Cab Calloway is a living legend. The Rochester born singer and bandleader started off in Chicago around 1928 and recorded in New York under his own name as soon as 1930. He became famous as a scat singer with the tremendous success of "Minnie The Moocher" and was one of the most sought after entertainers of the 30's - 40's. In 1931 commenced the prestigious residency at New York's Cotton Club, where he gained his nickname "King of Hi-De-Ho". As most big band directors of the time, Calloway tried to hire good soloists – perhaps to balance the commercial quality, to say the least, of most performances – and even counted in the ranks of his trumpet section with the young and boisterous Dizzy Gillespie. If the most celebrated musician of the orchestra has always been tenor saxist Chu Berry, other good instrumentalists enhanced the musical value of Cab's recordings and live appearances, such as Illinois Jacquet and Cozy Cole.

Or, in the case of these broadcasts, Jonah Jones, Shad Collins, Tyree Glenn, Quentin Jackson, Hilton Jefferson, Milton Hinton, J.-C. Heard and above all the sadly underrated tenorman Ike Quebec. This powerful improviser's full tone can be heard on eight of the tunes in this collection. Cab Calloway, who indulges himself here into languid crooning more than into his famous "Jive" vocals, shares the spotlight with girl singer Dottie Salter, who certainly listened a lot to the great Billie Holiday. Arranger Buster Harding shows his skill on instrumental numbers such as "Cruising With Cab", "One O'Clock Jump", "Frantic On The Atlantic". And now, let's join the Cab.
