in all cases to be applied for, and returned within those hours.

5th.—No books shall be taken from the shelves, in any part of the Library, by any person not employed in the service, except such books as are deposited as works of reference.

6th.—Books desired for home use must be designated by their numbers on the Catalogue, to be supplied by the Library at 25 Cents each.

7th.—No person shall have for home use more than one volume, on any one day ; and no book shall be retained by the person borrowing, more than the number of days printed inside the cover.—Provided always, that any book may be borrowed twice by the same person ; but not more than twice until it shall have been returned to the Library and shall have remained there at least one Library day.

8th.—No person who has borrowed a book from the Library, shall lend it to any one not a member of the same household.

9th.—A list of all persons entering their names for the purpose of borrowing books, shall be kept in the Library ; the residence of each individual and the page where the loans are recorded, being inserted against the name.

10th.—To protect the Library against loss, and to secure to all a just and equitable share in its benefits, any person detaining a volume longer than the regulations permit, shall be fined 2 Cents per day for each day's detention, the Librarian being charged with the collection of these and other dues of the Library.

11th.—Any book detained one week beyond the time limited by these regulations, shall be sent for by the Librarian ; and the expense thus incurred shall be paid by the person who has so detained it.

12th.—Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, sets of Newspapers and other books needed for reference in the Library building ; books not easily to be replaced in consequence of their rarity or value ; books expressly given for reference only ; and books deemed by the Committee to be unsuited for general circulation, shall be used only in the building. Provided nevertheless, that, in order to allow the widest practicable use of the Library consistent with its greatest efficiency, a person desiring to borrow any book whatever (except such books as may have been given on condition that they should not be taken from the Library,) and stating the reasons for it in writing to the Committee, shall if the reasons are deemed sufficient, be permitted to borrow it on proper conditions.

13th.—All injuries to books beyond a reasonable wear and all losses, shall be made good, to the satisfaction of the Superin-

tendent—by the person liable—every book detained above three months being held to be lost.

14th.—Any stranger or person visiting the city for the purpose of literary or scientific investigations, may, on being properly recommended, temporarily receive the benefits of the Library and the use of the books, within the Building, by signing the Stranger's Book.

15th.—All Books must be returned to the Library, at such time before the annual examination, as may be required by the Committee, under penalty of a fine of one dollar for each volume detained; but seasonable notice of the time of returning them shall be given in the Newspapers that advertise for the City.

16th.—Any person abusing the privileges of taking Books from the Library by the violation of any of the regulations, by intentional defacement of a book, by writing in it, or in any other way—shall immediately be reported to the Committee, who shall if they think the case requires it, exclude such person, for a time, or permanently, from the Library, according to the nature and degree of the delinquency or default.

17th.—Any person charged with Books by the late Mechanics' Library, not accounting for them, to the satisfaction of the Committee, shall be excluded from the privileges of the Library.

18th.—No person owing a fine for detention of a Book, or defacing the same, can be entitled to receive any other volume until all sums so due are paid.
