FORMATION OF THE CHURCH.

ON the twenty-third day of September, 1892, by the instruction of our beloved Teacher, Rev. MARY BAKER EDDY, twelve of her students and church members met and reorganized, under her jurisdiction, the Christian Science Church and named it, THE FIRST CHURCH OF CHRIST, SCIENTIST. At this meeting twenty other of Mrs. Eddy's students and members of her Church were elected members of this Church; those with others that have since been elected are to be known as "First members." The Church Tenets, Rules, and By-laws as prepared by Mrs. Eddy, were adopted.

The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., is designed to be built on the rock, Christ, which includes the understanding and demonstration of Truth, Life, and Love, healing and saving the world from sin, and death. Thus to represent the church universal, and to reflect the church triumphant.

To be signed by those uniting with The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass.

1. As adherents of Truth, we take the Scriptures for our guide to eternal Life.

2. We acknowledge and adore one Supreme God. We acknowledge His Son, and the Holy Ghost, and man as the Divine image and likeness.

8. We acknowledge God's forgiveness of sin in the destruction of sin, and that sin and suffering are not eternal.

4. We acknowledge the atonement as the efficacy, and evidence of divine Love, of man's unity with God, and the great merits of the Wayshower.

5. We acknowledge the way of Salvation demonstrated by Jesus, to be the power of Truth over all error, sin, sickness, and death; and the resurrection of human faith and understanding to seize the great possibilities and living energies of divine Life.

6. We solemnly promise to strive, watch, and pray for that Mind to be in us which was also in Christ Jesus, to love one another, and to be meek, merciful, just, and *pure*.

CHURCH RULES.

ARTICLE I.

REGULAR MEETINGS.

SECTION 1. The annual meeting of The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., shall be held on the first Tuesday in October in each year, to listen to the reports of the Treasurer, Clerk, and the Committees, and general reports from the fields of the entire members of this Church who desire to speak of their various experiences.

ARTICLE II.

FIRST MEMBERS AND QUARTERLY MEETINGS.

SECTION 1. Quarterly meetings of the First members of this Church shall be held on the Saturday next preceding the Communion Sunday in each quarter, beginning with the Saturday next preceding the first Sunday in January, 1893.

SECT. 2. The First members of the Church shall vote on admitting candidates, and attend to the transaction of any church business that may properly come before the meeting. The names of the candidates for church membership shall be read at the Quarterly meeting and voted on.

SECT. 3. If the First members shall become less than forty in number, they shall regain this number, and they shall be persons who have proven themselves, in successive years, strict adherents to the doctrines and practise inculcated in SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES. These First members shall have the same power to act for this Church as the incumbents.

This Rule shall neither be amended nor repealed except by unanimous vote of this Church.

SECT. 4. Seven First members shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of transacting business for the Church.

ARTICLE III.

SPECIAL MEETINGS.

SECTION 1. Special meetings of the First members of this Church shall be called by the clerk upon a request from our Pastor Emeritus Rev. Mary Baker Eddy, or, an order from three of the First members who are in good standing with this Church. When the clerk shall receive a request to call the First members to convene in special meeting he shall set the earliest possible hour when a quorum can assemble, unless it is otherwise stated in the request. For this purpose he is authorized to use the mail service, and also the telegraph and telephone wires if necessary.

ARTICLE IV.

QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. To become a member of The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., the applicant must be a believer in the doctrines of Christian Science according to the Platform and teaching contained in the Christian Science text-book, SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES, by Rev. Mary Baker G. Eddy. The Bible, and the abovenamed book, with other works by the same author, must be his only text-books for self instruction in Christian Science, and for teaching and practising metaphysical healing.

ARTICLE V.

APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. Applications for membership, coming from the students' pupils, must include the names and recommendations of their teachers. All applications for membership must be addressed to the clerk of the church, who, at each Quarterly meeting, shall read the names of the candidates, and, if requested, may read their letters. The candidates shall be elected by a majority vote of the First members present.

ARTICLE VI.

COMMUNION SERVICE.

