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The second time I read QUARTET, I went through the script and highlighted wherever a piece of music was mentioned. I then made a playlist (a pre-soundtrack) for how the film would play aurally. I knew this was not just going to be a movie with a musical score, it was a story that would be brought to life by the voices and instruments of real musicians and opera singers.

I never had any great knowledge or experience of Opera. I studied classical piano from the age of five until I was a teenager whereupon I switched to jazz. I remain a novice in both. It was not until I moved to New York City to study acting that I had roommates who were opera singers. I learned early on that these people were not only musicians, but extraordinary athletes who were in a highly competitive and extremely difficult art form that took years to perfect. When I agreed to direct QUARTET, I did it under the condition that I could cast actual retired opera singers and musicians, most of whom are on this soundtrack. They have not lost their talent or passion for their craft. Throughout filming, these individuals brought a dimension that none of us expected and it was truly a gift for all of us working on the film. They are in their 70's, 80's, 90's and yet they came in every day and worked long hours with great dedication and stamina. Their careers spanned many years across The Metropolitan Opera, English National Opera, London Symphony Orchestra, D'Oyly Carte Opera Co, Royal Opera House Covent Garden & Frank Sinatra's Orchestra.

I first heard Dario Marianelli's work in the film ATONEMENT. I felt he would be able to create a subtle and fine score amongst all the strong pieces of music. He did. And it was almost as impressive as his mushroom risotto.

I would also like to include the work that our editor, Barney Pilling, did in this movie. It went far beyond editing. His sense of music and rhythm contributed immeasurably to the film.

This is the music for "QUARTET."
