The Verses on Friends

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Aññadatthu haro mitto - One who makes friends only to cheat them

Yo ca mitto vacī-paramo – *One who is good only in word*

Anupiyāñ-ca yo āhu – *One who flatters & cajoles*

Apāyesu ca yo sakhā – And a companion in ruinous fun

Ete amitte cattāro Iti viññāa paṇḍito – *These four the wise know as non-friends*.

Ārakā parivajjeyya – *Avoid them from afar*

Maggam paṭibhayam yathā – *Like a dangerous road*.

Upakāro ca yo mitto, Sukha-dukkho ca yo sakhā

One who shares in your sorrows & joys

Atthakkhāyi ca yo mitto – One who points you to worthwhile things,

Yo ca mittānukampako – One sympathetic to friends

Etepi mitte cattāro Iti viññāya paṇḍito – These four, the wise know as true friends.

Sakkaccam payirupāseyya - Attend to them earnestly

Mātā puttam va orasam - As a mother to her child.