SECTION 1. The Communion shall be observed by this Church on the first Sunday in October, January, April and July — by reading selections from the BIBLE, silent prayer, the Lord's Prayer with the Spiritual Interpretation from the text-book, reading the Church

Tenets, reading a sermon appropriately selected from the BIBLE, and SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES, singing of hymns, singing, silent communion, and benediction.

ARTICLE VII.

MEMBERS OF OTHER CHURCHES.

SECTION 1. This Church will receive a member of another church of Christ, Scientist, but not the member of a church of a different denomination, until that membership is dissolved. A member of the Mother Church is not entitled to hold office, teach, or preach in other churches of this denomination except by invitation.

ARTICLE VIII.

CHURCH DISCIPLINE.

SECTION 1. Neither animosity, nor mere personal attachment, should impel the motives or acts of the members of the Mother Church. In Science, Divine Love alone governs man; and a Christian Scientist reflects the sweet amenities of Love, in rebuking sin, true brother-

liness, charitableness, and forgiveness. The members of this Church should daily watch and pray to be delivered from all evil, from prophesying, judging, condemning, counseling, influencing or being influenced, erroneously. The above Church Rule shall be read in Church, by the First reader, on the first Sunday of each month, except on Communion day. On each Communion Sunday, the Church Tenets shall be read from the pulpit.

SECT. 2. The First members are not allowed to report what is said or done in a Church meeting, or the Board of Directors to report what has been said in conference with the Pastor Emeritus, — on penalty of liability to have their names dropped from membership.

If a member shall depart from the Tenets, and be found having the name without the life of a Christian Scientist, his name shall be dropped from the list of membership by a two thirds vote of the First members.

SECT. 3. If a member of this Church shall work against the accomplishment of what the Discoverer and Founder of Christian Science understands is advantageous to the individual, to this Church, and to the cause of Christian Science, or shall influence or counsel others thus to act, upon Mrs. Eddy's complaint, it shall be the duty of this Church to immediately call a meeting, and drop forever the name of this member from its records.

This rule cannot be changed, amended, or annulled, except by a unanimous vote of the Church.

SECT. 4. It shall be the duty of every member of this Church to pray each day: "Thy Kingdom come," — Let the reign of Truth and Love be established in me, rule me, and rule out of me all sin. And may Thy Word, in Christian Science, enrich the affections of all mankind, and govern them.

SECT. 5. No person shall be made a member of this Church, or remain a member, who claims a spiritually adopted child; or a spiritually adopted husband, or wife; except they have been legally adopted and legally married according to the laws of our land.

Any member of this Church who is found living with a child improperly, or claiming a child not legally adopted; or claiming, or living with a husband, or a wife, to whom they have not been legally married; shall immediately

be excommunicated, and on the grounds of moral unfitness to be a teacher of Christian Science, or a member of this Church.

SECT. 6. In 1895 loyal Christian Scientists had given to the author of their text-book, the founder of Christian Science, the individual endearing term of Mother. Therefore if a student of Christian Science shall apply this title, either to herself or to others, except, as the term for kinship according to the flesh, it shall be regarded by the Church as an indication of disrespect for their Pastor Emeritus and unfitness to be a member of the Mother Church.

SECT. 7. If a member of this Church is found violating any of the Rules or By-Laws herein set forth he shall unless otherwise provided in such Rules or By-Laws, be admonished in consonance with the scriptural demand in Matthew 18: 15, 16, 17; and if he neglect to accept such admonition, his name shall be dropped from the roll of membership.

SECT. 8. No member of this Church is allowed to enter a complaint against another member to the Pastor Emeritus. If one member shall aggrieve or vilify another member, his just redress, and the footsteps whereby to reform his

> SECT. 4. They shall teach their students how to defend themselves against mental malpractise, and never to return evil for evil, but to know the Truth that makes free and so be a law, not unto others, but to themselves.

SECT. 5. If a member of this Church is found trying to practise, or to teach Christian Science contrary to the statement thereof in its text-book SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES, it shall be the duty of this Church to admonish that member according to the Church rule; then if said member persists in misteaching and malpractise, his or her name shall be dropped from the Church record.

BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

CHURCH OFFICERS.

SECTION 1. The officers of the Church shall be elected by the Board of Directors at their annual meeting.

