Christ's Object Lessons is an approachable explanation of the main parables used by Jesus Christ to teach His disciples how to live. Notably, this discussion highlights how the spiritual truths of Jesus' teaching were illustrated by everyday occurrences that would have been familiar to his hearers, such as sowing and harvesting grain, making bread, and searching for a lost coin. Christ's Object Lessons is the second major book by Ellen G. White, who was a founder of the Seventh Day Adventist church. Her first major book was Steps to Christ, which was published three years earlier.
