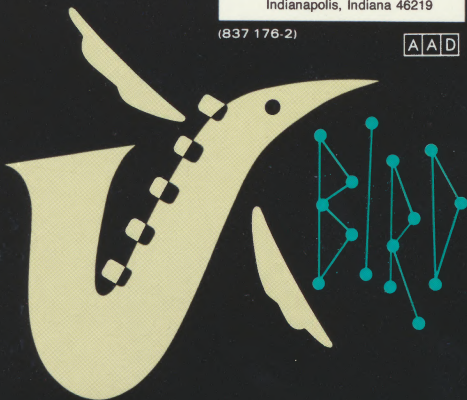



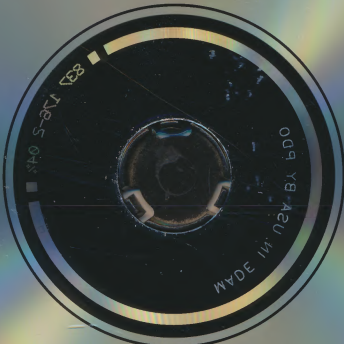
"Bird" was Charlie Parker... arguably, the most influential of all jazz musicians. Documented in this compilation is some of Bird's greatest work in a variety of contexts. Featured alongside some of his greatest collaborators, Bird can be heard in small groups, with strings, and in an extended jam. *Now's The Time* is one of his signature blues compositions; *Kim* and *Laird Baird* are dedications to his stepdaughter and son, respectively; *K.C. Blues* recalls his hometown, and *Just Friends* contains his own favorite solo. These are among the highlights of this collection which should prove to be an ideal introduction to the music of Bird.