SECT. 2. The officers shall consist of a President, Clerk, Treasurer, and two Readers.

SECT. 3. The President of this Church shall hold his office one year only, and is eligible to this office once in three years.

SECT. 4. The President's, Clerk's, Treasurer's and Readers' terms of office expire on the first Tuesday of October.

ARTICLE II.

THE CHRISTIAN SCIENCE PASTOR.

SECTION 1. I, Mary Baker Eddy, ordain the BIBLE, and SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES, Pastor over the Mother Church,— The First Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Mass., — so long as the Church is satisfied with this Pastor.

ARTICLE III.

READERS.

The Christian Science Board of SECTION 1. Directors shall appoint a male and a female reader, one to read the BIBLE, and one to read SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE They shall not read from copies SCRIPTURES. or manuscripts, but from the Books. The readers from these books shall commence by announcing their full titles, and the name of the author of the Text-book. The Directors shall select intelligible readers and exemplary They must be Christians to read in Church. members of this denomination. The readers must devote a suitable portion of their time to preparation for reading the Sunday lesson, a lesson on which the prosperity of Christian Science largely depends. They must keep themselves unspotted from the world, uncontaminated with evil, that the mental atmosphere they exhale shall promote health and holiness, even that spiritual animus so universally needed.

SECT. 2. This Board shall inform the Pastor Emeritus of the names of their candidates for readers before they are elected, and if she objects to the election, said candidates shall not be chosen.

SECT. 3. It shall be the duty of the First reader to conduct the principal part of the Sunday services, and the Friday evening meetings, and to personally examine the local candidates for admission to the Church.

SECT. 4. If the reader is found at any time inadequate or unworthy, a meeting shall be called and he or she shall be removed from office by a majority vote of the Christian Science Board of Directors, and the vacancy supplied.

SECT. 5. The first Reader may read, as a part of the church services, selections from the Scriptures, but no selections shall be read from SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES, other than those contained in the Lesson-Sermon.

SECT. 6. The First members of this Church shall fix the salary of the readers.

ARTICLE IV.

RELATION WITH OTHER CHURCHES.

SECTION 1. The First Church of Christ, Scientist, Boston, Mass., shall assume no official control of other churches of this denomination and shall be officially controlled by no other church; and shall not change its present Tenets.

ARTICLE V.

APPLICANTS FOR MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1. Applicants for membership who have not studied Christian Science with Rev. Mary Baker Eddy, can unite with this Church only by invitation and recommendation of a student of Mrs. Eddy's, loyal to the teachings of our Text-book, SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES,— unless it be an exception that the circumstances warrant.

SECT. 2. Applicants for membership are required to subscribe to the above Tenets and Rules as follows: —

ARTICLE VI.

PROBATIONARY PROVISIONS.

SECTION 1. Individuals who have heretofore been members of this Church, or were members of the Church of Christ, Scientist, organized in 1879 by Reverend Mary Baker Eddy, — but have either voluntarily withdrawn, or were expelled therefrom,— may be received into this Church on one year's probation, providing, they are willing and anxious to live according to its requirements, and make application for membership according to its by-laws and rules.

SECT. 2. If, at the expiration of said one year, they are found worthy, they shall be received into full membership, but if not worthy their applications shall be void.

SECT. 3. If an individual on probation or a member of this Church is found to be unworthy of this Church's membership, and another member in good standing shall, from Christian motives, make this evident, a meeting of this Church shall be called and the name of that probationary member, or full member, of this Church, dropped from its list of membership.

BY-LAWS.

A full member, or a probationary member of this Church that has been excommunicated, and afterwards, when sufficient time has elapsed to thoroughly test his sincerety, gives due evidence of having genuinely repented and of being radically reformed,—shall be eligible to probationary membership upon a unanimous vote of the First members of this Church. This by-law cannot be amended or annulled except by a unanimous vote of this Church.

SECT. 4. Any person desiring to unite with this Church who is unable, owing to unusual and justifiable circumstances, to furnish the recommendation of a loyal student of our Teacher, the Rev. Mary Baker Eddy, may upon application, be received on probation for one year. At the expiration of that term if this person has given satisfactory evidence to the First members that he is worthy of membership, he shall be received into full fellowship.

