THE DIVERSE YUSEF LATEEF

Many of Yusef Lateef's fans have asked for long compositions on his records. "The Diverse Yusef Lateef" is his answer.

Live Humble bears a message Yusef believes in, strongly. His concept of humbleness on this album is smooth, rhythmic and sensuous. To live humble is not easy and is complicated with many characters in the personality. Once achieved, however, it is an asset. Yusef illustrates this by a combination of tones and people. Live Humble is pure hard-driving swing.

A Long Time Ago, a fascinating symphony of African, Oriental and European instruments, with voices, depicts the beginning of something. It tells a history. It activates the imagination and each of us will have something to say about it. Yusef dedicated this composition to The Sweet Inspirations. It is their unusual sensitivity that highlights this work.

Chandra means moon. It is also the name of an Indian doctor, a microbiologist, Yusef met in Boston a few years ago. The composition is Oriental in name and design. It is mystic, majestic and moody. Chandra is strictly "Yusefian" (a word coined by Julian "Cannonball" Adderley). It resulted from the fusing of two forms, fugue and tone poem. The fugal (A) section played by the string quartet is tonal and the accompanying improvised flute solo is both tonal and atonal, portraying a lovely marriage of two musical mediums.

Throughout the U.S.A., during performances, those who came to listen were aghast and deeply captivated by Yusef's percussionist, Roy Brooks. A modern, magnificent musician, Mr. Brooks has shown another side of his many talents, that of composer. "Eboness is a woman, a beautiful woman," says Mr. Brooks. This composition certainly speaks loudly of Mr. Brooks' ability to illustrate his broadened, baffling barrage of colors and tones.

"The Diverse Yusef Lateef" is for listening. It is serious, meaningful and exquisitely performed. It is for Yusef's fans, old and new, who have for years wanted this kind of album.