SECT. 5. No member of this Church is allowed to report to the Pastor Emeritus a case of discipline, or the cases of candidates for admission to this Church, or for dismission from it.

BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE VII. PER CAPITA TAX.

SECTION 1. Every member of The First Church of Christ, Scientist, shall pay a per capita tax annually of not less than one dollar.

ARTICLE VIII.

DUTIES OF CLERK.

SECTION 1. When the Pastor Emeritus sends a letter or message to the clerk of the Mother Church, in Boston, to be read at a meeting of the First members, it shall be the imperative duty of this official to read said communication at the place and time specified. If the clerk fails to perform this important part of his office, he shall be complained of by a member of this Church, — a special meeting shall be called for this purpose, and he shall be removed from office.

SECT. 2. If the clerk of this Church shall receive a communication from the Pastor Emeritus that he does not fully understand, before presenting it to the Church, he shall inform said Pastor of this fact, and obtain a clear understanding of the matter and act in accord-

ance therewith. Failing to adhere to this bylaw, the clerk must resign his office.

ARTICLE IX.

SEATING OF STRANGERS.

SECTION 1. Mother welcomes to her seats in the Church, people of whatever sect or denomination who come to listen to the Sunday sermon, and are not otherwise provided with seats.

ARTICLE X.

VACATION.

SECTION 1. Vacation shall commence after the last Sunday in July, and the Church services shall commence again the first Sunday in September.

ARTICLE XI.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TEACHERS.

SECTION 1. Applicants for membership with the Mother Church who have studied Christian Science with Rev. Mary Baker Eddy, and who are loyal to its teachings, need no invitation or indorsement, and will use the first form of application.

SECT. 2. Applicants for membership who have not studied Christian Science with her, can unite with this Church, only by the invitation and recommendation of a Director, or a First member of this Church, or her loyal students, unless it be an exception that the circumstances warrant. One Normal student cannot recommend the pupil of another Normal student so long as both are loyal to their Teacher, and to our text-book.

SECT. 3. Applicants who have studied Christian Science with one of Mrs. Eddy's loyal students must receive printed invitations, and their teacher's approval of their application, and will use the second form.

SECT. 4. Applicants who have not studied Christian Science with a teacher must receive printed invitations from a loyal student of Mrs. Eddy's and the approval of their applications by the one inviting them, and will use the third form of application.

SECT. 5. All names should be *plainly* written, and one at least of the given names must be written in full. Initials only of first names will not be received.

SECT. 6. If the applicant is a member of a Church of Christ, Scientist, the pen should be drawn through the words, "I am not a member of any church," but if he is not a member of any church, the pen should be drawn through the words "I am a member of Church of Christ, Scientist."

SECT. 7. Instruct the applicants whom you invite, which of the last two forms to use, and be sure they are correctly filled out as indicated below, before they are sent to the clerk of the Church.

ARTICLE XII.

TITLE OF BRANCH CHURCHES.

SECTION 1. The First Church of Christ, Scientist, is the legal title of the Mother Church; branch churches may take the title of First Church of Christ, Scientist; Second Church of Christ, Scientist; and so on, where more than one church is established in the same place; but branch churches shall not take the title of *The* First Church of Christ, Scientist.

CHURCH MANUAL.

ARTICLE XIII.

USE OF CHURCH TENETS.

SECTION 1. Branch churches shall not write the Tenets of the Mother Church in their Church books; but may place securely in such books a copy of the printed Tenets for members to subscribe to. The Tenets of the Mother Church are copyrighted in SCIENCE AND HEALTH WITH KEY TO THE SCRIPTURES.

ARTICLE XIV.

PUBLISHER OF THE TEXT-BOOK.

SECTION 1. A person that is not accepted by our Pastor Emeritus, and the Christian Science Board of Directors, as suitable to publish the Christian Science text-book, shall in no manner be connected therewith, nor with the house whence it is issued.

This by-law can neither be amended nor annulled, except by a unanimous vote of this Church.

ARTICLE XV.

ORGANIZATION OF CHURCHES BY STUDENTS' STUDENTS.

SECTION 1. A member of this Church that obeys its Rules and By-laws, and is a student of Mrs. Eddy's

student, is eligible to form a church and to have church services conducted by reading the Scriptures and the Christian Science text-book. This member's church shall be acknowledged publicly as a church of Christ, Scientist, and its members shall be treated as brethren. Any deviation from this By-law by a member of this Church shall render that member liable to have his name dropped from the Church.

DEED OF TRUST.

THE FOLLOWING IS A COPY OF THE DEED OF TRUST CONVEYING LAND FOR CHURCH EDIFICE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That I Mary Baker G. Eddy of Concord in the County of Merrimack and State of New Hampshire in consideration of one dollar to me paid by Ira O. Knapp of Boston Massachusetts, William B. Johnson, of Boston, Massachusetts, Joseph S. Eastman of Chelsea, Massachusetts, and Stephen A. Chase of Fall River, Massachusetts, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and, also in consideration of the trusts and uses hereinafter mentioned and established, do hereby give, bargain, sell and convey to the said Ira O. Knapp, William B. Johnson, Joseph S. Eastaman, and Stephen A. Chase as trustees as hereinafter provided and to their legitimate successors in office forever, a certain parcel of land situate on Falmouth street in said Boston, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the junction of Falmouth street and a forty foot street now called Caledonia street: thence running Southwest on said Falmouth street one hundred and sixteen and 88/100 feet; thence Northwest at a right angle to a point where a line drawn at right angles to said forty foot street at a point thereon one hundred and sixteen and 55/100 feet Northwest from the point of beginning meets the said boundary at right angles to Falmouth street,

sixty-six and 78/100 feet; thence at an obtuse angle on said line at right angles to said forty foot street sixtyseven and 85/100 feet to said forty foot street; thence Southeasterly on said forty foot street one hundred and sixteen and 55/100 feet to the point of beginning; containing seven thousand eight hundred and twenty-eight square feet more or less, and subject to the agreements and restrictions mentioned in a deed recorded in Suffolk Registry of Deeds Lib. 1719, Fol. 83 so far as the same are now legally operative.

This deed of conveyance is made upon the following express trusts and conditions which the said grantees by accepting this deed agree and covenant for themselves and their successors in office to fully perform and fulfil.

1. Said grantees shall be known as the "Christian Science Board of Directors" and shall constitute a perpetual body or corporation under and in accordance with section one, Chapter 89 of the Public Statutes of Massachusetts.^{*} Whenever a vacancy occurs in said Board the remaining members shall within thirty days fill the same by election : but no one shall be eligible to that office who is not in the opinion of the remaining members of the Board a firm and consistent believer in the doctrines of Christian Science as taught in a book entitled "Science and Health" by Mary Baker G. Eddy beginning with the seventy-first edition thereof.

* The descons, church wardens, or other similar officers of churches or other religious societies, and the trustees of the Methodist Episcopal churches appointed according to the discipline and usages thereof, shall, if citizens of this commonwealth, be deemed bodies corporate for the purpose of taking and holding in succession all the grants and donations, whether of real or personal estate, made either to them and their successors, or to their respective churches, or to the poor of the churches. 2. Said Board shall within five years from the date hereof build or cause to be built upon said lot of land a suitable and convenient church edifice, the cost of which shall not be less than fifty thousand dollars.

3. When said church building is completed said Board shall elect a pastor, reader or speaker to fill the pulpit who shall be a genuine Christian Scientist; they shall maintain public worship in accordance with the doctrines of Christian Science in said church and for this purpose they are fully empowered to make any and all necessary rules and regulations.

4. Said Board of Directors shall not suffer or allow any building to be erected upon said lot except a church building or edifice, nor shall they allow said church building or any part thereof to be used for any other purpose than for the ordinary and usual uses of a church.

5. Said board of directors shall not allow or permit in said church building any preaching or other religious services which shall not be consonant and in strict harmony with the doctrines and practise of Christian Science as taught and explained by Mary Baker G. Eddy in the seventy-first edition of her book entitled "Science and Health," which is soon to be issued, and in any subsequent edition thereof.

6. The congregation which shall worship in said church shall be styled "The First Church of Christ, Scientist."

7. Said directors shall not sell or mortgage the land hereby conveyed; but they shall see that all taxes and legal assessments on said property are promptly paid.

8. Said church building shall not be removed from said lot except for the purpose of rebuilding thereon a more expensive or a more convenient structure in which said doctrines of Christian Science only shall be preached and practised. If said church building is removed for either of the purposes above set forth, any and all tablets and inscriptions which are or shall be upon said church building at the time of removal shall be removed therefrom and placed upon the walls of the new edifice. If said building is burned, the directors shall forthwith proceed to rebuild the Church.

9. Said directors shall maintain regular preaching, reading or speaking in said church on each Sabbath, and an omission to have and maintain such preaching, reading or speaking for one year in succession shall be deemed a breach of this condition.

10. Whenever said directors shall determine that it is inexpedient to maintain preaching, reading or speaking in said church in accordance with the terms of this deed, they are authorized and required to reconvey forthwith said lot of land with the building thereon to Mary Baker G. Eddy, her heirs and assigns forever by a proper deed of conveyance.

11. The omission or neglect on the part of said directors to strictly comply with any of the conditions herein contained shall constitute a breach thereof, and the title hereby conveyed shall revert to the grantor Mary Baker G. Eddy, her heirs and assigns forever, upon her entry upon said land and taking possession thereof for such breach.

To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereon belonging to said grantees and their successors in office to the uses and trusts above described forever.

And the said grantor for herself and her heirs, executors and administrators covenants with the said grantees and their successors in office that she is lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid premises, that they are free from all incumbrances not herein mentioned or referred to; that she has good right to sell and convey the same to the said grantees and their successors in office as aforesaid, and that she will and her heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the same to the said grantees and their successors in office forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

Whereas, on March 20, 1895, the Christian Science Board of Directors, in behalf of The First Church of Christ, Scientist, Boston, presented to Reverend Mary Baker Eddy their church edifice as a Testimonial of this church's love and gratitude, and she, with grateful acknowledgments thereof, declined to receive this munificent gift, she now understands the financial situation between the Christian Science Board of Directors and said Church to be as follows :--

The Christian Science Board of Directors own the Church edifice, with the land whereon it stands, legally; and the church members own the aforesaid premises and building, beneficially. After the church was built the balance of the Building Funds which remained in the hands of the Directors, rightfully belonged to the Church, and not solely to the Directors. Therefore, the balance of the church Building Funds which can be spared after the debts are paid, should remain on safe deposit, to be hereafter used for the benefit of this church, as the right occasion may call for it. The following By-law indicates the proper management of the Church Funds.

BY-LAW.

It shall be the duty of the Christian Science Board of Directors to report annually the amount of Church Funds on hand, the amount of its indebtedness, and of its expenditures for the last year. Any gift made of the Church Funds shall require a majority vote of the Christian Science Board of Directors, and a majorty vote of the First members of this Church. The books of the Christian Science Board of Directors and of the Church Treasurer shall be audited annually at the written request of the Church, through a committee on finance.

God requires wisdom, economy and brotherly love to characterize all the proceedings of the members of the Mother Church, The First Church of Christ, Scientist, and I am glad to state, that the action of its honorable Board of Directors has given good evidence of their obedience to this requirement. In case of any possible future deviation therefrom, it shall be the duty of the First members of this Church, to call a special meeting for the purpose of duly considering the questions relating thereto, and to require the committee on finance to visit the Board of Directors, and, in a Christian spirit and manner, demand each one to comply with the vote of the First members on this subject; if any member refuses thus to do, this member shall be dismissed from office and the vacancy supplied by the Board.

Said committee shall inform themselves annually as to the church's financial matters, which are entrusted to the Board of Directors and to the Church Treasurer. If it be found that the church funds have not been properly managed, it shall be the duty of the First members of the Church, to require the Board of Directors and the Treasurer to be individually responsible for the performance of their several offices satisfactorily, and for the proper distribution of the funds of which they are the custodians.

This By-Law is designed, not as much for this hour as for future years, and for the disobedient; even as the Ten Commandments stand for all time, and require all men to act righteously. MARY BAKER EDDY.
